The 2025 Baltimore Orioles Media Guide, as well as the latest game YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles were shut out last night by the Red Sox, 3-0, setting up the season's first rubber match this afternoon.

- $heta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle b}$ Baltimore was shut out for the first time since September 17, 2024 vs. San Francisco (10-0) and the first against Boston since September 23, 2023 at Oriole Park (3-0).
- (9.3 Garrett Crochet became the first opposing pitching to throw 8.0+ scoreless innings against the Orioles since SEA's George Kirby (9.0 IP, 3 H) on August 12, 2023, and the first opponent to do so at Camden Yards since ATL's Max Fried (9.0 IP, 4 H) on August 20, 2021.
- $oldsymbol{ heta}_{\!\scriptscriptstyle A}$ Baltimore recorded one at-bat with runners in scoring position, its fewest overall since September 13, 2024 at Detroit (1 AB) and its fewest against Boston since May 2, 2017 (1 AB).
- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle B}$ The O's saw their season-opening streak of five straight games scoring the first run of the game come to an end, falling one game shy of tying the 2013 Orioles for the franchise record (since 1954).
- 2 Zach Eflin extended his career-best streak to 12 straight starts allowing three runs or fewer, tied with TOR's Bowden Francis for the longest active run in the AL.

MORE-TON THE MERRIER: Charlie Morton is 8-2 with a 4.21 ERA (39 ER/83.1 IP) in 15 career starts against the Red Sox...The eight wins are tied with the Cincinnati for his second most against any single opponent behind Miami (14)...The eight victories mark the third most against Boston among all active MLB pitchers behind both Alex Cobb and Kevin Gausman (9).

TYLER THE CREATOR: Tyler O'Neill has eight hits in his first five games with Baltimore, becoming one of five Orioles to accomplish the feat since 2017, joining with Tim Beckham (13, 2017), Jonathan Villar (9, 2018), Eloy Jiménez (8, 2024), and Jose Iglesias (8, 2020).

HIGH'S AND LOWS: Baltimore hitters have slashed .373/.427/.673 (41-for-110) with six doubles, nine home runs, 29 RBI, and nine walks in three wins, compared to .172/.235/.215 (16-for-93) with one double, one home run, two RBI, and eight walks in three losses. Θ The O's rank among the AL in OPS (2^{nd} , .804), slugging percentage (2^{nd} , .463), runs (T- 2^{nd} ,

32), hits (T-2nd, 57), and home runs (3rd, 10).

IF THE SOX FIT: The O's and Red Sox conclude a three-game set this afternoon at Camden Yards...Baltimore travels to Boston for a four-game series from May 22-25 and a two-game set from September 18-19 before closing the season series with a four-game set in Baltimore from August 25-28.

- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle A}$ Ramón Urías is 52-for-144 (.361) with seven doubles, one triple, six home runs, 26 runs, 23 RBI, and 12 walks in 50 career games opposite Boston...Min. 125 at-bats, his .361 career average against the Red Sox is second highest among all active players behind LAD's Freddie Freeman (.366).
- θ_{λ} Jordan Westburg has reached base safely in 10 of 12 career games against the Red Sox, slashing .353/.476/.647 (12-for-34) with four doubles, two home runs, and seven RBI... he and Adley Rutschman have both reached base safely in six straight games vs. Boston.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: The Orioles recorded nine wins by seven or more runs at home in 2024, tied with Philadelphia for the second most such wins in MLB behind Arizona (12)...The nine wins also tied a franchise record (since 1954), matching the 1985, 1983, and 1969 Orioles.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde moved into sole possession of fourth place in Orioles history with his 408th win on March 29 at Toronto...The victory broke a tie with Hank Bauer...The 2023 AL Manager of the Year trails Earl Weaver (1,480), Buck Showalter (669), and Paul Richards (517).

OPENING DAY RECAP: The Orioles opened their 72nd season in Baltimore by beating the Blue 12-2, on Thursday at Rogers Centre.

- he O's improved to 47-25 all time on Opening Day...The .653 winning percentage in the first game of the season since the team moved in 1954 is the best in the majors during that time.
- Baltimore has won the last three Opening Days by a combined score of 33-14...The Orioles' streak of scoring at least 10 runs in the first game of the year ties the MLB record, held by the Cincinnati Reds (1893-95) and Milwaukee Brewers (1994-96), per the Elias Sports Bureau.
- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle A}$ The team's six home runs are a franchise record on Opening Day... the O's six homers are tied for the second most on Opening Day in MLB history, trailing only the eight by the Los Angeles Dodgers on March 28, 2019 vs. Arizona.
- Tyler O'Neill homered in the third inning to extend his MLB record by going deep in his sixth consecutive Opening Day...The previous record was four held by three players. O'Neill is the first Canadian to homer on Opening Day in his home country.
- Cedric Mullins and Adley Rutschman both hit two home runs, tying the most on Opening Day in team history...Entering Thursday, only two Orioles in franchise history had multi-homer games on Opening Day: Sam Horn on April 9, 1990 at Kansas City and National Baseball Hall of Famer Brooks Robinson on April 6, 1973 vs. Milwaukee.
- Mullins set a career high with five RBI and joined Horn (6 RBI, 4/9/90) as the only players in club history (since 1954) with 5+ RBI on Opening Day...Rutschman joined Don Baylor as the only players since 1900 to have 10 total hits in their first three career Opening Day games, per the Elias Sports Bureau.

