BE A GOLDFISH: The Giants will play their 100th game of the season tonight as they open a three-game series vs. the Royals... SF is currently 1-2 on this six-game road trip after dropping its series in Seattle over the weekend.

- ▶ The Giants enter today at 42-57 (.424)...the record is tied with the A's for the fifth-lowest winning percentage in MLB, ahead only of the Mets (42-58, .420), Royals (40-60, .400), Rockies (40-61, .396) and Angels (39-61, .390).
- ▶ SF's 42 wins through the team's first 99 games are its fewest since going 38-61 (.384) to start the 2017 season.
- ▶ The Giants need a win tonight to avoid losing 58 of their first 100 games for just the 10th time in franchise history (sixth in SF era).

I BELIEVE IN HOPE. I BELIEVE IN 'BELIEVE': The Giants and Royals have faced off just 28 times in the regular season, with SF going 11-17 (.393) against them in the history of their matchup.

- ▶ The 11-17 record is tied for SF's second-lowest winning percentage against any single opponent (also: vs. CWS), trailing only its 8-19 (.296) mark against the Yankees.
- ▶ However, SF has won five of its last seven games against the Royals dating to April 9, 2023...they have outscored them 24-15 in that span, with Giants pitchers sporting a 1.57 ERA (11er, 63.0ip).

BE CURIOUS, NOT JUDGMENTAL: The Giants make their first visit to Kauffman Stadium since Sept. 20-22, 2024, when they swept the Royals in three games while outscoring them 13-1.

- ▶ According to *Stats, LLC*, the one run allowed by SF's pitching staff stands as the fewest allowed by the Giants in a three-game road series since May 24-26, 1960 at Philadelphia (also one).

HE'S HERE, HE'S THERE, HE'S EVERYWHERE!: IF Bryce Eldridge hit a solo homer in the 1st inning yesterday to record his 10th home run of the season...at 21 years, 272 days old, he became the first Giants batter age 21 or younger to have double-digit home runs in a season since **Jack Clark** (13) in 1977.

- ▶ He is the youngest infielder to do so since **Orlando Cepeda** (26) and **Willie McCovey** (13) both did it in 1959.
- ▶ Eldridge has 30 walks to go along with his 10 homers in 57 games so far this season...according to *Stats, LLC*, he is the first Giants rookie to reach those numbers before August since **Chili Davis** in 1982 (see full chart to the right).

THE HARDER YOU WORK, THE LUCKIER YOU GET: RHP Trevor McDonald takes the hill for SF tonight to make his 14th start of the season...the right-hander is coming off one of the strongest starts of his early career, when he tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball and allowed just three hits vs. the Rockies on July 12.

- ▶ McDonald has pitched well on the road this year, posting a 3.19 ERA (11er, 31.0ip) in six road starts compared to a 6.62 ERA (26er, 35.1ip) mark in seven starts at home...SF has gone 4-2 in this six road starts.
- ▶ In his last road start on July 1 at Arizona, the righty tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just one batter to reach safely (a single by AZ's Ketel Marte)...per *Stats, LLC*, McDonald became just the third Giants rookie in franchise history to allow just one batter to reach base (hit, walk or HBP) in 6.0+ innings (home or away), joining **Doc Crandall** (1908 at STL) and **Virgil Barnes** (1922 vs. CHC).

YOU SAY IMPOSSIBLE, BUT ALL I HEAR IS I'M POSSIBLE: The Giants are in the midst of a stretch in which they are facing three consecutive AL opponents (Mariners, Royals and Angels)...in fact, SF faces Interleague opponents for eight of its 11 series following the All-Star break, also visiting the Rangers, Guardians and Red Sox and hosting the Tigers and Astros within the next month.

- ▶ SF's 9-15 (.375) record in Interleague play this season is lowest in the NL and fourth-lowest in MLB, ahead only of the Angels (9-18), Twins (12-21) and Astros (10-17).



JULY 20, 2018

Andrew McCutchen recorded eight putouts in a 4-1 win over the Athletics, becoming the first Giants right fielder to have eight or more putouts in a 9-inning game since **Randy Winn** also had eight on April 7, 2006.

T-MAC: Was the Giants' 11th-round pick in 2019 out of George County High School in Lucedale, MS...originally committed to South Alabama for college ball before signing...made his debut with SF during the final game of the 2024 season and has made appearances at the Major League level in each season since.

LAST TIME OUT: Finished the first half strong with 7.0 innings of one-run ball versus the Rockies on July 12 at Oracle Park...allowed just three hits, one walk and struck out four in SF's 3-1 win...he unfortunately did not factor into the decision...he had a much more effective day with his sinker with Rockies hitters going 1-for-11 on the offering...in his prior start against Toronto, Blue Jays hitters were 9-for-15 off the pitch.

LINE CHANGE?: McDonald threw 17 changeups to Colorado in his last start, his second-highest single game total in his brief MLB career behind 20 versus the Dodgers on May 11 earlier this year...overall, had an even usage rate for both his changeup and slider in the game versus Colorado for the first time all year...typically, his slider has been his go-to secondary offering with it being used 26.3% of the time this season.

WIDE TURN OF THE CORNER?: July has been a mixed bag thus far for McDonald with two of his three outings being at least 6.0 innings and one or fewer runs allowed...the other outing, however, he allowed a career-worst eight runs on 11 hits in just 2.1 innings to the Blue Jays on July 7...he was singled all over the yard in that outing versus Toronto with nine of the 11 hits being singles and many balls not solidly struck (the xBA on the singles was .342 compared to the actual .600 BA)...regardless, he wasn't able to course correct.

AL OVEREXPOSURE?: Is facing the Royals for the first time in his young career...in an extremely small sample size, all of his toughest outings this season have come against AL foes...in his three starts against American League teams he's 1-2 with an 11.37 ERA (16er, 12.2ip) with opponents hitting .339 off him...in his 10 starts against NL opponents he owns a 3.52 ERA (21er, 53.2ip) with NL hitters batting .230.

EXTREME SPLITS: In his 13 starts at the MLB level this year, McDonald has limited right-handed hitters to a .202 average with a .506 OPS and just three extra-base hits allowed (all doubles)...lefties, however, have a .296 average with an .867 OPS off McDonald...lefties have eight doubles, a triple and six homers...he did do well against Colorado's lefties in his last start, limiting them to one hit in 13 at-bats...the one hit, however, was a homer.

GROUNDDED: Entering this start he owns a 55.1% groundball rate, which sits in the 95th percentile among Major Leaguers...his 55.1% groundball rate is fourth-best in the Majors if you lower the innings threshold to 60.0...he trails PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (57.6%), STL's Andre Pallante (55.7%) and LAA's Walbert Ureña (55.2%).

ORDER UP...: He's been most effective the first time through the order this year with hitters going a combined 21-for-107 (.196) with a .642 OPS...it goes upward from there with opposing hitters hitting .290 with a .738 OPS the second time through and .292 with a .753 OPS the third time through.

ROAD TRIPPIN': Has pitched to a 3.19 ERA (11er, 31.0ip) in six starts on the road this year compared to a 6.62 ERA (26er, 35.1ip) in seven home starts...SF has gone 4-2 in this six road starts versus a 2-5 mark in his starts at Oracle Park.

IN TRIPLE-A IN 2026: Went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (9er, 15.0ip), 12 strikeouts and a 1.53 WHIP in five Triple-A games (four starts) for Sacramento...was much better at home (1-0 with a 2.79 ERA in three games) than on the road (0-1 with a 10.13 ERA in two games).
