TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS: The Reds today placed on the 10-day injured list **SS Elly De La Cruz** (right hamstring strain); recalled from AAA-Louisville **INF Edwin Arroyo** (#2); selected from Louisville **LHP Brandon Leibrandt** (#58); designated for assignment **RHP Yunior Marte**.

- **De La Cruz** had appeared in each of Cin's previous 276 games beginning 7/30/24 vs **Chc**...is the third-longest consecutive games-played streak for a Red since 1970.
- **Arroyo** will make his Major League debut when he plays.
- **Leibrandt** is the son of 1985 **Royals** World Series champion, **Charlie**.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs former Red **Jeff Montgomery's Royals** and the fourth game (1-2) of a 6-game homestand that includes a 1-2 weekend series loss to the **Braves**.

- Following Wed's game vs **KC** and Thu's off day, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **StL** (6/5-6/7) and **SD** (6/8-6/10).

JUNE IS HERE: The Reds enter today's game **30-28** and in **fifth place** in the NL Central, **6.0** games behind division leader **Milwaukee**...Below are recent Reds teams entering June:

APRIL FLOWERS, MAY SHOWERS: The Reds opened the month of May with an 8-game losing streak and lost 13 of the month's first 17 games but won 6 of its final 10 games.

- Went 20-11 (.645) to open the 2026 season...entered May a season-high 9 games over .500 and in first place in the NL Central (+1.0).
- Ended the month 2 games over .500 and in fifth place (-6.0).
- The Reds lost 9 games in May in which they held a lead.

BLEDAY IN MAY: In yesterday's 6-4 win vs **Atl**, **LF JJ Bleday** went 2-for-4 with 2 doubles and 2 RBI.

- For the month of May, **Bleday** slashed .301/.387/.631 with 8 HR, 25 RBI, 8 2B, 1 3B, 65 TB, and a 1.018 OPS in 27 games (31-for-103).
- He led all National League players for the month in slugging pct and total bases while ranking among the leaders in RBI (T1st) and HR (T3rd).
- Since being recalled from AAA-Louisville on 4/26, he's slashing .303/.398/.642 with 9 HR, 26 RBI, and a 1.041 OPS in 30 games.

ABBOTT AND BURNS: **LHP Andrew Abbott** and **RHP Chase Burns** combined for a 7-1 record in May with a 1.23 ERA and 6 quality starts (10 starts)...the rest of the starting staff went 2-9 with a 7.00 ERA and 2 quality starts (17 gs).

- **Abbott** went 3-1, 1.29 in May (5gs) and allowed just 4 extra-base hits for the month (all homers)...he owns a 1.69 ERA over 16 career starts in the month of May, the lowest mark by any Major Leaguer with at least 16 starts in May since earned runs became an official stat in 1913.
- **Burns** went 4-0, 1.19 in May (5gs)...he held opponents to a .155/.216/.301 slash and allowed just 4 runs and 16 hits for the month.

SMART STEERING: **OF/INF Spencer Steer** has reached safely in a career-high 19 consecutive games dating back to 5/9 vs **Hou**...it's the longest active streak in the majors...he's hit safely in 27 of his last 30 games (.315/.387/.450).

- Since 4/18, Steer is slashing .309/.394/.456 in 38 games (42-for-136, 4hr, 16rbi, 12xbh, 61 times on base).
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 26g in LF, 24g at 1B, 15g in RF, 6g at 2B, and 2g at 3B...appeared at 5 different pos. over last 17g.

SERIES NOTES:

- The Reds are 19-22 all-time vs **KC**, including 4-11 here at **Great American Ball Park** and 13-8 at **Kauffman Stadium**.
- The Reds took 2 of 3 games last season (5/26-5/28) at **KC** and have won 8 of the last 13 games vs the **Royals**...their 3-2 loss on 5/28 snapped their 6-game winning streak at **Kauffman Stadium**, dating back to 2021.
- Of the 16 completed **Reds/Royals** series, 9 have resulted in sweeps.
- The first game of the **June 1999** series was postponed because of a power failure...the Reds swept the next day's doubleheader, 9-4 and 7-4 in 10 innings, before winning the series finale, 14-3...was the first doubleheader in interleague history.

SAVE THE LAST DANCE FOR ME: In yesterday's 6-4 win vs **Atl**, **LHP Sam Moll** earned his second career save, his first since 6/27/23 for **Oak** vs **NY**, a span of 1,069 days (2 years, 11 months, 4 days).

- **Moll** became the eighth different pitcher this season to earn a save for the Redlegs (also: **Antone**, **Ashcraft**, **Burke**, **Johnson**, **Pagán**, **Phillips**, **Santillan**)...the **Reds**, **Nationals** (8) and **Twins** (11) are the only teams in the majors to have saves from 8 different pitchers in 2026.

POWER SURGE: The Reds have homered 50 times over their last 35 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), T6th-most in the majors during that time, behind the **White Sox** (56), **Yankees** (54), **Braves** (54), **Mariners** (53), and **Nationals** (52).

- Are on pace to hit 201 homers this season, which would be the 10th time in franchise history they'd reach the 200-HR mark.
- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 20 times this season.
- Did not homer in either of their final 2 games in **New York** despite producing a combined 23 hits...in Wed's 7-2 win, none of their 15 hits resulted in a home run...it was the first time a Reds team collected at least 15 hits in a game and didn't homer since 3 years ago to the exact day in 2023 (5/26/23 vs **Chc**, 19h, 0hr).
- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter today's game ranked T8th in the majors with 72 HR.
- 114 of their 256 runs scored this year have come via HR (44.5%).

NO THANKS: The Reds are 1 of 5 teams without an ABS challenge from their pitching staff (also: **Diamondbacks**, **Twins**, **Blue Jays**, and **Rays**).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 41 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's their longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds eluded a series sweep at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

- Is scheduled to make his fifth Major League start tonight vs KC...started on the mound in each of his first 4 Major League outings (8/6/23-9/6/23).
- On Sat vs Atl made his season debut after being selected from AAA-Louisville earlier in the day...marked his first Major League appearance since 9/3/25 vs Tor.
- Has spent most of the 2026 season with AAA-Louisville, where he has pitched to a 2-2 record with a 4.75 ERA (30.1ip, 20r/16er) across 18 games (1 start).
- Last season, pitched in 34 Major League games (all in relief) across 5 stints with the Reds (4/27-5/1, 5/6-5/21, 5/30-8/1, 8/3 - MLB Speedway Classic, 9/3-9/11).
- Posted a career-long 6.2-inning scoreless streak from 5/8-5/17, 2025...scored upon in a career-high 6 straight relief appearances from 6/28-7/8, 2025.
