Historic Winning

The Brewers set a franchise record last night with their 14th consecutive win.....the longest streak in franchise win.....the longest streak in franchise history spanning seasons is 16 from 10/3/86-4/20/87 as the team won its last 3 games of 1986 and first 13 games of 1987....it is the longest winning streak in the majors since 14-game runs in 2022 by Atlanta [6/1-6/15] and Seattle [7/2-7/17].... the last winning streak of 15+ games in the majors was 17 by St Luis from in the majors was 17 by St. Louis from 9/11-9/28, 2021,

Team Streak

The Brewers are the first team in the majors since the 2015 Blue Jays (11g twice) to have multiple winning streaks of 11+ games in a season and the first National League team to do it since the 1935 Cubs (11g and 21g).

Climbing the Charts

The Brewers (78-44) are 34 games over .500, tying a franchise record..... the team was also 34 games over .500 twice in 2021 (89-55 and 91-57).

Road Warriors

The Brewers are on a 9-game road winning streak, tying the franchise record set from 6/8-6/17, 1973 and 7/18-8/2, 2008....the longest road winning streak in franchise history spanning seasons is 11 from 9/21/86-4/20/87 as the team won its last 4 road games of 1986 and first 7 road games of 1987. games of 1987.

Seeing Red Milwaukee clinched its 13th straight series victory over Cincinnati with last night's win.....the Brewers are 44-16 in their last 60 games against the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME: Is game 3 (2-0) of an 8-game road trip to Cincinnati (2-0) and Chicago-NL (5g)....following this trip, the Brewers return to American Family Field for 7 games against San Francisco (3g) and Arizona (4g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (152 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 38*, SECOND: 57, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 9.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 26-12-2 in series play, including this series. Game 1: 26-14, Game 2: 26-14, Game 3: 23-15, Game 4: 3-1 Sweeps (10): vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28), at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1), at MIN (3g, 6/20-6/22), vs. LAD (3g, 7/7-7/9), vs. WSH (3g, 7/11-7/13), at LAD (3g, 7/18-7/20), at WSH (3g, 8/1-8/3), at ATL (3g, 8/4-8/6), vs. NYM (3g, 8/8-8/10), vs. PIT (3g, 8/11-8/13).....Were Swept (1): at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The team is a Major League-best 42-20 at home, going 15-5-0 in series play....are 30-11 in the last 41 games, 19-4 in the last 23 and 9-1 in the last 10 contests with a season-high-tying 6-game winning streak.....also had a 6-game winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is a Major League-best 36-24 on the road, going 11-7-2 in series play, including this series.....are 26-6 in the last 32 games and 14-1 in the last 15 contests with a franchise-record-tying 9-game winning streak.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 21 replay challenges this season, going 14-7.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/15 at Cincinnati as an out call at first base involving Brandon Lockridge was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 744 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

SUMMARY: Are 236-218-1 all time, including 7-2 this season....went 9-4 last season and are 44-16 in the last 60 games.....Milwaukee has won the last 13 series vs. Cincinnati.

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE: José Quintana, 36, will make his 19th start of the season and first against the Reds.....he last started last Monday vs. Pittsburgh and earned a 7-1 win (6ip, 3h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 89 pitches).....the team is 13-5 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .246 (93-for-378, 14hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/14-5/31 with a left shoulder impingement, retroactive to May 11.....Quintana signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on March 5.....he is signed through the 2025 season with a mutual option for 2026.....name is pronounced "keen-TAH-nuh."

MR. COLOMBIA: Quintana, born in Arjona, Colombia, is his country's all-time leader in nearly every statistical category in the Major Leagues, including games (377), starts (351), wins (112), innings pitched (2069.0) and strikeouts (1,796).....he pitched for Colombia in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT: Quintana has made 351 starts since 2012 - his first season - trailing only Max Scherzer (366).....this includes nine seasons of 30+ starts.

CAREER: Is 112-107 with a 3.73 ERA in 377 games/351 starts (2069.0ip, 857er).....is in his 14th Major League season while pitching for Chicago-AL (2012-17), Chicago-NL [2017-20], Los Angeles-AL (2021), San Francisco (2021), Pittsburgh (2022), St. Louis (2022), New York-NL (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2025).....was an All-Star in 2016 as he finished 10th in American League Cy Young Award voting.....Quintana was originally signed by the Mets as a non-drafted free agent on 4/26/06.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 8-7 with a 4.10 ERA in 20 starts [109.2ip, 50er].....is 3-3 with a 4.43 ERA in 8 starts this season [42.2ip, 21er].

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 57-56 with a 3.74 ERA in 191 games/179 starts (1045.0ip, 434er).....is 7-1 with a 2.70 ERA in 10 starts this season (56.2ip, 17er).

CAREER vs. REDS: Is 6-4 with a 2.71 ERA in 16 games/15 starts against the Reds (89.2ip, 87h, 29r, 27er, 28bb, 68k, 7hr), including 1-0 with a 0.73 ERA in 2 starts last season with the Mets (12.1ip, 10h, 1r, 1er, 6bb, 10k, 1hr).
