**THE PIRATES:** had the day off on Thursday...Went 3-3 on their recent six-game road trip to Cleveland (2-1, July 18-19) and New York-AL (1-2, Monday-Wednesday)...Will begin a stretch of 20 straight games vs. the National League (11 of their next 14 games are vs. the National League Central) tonight (their next interleague game is on August 14 vs. Boston)...Have hit 132 home runs this season after hitting just 117 home runs all of last season...Have hit 71 home runs at home this season, tied with Cincinnati for the fifth-most in all of Major League Baseball (their record for the most home runs at PNC Park in a single season [since 2001] is 81, set in 2003)...Have the most hits (933) in all of Major League Baseball (Los Angeles-NL, 901, is second)...Have scored the second-most runs (543) in all of Major League Baseball, trailing only Washington (567), after scoring just 583 runs all of last season...Have struck out the fourth-most batters (943) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Philadelphia (1004), Milwaukee (997) and Cleveland (950)...Have the sixth-best run differential (+51) in all of Major League Baseball, trailing only Los Angeles-NL (+157), Milwaukee (+133), Atlanta (+106), New York-AL (+88) and Chicago-NL (+65).

**THE LONG ROAD AHEAD:** Pittsburgh is in the first day of a stretch of 17 straight days with a game...The Pirates will play three games vs. Chicago-NL (Friday-Sunday), three games vs. Arizona (July 27-29), four games at Cincinnati (July 30-August 2), four games at Milwaukee (August 3-6) and three games vs. New York-NL (August 7-9) before having the day off on August 10, prior to a three-game trip to Miami (August 11-13)...Their last stretch of 17 straight calendar days with a game came in 2023, when they played three games vs. Chicago-AL (April 7-9), three games vs. Houston (April 10-12), four games at St. Louis (April 13-16), three games at Colorado (April 17-19) and four games vs. Cincinnati (April 20-23)...The upcoming consecutive four-game series at Cincinnati and Milwaukee will mark the first time that Pittsburgh plays consecutive four-game series since August 3-10, 2023, when it played four games at Milwaukee (August 3-6) and four games vs. Atlanta (August 7-10)...The last time the Pirates did that in back-to-back road series came from Sept. 12-18, 2022, when they played four games at Cincinnati (Sept. 12-14) and four games at New York-NL (Sept. 15-18)...The Pirates have not done that in consecutive road series (excluding series with a doubleheader) since May 7-14, 2001, when they played four games at St. Louis (May 7-10) and four at Milwaukee (May 11-14).

**CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE:** The Pirates are 17-12 (.586) against the National League Central this season, having won or split seven of their first nine series against the division...Pittsburgh won two of three games from March 30-April 1 at Cincinnati, won two of three games from April 10-12 at Chicago, won two of three games from April 24-26 at Milwaukee, swept a three-game series from May 1-3 vs. Cincinnati, won two of three games from May 19-21 at St. Louis, split a four-game series from May 25-28 vs. Chicago and swept a three-game series from July 11-12 vs. Milwaukee (the team was swept in a four-game series from April 27-30 vs. St. Louis and lost two of three games from June 26-28 vs. Cincinnati)...The Pirates won or split only seven of their 16 series against the National League Central during the 2025 campaign...They have finished with a .500 or better record against the division in a season three times since it formed in 1994, coming in 1997 (.500, 24-24), 2013 (.592, 45-31) and 2018 (.566, 43-33).

**STARTING YINZ UP:** Mitch Keller pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in Game One on Wednesday at New York (AL), while Bubba Chandler tossed 6.1 scoreless innings in Game Two at Yankee Stadium...Pittsburgh is looking to have its starting pitcher toss at least 5.0 scoreless innings in three straight games for the first time since last year from July 25-27 vs. Arizona (Mike Burrows, Andrew Heaney, Paul Skenes)...The Pirates' 2.96 rotation ERA (27.1ip/9er) since the All-Star break is the third-best mark in MLB.

**PITTSBURGH LEFT:** The Pirates will face a left-handed starter in each of the next two games, when they take on the Cubs' Matthew Boyd (Friday) and Shota Imanaga (Saturday)...Pittsburgh has already faced a left-handed starter in six of its last eight games, dating back to Game Two of the July 11 doubleheader vs. Milwaukee...The Pirates' .297 batting average (43-for-145) vs. left-handed pitching since July 11 is fourth in Major League Baseball, behind Chicago-NL (.338), Texas (.311) & Baltimore (.308).

