YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers lost to the Cubs, 6-1, in Phoenix for their fourth straight defeat..... William Contreras drove in the lone run for Milwaukee with an RBI-double.....CF Garrett Mitchell went 2-for-3.

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders.....there are 18 non-roster invitees; 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons..... the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs.... the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020).....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.... his only other Major League managerial experience came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JOE ROSS

RHP Joe Ross, 30, signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on Dec. 12.....Ross was in the Giants organization last season as he retured from "Tommy John" surgery in August and appeared in 8 games (7 starts) in the minors.....Ross last pitched in the Major Leagues in 2021 with Washington, his only big league team (2015-21).....he did not pitch in 2020 as he opted out of the season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....Ross is signed through the 2024 season.....he was a member of the 2019 World Series-champion Nationals.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Elvis Peguero, who turns 27 on March 20, went 4-5 with a 3.38 ERA and 1 save in 59 relief appearances last season.....he held opponents to a .222 batting average.....he has also pitched in the Major Leagues with Los Angeles-AL (2021-22).....Peguero was acquired from the Angels on 11/22/22 as part of the trade for OF Hunter Renfroe.

RHP Abner Uribe, 23, made his Major League debut last season, going 1-0 with a 1.76 ERA and 1 save in 32 relief appearances with Milwaukee.....he held opponents to a .154 batting average with 39 strikeouts in 30.2 innings.....he signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent out of the Dominican Republic on 7/2/18.

RHP Sam Carlson, 25, signed with Milwaukee on Nov. 30 and is a non-roster invitee.....he was selected by Seattle in the second round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and spent his career (2017-23) in the Mariners farm system prior to joining the Brewers.
