Today's Headlines

Tyler Gentry (KC) blasted two home runs for the Surprise Saguaros on Tuesday, going 2-for-4 with three RBI. His production proved decisive in the Saguaros' 8-6 win over the Salt River Rafters, and his 1.000 slugging percentage now ranks fourth in the AFL.

Nick Gonzales (PIT) went 2-for-2 with a double on Thursday, driving in two runs for the Surprise Saguaros. The infielder reached base safely in all four of his plate appearances (2 BB), and he now holds a .455/.538/.727 batting slash this fall (5-for-11).

Mesa

Allan Winans (ATL) pitched five innings for the Scottsdale Scorpions on Thursday, the longest pitching appearance in the 2022 AFL through four days of action. Winans allowed zero earned runs and one hit, striking out four in a 5-2 win over the Mesa Solar Sox.

Pedro Pages (STL) had a 2-for-4 showing on Thursday with a double and home run, driving in three of Salt River's six runs on the afternoon. The right-handed-hitting catcher now has an AFL slash of .286/.375/.857 in three total games (2-for-8).

Drew Millas (WSH) had a 3-for-5 showing with a home run and double for the Peoria Javelinas on Thursday. He collected four RBI in an eventual 9-8 victory over the Glendale Desert Dogs. Millas has posted a .333/.333/.778 batting slash this fall (3-for-9).

The Peoria Javelinas and Scottsdale Scorpions are currently tied for the best team ERA in the Fall League (3.75), while the Surprise Saguaros lead the AFL with a .955 OPS. All six AFL teams have scored between 26-30 runs and posted between 35-38 hits.

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Troy Percival (Scottsdale Scorpions, 1992) was a sixth-round selection in the 1990 MLB Draft, making his way to the Fall League during his third year as a professional. A converted Minor League catcher, Percival played in the AFL as a pitcher, going on to record the 13th-most saves in MLB history (358). Percival played a combined 14 years in the big leagues with the Angels, Tigers, Cardinals and Rays, pitching 708.2 career innings with a 3.17 ERA and 781 strikeouts. An alumnus of the University of California, Riverside, Percival later served as the head baseball coach at his alma mater.
