THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 to begin their seven-game, eight-day homestand, losing three-straight games to the Tigers from Thursday-Saturday, followed by a win on Sunday afternoon... today, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the first of three games against the Athletics through Thursday afternoon.

TWINS FOUGHT THE LAW AND THE TWINS WON: The Twins beat Chris Paddack and the Tigers on Sunday afternoon by a score of 8-1, snapping their three-game losing streak...Thomas Hatch (2-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched... Michael Tonkin (1.0), Cole Sands (1.0), Génesis Cabrera (1.0) and Erasmo Ramirez (1.0) combined to pitch 4.0 perfect innings of relief, with eight strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Byron Buxton, who homered (25) and singled twice...Brooks Lee hit his first career grand slam and first for a Twin this season...Royce Lewis hit his sixth home run of the season and first at Target Field since September 1, 2024.

STRAIGHT A's: The Twins and A's are playing the fifth of seven games this season...the Twins played four games in Sacramento from June 2-5, winning the first three and losing game four...Minnesota outscored the A's 26-8 in the first three, then lost 3-14 in the finale.

◆When the Twins left Sacramento on June 5, they were 34-28...since that final game, Minnesota has gone 24-38.

◆Twins are 9-2 in their last 11 against the A's, 15-3 in their last 18 and 19-4 in their last 23, dating back to May of 2022.

◆A win tonight would secure the season series over the A's for the fourth consecutive season... they went 6-1 in 2024, 5-1 in 2023 and 5-1 in 2022.

◆Byron Buxton is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 13 RBI, a .571 slugging percentage and a .940 OPS in his last 10 games against the A's.

◆Trevor Larnach is hitting .306 (15-for-49) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks and an .816 OPS in 13 career games against the A's...in those 14, he is hitting .327 (16-for-49) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.073 OPS.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Twins have gone 10-3 against California teams this season, going 3-0 vs. Los Angeles-AL (April 25-27), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11), 3-1 against the Athletics (June 2-5) and 1-2 at Los Angeles-NL (July 21-24)...later this season, the Twins will host the Padres (3 G, August 29-31), and play in Anaheim (3 G, September 8-10).

FIRE ON THE MOUND-TAIN: Over his last 19 starts (18 games), since April 27, Joe Ryan has gone 11-3, 2.41 ERA (112.0 IP, 30 ER) with 24 walks, 125 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average...below are his AL ranks since that date:

THE LEFTOVERS: Tonight marks the 25th time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 8-16 against lefty starters...they have lost their last three games vs. a left-handed starter, a 2-0 defeat on August 8 vs. Noah Cameron and the Royals, a 9-1 defeat on August 12 vs. Carlos Rodón in Yankee Stadium and a 4-3 defeat on Thursday vs. Tarik Skubal and the Tigers...their last win against a lefty starter was a 5-4 victory on August 3 at Cleveland over Joey Cantillo.

₱ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with a .933 OPS in his last 24 games vs. lefties.

₱ Brooks Lee is hitting .355 (25-for-77) with a .787 OPS in his last 24 games vs. lefties.

₱ Brooks Lee is hitting .300 (21-for-70) with four doubles, one triple, six home runs, 11 RBI, a .643 slugging percentage and a 1.021 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season.

₱ Austin Martin is 6-for-17 (.353) at the major league level vs. lefties this season, including one home run.

Matt Wallner is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with a 1.054 OPS in his last 19 games against left-handed pitching...he has 11 hits against lefties this season...he entered 2025 with 14 career hits off lefties, from 2022-24...had a .510 OPS entering 2025, but has an .828 OPS in 2025.

BUCK-TASTIC: Byron Buxton hit his 25th home run of the season on Sunday and is now three short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 32 home runs.

♣ He has a 14.16 at-bat-per-home run ratio, fifth-best in the AL and eighth-best in baseball, trailing Cal Raleigh (9.83), Aaron Judge (10.56), Kyle Schwarber (10.81), Shohei Ohtani (11.12), Eugenio Suárez (11.87), Junior Caminero (13.31) and Shea Langeliers (13.81).

♣ Over his last 43 games, Buxton is hitting 305 (50-for-164) with nine doubles, one triple, 15 home runs, 23 RBI, 36 runs scored, 14 walks, a .365 on-base percentage, a .646 slugging percentage and a 1.011 OPS.

