TODAY'S GAME: SF is looking to level the series with the Angels after last night's series-opening loss...the Giants are 6-10 in Interleague games in 2024.

- ▶ The Giants are 15-11 (.577) in their last 26 games dating to May 15...the .577 winning % in that time is fourth-best in the NL behind Philadelphia (17-9, .654), St. Louis (16-10, .615) and Cincinnati (16-11, .593).
- ▶ More recently, SF is 2-2 thus far on its six-game homestand versus Houston (2-1) and the Angels (0-1).

BIG TIME TIMMY JIM TURNS 40: Two-time Cy Young Award winner, three-time World Series Champion and four-time All-Star **Tim Lincecum** turns 40 today.

- ▶ Oddly enough, Lincecum never started a game on his birthday during his MLB career.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Giants scored six runs in last night's loss to the Angels...it was just the fourth time this year the Giants have scored 5+ runs and lost...SF is now 22-4 in such games.

- ▶ SF did have its opportunities yesterday but left 10 men on while going 3-for-12 w/RISP.
- ▶ The Giants drew seven walks yesterday...none of them came around to score.

BEAT LA...A: The Giants are 26-17 all-time in the regular season vs. the Angels, outscoring them 215-171 (+44)...at Oracle Park, SF is 14-8 vs. LAA, outscoring them 99-82 (+17).

- ▶ With last night's defeat the Giants have now lost three straight to the Angels dating to August 8, 2023...it is the Giants first three-game losing streak to the Angels since losing four straight to the Halos from June 21, 2006-June 17, 2009.

THE LONG BALL: OF Heliot Ramos slugged the Giants' 23rd homer at home this season with his three-run blast in the 8th inning last night...SF's 23 homers at home are still fewest in the Majors...the team with the next fewest is Toronto (26).

- ▶ Furthermore, the Giants have a -7 home run differential in their home ballpark this year having allowed 30 homers while hitting only 23 themselves...the -7 HR difference at home is fifth-worst in the Majors.
- ▶ Overall, the Giants and their opponents have combined to hit 53 homers at Oracle Park this season, the fewest of any park in the Majors...Atlanta's Truist Park has the next fewest at 54 combined homers.

EL BORI: OF Heliot Ramos has been a bright spot for SF since his call-up on May 8, reaching base safely in 29 of his 33 games with a .314/.400/.529 slash line (.929 OPS), five doubles, seven homers and 27 RBI.

- ▶ Ramos' 27 RBI since May 8 are most in the National League and fifth-most in the Majors behind NYY's Aaron Judge (42), CLE's José Ramírez (32), KC's Bobby Witt Jr. (31) and BAL's Adley Rutschman (29).
- ▶ In 12 games this month, he's 17-for-46 (.370) with six extra-base hits (one double, five homers), 14 RBI, seven runs, eight walks and a 1.181 OPS.
- ▶ In the 32 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.03 runs per game and hitting .254, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a .237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- ▶ Defensively, he has +7 DRS in the outfield in 280.2 innings...the +7 DRS are tied for fifth-best among MLB outfielders.

GOT 'EM RIGHT WHERE WE WANT EM?: The Giants are 19-11 (.633) in day games in 2024, including an 11-4 mark in day games here at Oracle Park.

- ▶ SF's .633 winning percentage in day games is fifth-best in the Majors and second-best in the NL behind the Brewers (20-11, .645).
- ▶ The Giants own a .733 OPS in those 30 day games, 68 points higher than their OPS in night games this season (.665).
- ▶ The Giants are 7-2 in their last nine day games here at Oracle Park dating to April 28.

COMMUTER TRAFFIC: SF is one of MLB's top offenses at getting the leadoff runner on-base as shown in the chart below...SF's .341 on-base percentage to lead off an inning would be the franchise's third-best over the past 50 seasons behind 2020 (.361) and 1999 (.345) per *Stats, LLC*.

LET'S GET SOME WINND BEHIND OUR BACKS: RHP Keaton Winn starts this afternoon looking to regain his early-season form in what will be his second start off the IL and his 11th start of the year overall.

- ▶ Winn's first start off the IL (right forearm strain) last Sunday in Texas was a tough one as he allowed seven runs on six hits in 4.1 innings.
- ▶ In his first six starts of the year from April 1-28, Winn went 3-3 with a 3.18 ERA (12er, 34.0ip).
- ▶ Over his last four starts dating to the beginning of May (before his IL stint) he's given up 24 runs on 23 hits in 12.2 innings for a 17.05 ERA.

PRIDE DAY: The Giants are donning their **Pride Day** caps for a fourth consecutive season for this year's Pride Day at Oracle Park...in 2021, the Giants became the first MLB team to incorporate Pride colors into their on-field uniform...for more information on today's festivities at the ballpark, click [here](#).