**THE GONZALEZ-Z/S BOYS:** Jacob Gonzalez (two-run, fifth inning) and Nick Gonzales (solo, seventh inning) both homered in Pittsburgh's 5-3, 10-inning win on Wednesday (G1) at New York (AL), marking the second time on the Pirates' recent road trip that both players homered in the same game...Gonzalez (two-run, second inning) and Gonzales (solo, sixth inning) also did that in the team's 7-1 win on July 18 (G1) at Cleveland...Gonzalez is 5-for-17 (.294) with a double, two home runs, five RBI, a 1.000 OPS and three runs in his first seven games with Pittsburgh (since July 12 vs. Milwaukee) after being acquired from Chicago (AL) on July 10...Gonzales is 27-for-68 (.397) with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, eight walks, a 1.079 OPS and 14 runs in 17 July games...His .397 July average ranks third in MLB, trailing Cleveland's Steven Kwan (.426) and Washington's Curtis Mead (.400).

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 24, 2018: The Pirates picked up their 11th consecutive win with a 9-4 victory over the Indians at Progressive Field, giving them their first 11-game winning streak since September 12-22, 1996. It was Pittsburgh's seventh consecutive game with at least six runs, something it had not done since May 23-30 (G2), 1946. The Pirates plated seven of their nine runs during the game's first two innings.

**AS OF LATE:** Jones won a 7-1 decision after allowing one run and striking out nine batters over 5.0 innings on July 18 (G1) at Cleveland...It marked his fourth career game with at least nine strikeouts, along with March 30, 2024 at Miami (10), May 4, 2024 vs. Colorado (10) and September 8, 2024 vs. Washington (nine)...Jones has become the only Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) with three or fewer hits allowed, one/zero runs allowed and at least six strikeouts in three consecutive outings.

**30 ROCK:** Jones retired his final four batters on July 2 at Philadelphia, retired each of his 18 batters on July 8 vs. Atlanta and retired his first eight batters on July 18 (G1) at Cleveland (Steven Kwan snapped the streak with a two-out single in the third inning)... Per the Elias Sports Bureau, Jones became one of only three Pirates pitchers in the last 70 years (since 1957) to retire at least 30 consecutive batters, joining Harvey Haddix (38 straight batters, May 21-26, 1959) & Jim Bibby (32 straight batters, May 19-24, 1981).

**SKY-HIGH JULY:** Jones is one of only six pitchers throughout all of Major League Baseball with at least 23 strikeouts and a 1.20 or lower ERA during the month of July... He is joined by Chicago (AL)'s Sean Burke (0.92 ERA and 25 K), Miami's Eury Pérez (0.95 ERA and 23 K) and Philadelphia's Jesús Luzardo (1.00 ERA and 27 K) on that short list... Jones is the only one on that list who has allowed five or fewer hits so far during July.

**AGAINST THE CUBS:** Jones is 1-2 with a 5.24 ERA (22.1ip/13er) and 19 strikeouts in four career starts against Chicago (NL), including a 6.30 ERA (10.0ip/7er) in two starts at PNC Park...He lost a 7-2 decision after allowing three runs (two earned) over 6.0 innings here on May 10, 2024, while also losing a 9-5 decision after giving up five runs over 4.0 innings here on August 27, 2024...Jones' last start against the Cubs came on September 2, 2024 at Wrigley Field, when he allowed three runs across his 6.1 innings.

**YOU'RE PERFECT:** Jones had a no-decision after striking out eight batters over 6.0 perfect innings in Pittsburgh's 3-0 loss on July 8 vs. Atlanta...He was the first Pirates pitcher in the Modern Era (since 1901) to have an outing of at least 6.0 perfect innings.

**2026 DEBUT:** Jones had a no-decision after allowing five runs and striking out six batters over 4.1 innings of work in Pittsburgh's 6-5, walkoff win on May 29 vs. Minnesota (Bryan Reynolds hit a game-ending, two-run blast in the ninth inning)...It marked his first Major League appearance since pitching 4.1 innings on September 27, 2024 at Yankee Stadium (he was reinstated from the 60-day injured list the same day).

**MAKING A COMEBACK:** Jones missed all of last year with a right elbow UCL sprain... He underwent right UCL surgery on May 21, 2025 (was performed by Dr. Keith Meister).

**ON THE MEND:** Jones had a 2.89 ERA (18.2ip/6er) and 24 strikeouts over five rehab starts split between Low-A Bradenton (one start, April 29 vs. Lakleand), Triple-A Indianapolis (two starts, May 6 [G1] vs. Omaha and May 23 at Toledo) and Double-A Altoona (two starts, May 12/17 vs. Harrisburg)...He had a 1.02 WHIP on the assignment.

**2024 IN REVIEW:** Jones went 6-8 with a 4.14 ERA (121.2ip/56er) and 132 strikeouts in 22 starts during his rookie season (2024)...His 132 strikeouts ranked sixth among all Major League rookies (his teammate, Paul Skenes, ranked fourth with 170 strikeouts).