♣ Buck has a .966 OPS at home this season, seventh-highest in baseball, trailing Aaron Judge (1.119), Shohei Ohtani (1.025), Kyle Schwarber (.988), Junior Caminero (.979), Will Smith (.968) and Zach McKinstry (.966).

CHILD OF THE CORN: High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Ty Langenberg yesterday was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week...the 23-year-old made the start on Thursday vs. Quad Cities, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...the Urbandale, IA native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Iowa.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2007, Johan Santana set a club record with 17 strikeouts against the Rangers at the Metrodome, allowing two hits (both to Sammy Sosa - one single and one double) and no walks in 8.0 innings as Joe Nathan pitched the ninth inning and the Twins beat the Rangers 1-0...Michael Cuddyer provided the game's only run with a homer.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his 12th win of the season - one shy of his career high (13 in 2022) - on August 13 at Yankee Stadium, opposite Cam Schlittler, in Minnesota's 4-1 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and seven strikeouts over 6.2 innings of work...lone run scored came on a third-inning solo home run by Cody Bellinger...marked his 13th quality start of the season, one shy of his career high of 14 (2023)...threw a season-high 102 pitches.

4 Has worked 5.0-or-more innings in all 24 appearances this season, becoming the fifth pitcher (ninth time) in Twins history (1961-) to do so in each of his first 24 games to start the season and the first since Johan Santana did so in 32-straight in 2007.

600 CLUB: Ryan's 609.1 career innings pitched make him the 38th pitcher in Twins history to reach the 600.0 IP mark; Glen Perkins ranks 37th with 624.1 innings pitched...his 609.1 IP are the 14th most all-time among Twins pitchers (1961-) through their first 107 career games...among Twins pitchers with 600.0-or-more innings pitched through their first 107 career games, Ryan's 678 strikeouts are the most; Bert Blyleven is the next closest with 615 K in 763.2 IP...also, his .592 win percentage ranks first, his 136 walks ranks second and his 3.65 ERA ranks fourth.

FACING THE ATHLETICS: In three career starts against the A's, is 2-0 with a 4.67 ERA (17.1 IP, 9 ER), seven walks and 16 strikeouts...earned the win in his last start against the A's in Sacramento on June 2, allowing four runs on six hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts over 5.0 innings.

◆ In his career, A's batters are hitting .219 (14-for-64) with three doubles, three home runs, a .320 on-base percentage, a .406 slugging percentage and a .726 OPS against Ryan.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': The San Francisco native is 7-3 in 13 career starts against California teams, with a 4.85 ERA (72.1 IP, 39 ER), 23 walks and 87 strikeouts (1x LAD, SD; 3x ATH; 4x SF, LAA)...here is how he ranks among Twins pitchers with five-or-more starts against California teams since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In 11 home starts (12 appearances) this season, is 6-3 with a 3.03 ERA (65.1 IP, 22 ER), seven home runs, 15 walks and 80 strikeouts, compared to 6-2 with a 2.44 ERA (73.2 IP, 20 ER), nine home runs, 12 walks and 73 strikeouts in 12 home starts...in 55 career home games (54 starts), is 25-15 with a 3.58 ERA, a 5.03 strikeout-to-walk ratio and a .209 opponent batting average.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .226/.276/.385 with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 13 walks and 64 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .175/.236/.293 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 14 walks and 89 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .211/.270/.367 with 75 walks and 273 strikeouts (3.64 K/BB), while right-handed hitters are slashing .225/.271/.419 with 61 walks and 405 strikeouts (6.64 K/BB).

© His .175 BAA against righties ranks second among all qualified pitchers in baseball this season and his .529 opponent OPS vs. righties ranks fifth.

THE ARSENAL: Through 24 appearances (23 starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix...here

is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

5.0 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 94th percentile and his 28.2 percent strikeout rate ranks in the 86th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.2 mph and his hard-hit rate is 41.5 percent.
◆ His overall pitching run value of 20 ranks in baseball's 96th percentile.

₱ His fastball run value of 22 ranks in baseball's 99th percentile...his 87 strikeouts via the four-seamer are the second-most in the majors behind San Francisco's Robbie Ray (89).