This Date in Giants History

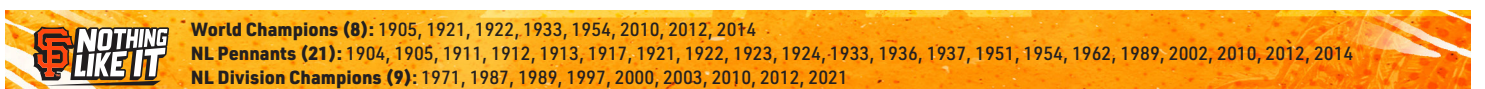

WELCOME BACK: Was reinstated from the 15-day IL last Sunday after missing 20 games with a right forearm strain...Winn landed in the IL on May 17 after sustaining the injury during his start on May 14 against the Dodgers...he is set to face the Angels for the first time in his career.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fourth consecutive loss on Sunday at Texas after matching a season-high seven runs...worked 4.1 innings and gave up six hits with two walks and a homer despite striking out a season-high seven batters...he's failed to reach 5.0 innings in four straight starts, last reaching the mark on April 28 vs. Pittsburgh (6.0ip).

IL STINT: Made one rehab appearance in the Arizona Complex League on June 4 and worked 3.2 innings out of the 'pen...struck out six in the outing and gave up just one run (solo home run) on two hits with two walks.

SECOND THOUGHTS: Over his last three starts, Winn has allowed 12 earned runs over 5.0 innings in his second time through the lineup (21.60 ERA)...batters were 11-for-24 with three homers and two walks in those situations...prior to this stretch, the right-hander had not given up a hit in the 4th inning in seven starts to begin the year, issuing just one walk with four strikeouts in that inning.

BANANA SPLIT: Winn's trademark is his splitter, which he's been using 41.0% of the time this season...19 of his 40 strikeouts this season have come off the pitch and he's limiting opponents to a .228 clip with six extra-base hits...batters were 1-for-8 with four strikeouts and a walk off Winn's splitter in his last start on Sunday...his 41.0% splitter usage this season is the highest of any starting pitcher in MLB.

KEEP THEM GROUNDED: Winn has been successful at inducing ground balls early in his career...his 53.3% ground ball rate this season is 10th-best in MLB among pitchers with at least 40.0 innings this season.

UNDERLYING DATA: Batters have been hitting the ball hard off Winn this year...his 93.3 mph average exit velocity this season is the highest figure in MLB among qualified pitchers...his 51.1% hard hit rate also ranks in the bottom 3% of the league.

LEFT ON READ: Lefties are 16-for-80 (.200) off him this season with 24 strikeouts...however, they are 12-for-their-last-34 with five extra-base hits off him over his last five starts.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 6/12 vs. HOU, SV, 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Converted his 12th save of the season on Wednesday...is 12-for-14 in save opportunities this season.
- ▶ Issued 19 walks in 27.1ip...his 15.2% walk rate is in the bottom 4% of the league.
- ▶ Righties are just 8-for-53 (.151) with three extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 15-for-53 (.283) with six extra-base hits.
- ▶ Has struck out 35 batters over 27.1 innings of work (11.52 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 20 of his 35 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .368 (7-for-19) off his sinker this year.

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, Cutter, Changeup, Knuckle Curve

Last Game: 6/14 vs. LAA; 1.0ip, k (9 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last seven outings, he's thrown 10.1 innings and allowed just one run (solo HR) on two hits with six strikeouts (0.87 ERA).
- ▶ SF has won 11 of the last 15 games he's appeared in.
- ▶ Has recorded at least five outs in 10 of his 20 games w/SF.
- ▶ Since April 30, Hjelle has a 1.18 ERA (5er, 25.0ip) with 25 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has a 65.1% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 6/14 vs. LAA; 1.0ip (15 pitches)

- ▶ Hasn't allowed a run in six of his last seven outings (7.2ip) and hasn't given up a hit in four of those games.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.
- ▶ Lefties are 11-for-31 (.355) off him with six RBI...righties are just 9x45 (.200).
- ▶ Has a 9.64 ERA on the road (9.1ip) and a 1.69 ERA at home (10.2ip).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 6/14 vs. LAA; 1.0ip (16 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first career Major League win last Saturday after throwing 1.0 scoreless inning with two strikeouts.
- ▶ Has served as an opener four times this season...allowed one run on two hits in 4.2 innings in those four starts (1.93 ERA).
- ▶ Over his last 13 games dating to May 15 he's allowed four runs (two earned) in 11.1 innings (1.59 ERA) with 14 strikeouts.
- ▶ LHBs are 6-for-40 (.150) off him and RHBs are 16-for-71 (.225) with five home runs (one inside the park) and 11 RBI.
- ▶ Opponents are 8-for-48 (.167) off his changeup with 13 strikeouts.
- ▶ Has allowed 15 walks in 31.2 innings.

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 6/14 vs. LAA; 2.2ip, 3h, 4er, 4er, hr, bb, k (44 pitches)

- ▶ Gave up a career-high four earned runs last night.
- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on May 2 and made his MLB debut on May 4 at Philadelphia.