2024 RECAP: Baltimore went 91-71, securing the first Wild Card spot in the AL and finishing 3.0 games behind New York in the AL East...The O's have made the Postseason in back-to-back

QUICK HITS: Morton is set to make his home debut as an Oriole today against the Red Sox...Made four Grapefruit League starts, recording a 3.38 ERA (3 ER/8.0 IP) on nine hits and one walk with six strikeouts...Signed a one-year contract with the Orioles on January 3, 2025...Made 30 starts with the Braves in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.19 ERA (77 ER/165.1 IP) on 154 hits (23 HR), 85 total runs, 65 walks, and 18 hit batters with 167 strikeouts...Was on Atlanta's NLWC roster, but did not appear in a game.

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt the loss in his Orioles debut on March 28 at Toronto... Allowed four runs on seven hits and one walk with three strikeouts in 3.1 innings...All four runs scored in the fourth inning, with two coming after Morton exited the game... Threw 80 pitches, 48 strikes.

IF THE SOX FIT: He has made 15 career starts opposite Toronto, going 8-2 with a 4.21 ERA (39 ER/83.1 IP) on 80 hits (11 HR), 24 walks, and five hit batters with 88 strikeouts...Is 4-1 with a 4.14 ERA (21 ER/45.2 IP) on 44 hits (7 HR), eight walks, and

two hit batters with 57 strikeouts in eight career home starts against the Sox.

(b) In 54 career starts against AL East opponents, he is 23-14 with a 3.83 ERA (126 ER/296.0 IP) on 262 hits (30 HR), 102 walks, and 22 hit batters with 351 strikeouts.

LIKE FINE WINE: In his last start, at 41 years and 136 days old, Morton became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to start a game for the Orioles, surpassing Orlando Peña (39y, 177d) on May 13, 1973-G1 at New York-AL...The oldest pitcher to ever appear in a ame in club history is Jesse Orosco (42y, 160d) on September 28, 1999 at New York-AL.

His 167 strikeouts were the most by an Atlanta pitcher age 40 or older since Phil Niekro in 1980 (176).

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: Morton has made 30+ starts in each of his last six full seasons (excluding 2020) since 2018...He joins TOR's José Berríos, TEX's Patrick Corbin, and PHI's Aaron Nola as the only pitchers in MLB to accomplish the feat during that stretch...Morton had not reached the 30-start mark in each of his first 12 seasons from 2008-19.

Last season, he became the fifth player in Braves franchise history to make 30 starts in his age 40 season or older, joining R.A. Dickey (2017), Phil Niekro (1979-80, 82-83), John Smoltz (2007), and Warren Spahn (1961-63).

ABOVE THE CURVE: In 2024, Morton utilized his curveball 42.2 percent of the time, limiting opponents to a .200 (55-for-275) average on the offering while producing a 34.2 ercent whiff rate...Of his 167 strikeouts last season, 102 came on the curveball (61.1%).

He held left handed hitters to a .181 (26-for-144) clip against the curveball with 62 strikeouts, compared to .221 (29-for-131) with 40 strikeouts against right handers.

<u>MERRY-GO-ROUND:</u> Snapped an eight-start streak of allowing multiple walks in his last start, which dated back to August 18, 2024 and tied the second-longest streak of his career (also 6/9-7/25/18)...Had $\bar{\text{a}}$ career-long 10-game stretch with multiple walks from 7/18-9/11/09.

IT'S A MARATHON: Last season, opponents slashed .272/.371/.491 (62-for-228) with 16 doubles, two triples, 10 home runs and 27 walks against Morton from innings 1-2... from innings 3-5, however, he limited the opposition to a .230/.314/.390 (69-for-300) line with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, and 29 walks.

UP'S AND DOWN'S: Morton's 3.97 run support average in 2024 was sixth lowest in MLB (min. 120.0 IP) behind PIT's Luis Ortiz (3.32), PIT's Jared Jones (3.48), WSH's Patrick Corbin (3.50), CIN's Hunter Greene (3.89), and STL's Andre Pallante (3.93).

Discrepance of the same parameter, Morton's 6.72 run support average in 2023 was third highest in the major behind SD's Michael Wacha (7.50) and CHC's Drew Smyly (6.83).

Since 2023, Morton is 19-4 with a 3.18 ERA (64 ER/181.1 IP) when receiving three runs or more of support, compared to 3-19 with a 4.96 ERA (83 ER/150.2 IP) when receiving two runs or fewer.

CHECKING THE BOXES: Last season. Morton earned the victory on June 28 vs. Pittsburgh. giving him a win against all 30 teams; became the 22nd pitcher to accomplish the feat since baseball's most recent expansion in 1998, and one of four active players (TOR's Max Scherzer, NYY's Gerrit Cole, and SF's Justin Verlander) to do so.
