Friday's Top Performance

SAM PETERSEN (SCO/WSH No. 24/OF) went 4-for-4 with a double, a home run, three RBI, two runs scored and eight total bases. He is on a four-game hitting streak.

SEAVER KING (SCO/WSH No. 7/INF) went 2-for-4 with a two-run single and a pair of runs scored.

STARLYN CABA (MSS/MIA No. 5/INF) went 3-for-5 with 3 RBI, including his second AFL home run and a two-run single, both in the first inning.

JOSHUA KURODA-GRAUER (MSS/ATH No. 10/INF) went 3-for-4 with a double and a stolen base. Grauer is now slashing .361/.410/.556 and is batting .500 (10-for-20) on a five-game hitting streak.

RYAN LASKO (MSS/ATH No. 17/OF) added to the Mesa lead with a two-run single. Lasko now leads the Solar Sox with a .373 average.

DANTE NORI (SUR/PHI No. 6/OF) drove in a pair on an RBI single to center field in the seventh inning, capping off seven unanswered runs for the Saguaros.

BROCK RODDEN (PEO/SEA No. 22/INF) went 2-for-3 on a double and home run, also adding one walk and two RBI.

PATRICK CLOHISY (GLD/ATL/OF) tied **ENRIQUE BRADFIELD JR.** (PEO/BAL/No. 4) for the league lead in stolen bases. Clohisy stole three while Bradfield Jr. added one as both are tied with 17.

CUTTER COFFEY (GLD/TOR No. 27/INF) had a bases-clearing, go-ahead, three-run double in the third that put Glendale up for good.

FALL LEAGUE TO FALL CLASSIC: In the 2025 World Series, 21 of the 52 active players (40.4%) between the Dodgers and Blue Jays are Arizona Fall League alum.

Today's Headlines

Glendale @ Mesa: The Desert Dogs got back in the win column Friday, helped out by a three-inning, six-strikeout start by RHP **Darlin Saladin** (GLD/STL). Glendale will have six-foot-eight RHP **Luke Sinnard** (ATL No. 16) on the mound. The 2024 third-round pick has allowed one run in three starts. He punched out a season-high five in a scoreless start against Peoria on Oct. 25. He has 11 total strikeouts in eight innings compared to two walks.

On the other side will be RHP **Nathan Dettmer** (ATH). Dettmer is making his fourth appearance and second start in the AFL. The fifth round pick in 2023 out of Texas A&M made 25 appearances (20 starts) across Single-A Stockton and High-A Lansing, tossing 109 1/3 innings.

Peoria @ Surprise: The Javelinas piggyback off of the best ERA in the AFL with MLB's No. 80 prospect RHP **Rhett Lowder** (CIN No. 5). Lowder has appeared in two innings in all three starts. He has a 68.3 strike percentage while having not allowed a walk. The No. 7 overall pick in 2023 out of Wake Forest made six starts with the Reds in 2024, allowing four runs across 30 2/3 innings pitched (1.17 ERA) and striking out 22.

Despite eight runs given up in the first two innings, the Saguaros bullpen did not allow a run in the final five innings, helped out by two shutout innings from **Matt Jachec** (CLE/RHP) with two strikeouts and a scoreless frame from **Joey Danielson** (TEX/RHP), where he struck out the side. Surprise will hand the ball off to **Jack Dallas** (PHI) for his fourth appearance. He has not allowed a run in seven innings, striking out 11. The 26-year-old made three starts in 31 appearances.

Salt River @ Scottsdale: RHP **Luis Peralas** (BOS No. 9) makes his fifth start in the AFL. He has struck out 11 in eight innings pitched. Of his 20 fastballs in his last outing, 10 were 99.0 mph or above, with a pair hitting triple digits.

The last two NFP AFL Pitchers of the Week, **Anderson Brito** (SCO/HOU No. 7/ RHP) and **James Hicks** (SCO/HOU No. 26/RHP), combined for six scoreless innings, allowing one hit, one unearned run, and 10 strikeouts. Hicks is the only qualified pitcher to have not allowed a run, while Brito is second in the AFL in strikeouts. Scottsdale now sends out the AFL leader in strikeouts (23) in LHP **Jake Bennett** (WSH No. 10). Bennett is making his fifth appearance (fourth start). In 15 innings, Bennett is striking out 13.8 batters per nine innings.
