AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their six-game road trip tonight with the first game a three-game series at Toronto (through Sun.)...are 3-0 on the road trip after sweeping a three-game series at Cleveland...following this homestand, will return home for a six-game homestand, featuring three-game sets against Chicago-AL (Tues.-Thurs.) and Cincinnati (6/19-21).

- Their 41-26 (.612) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors.
- **Have won each of their last four games (since 6/7) and five of their last six games (since 6/4)...are 11-4 in their last 15 games (since 5/24)** and 13-7 in their last 20 games (since 5/18)...are 33-19 in their last 52 games (since 4/13).
- **Are a season-high 15G over .500.**
- The Yankees' +103 run differential this season is the best in the AL and tied for the third-best in the Majors...have outscored their opponents, 90-52, over their last 15 games (since 5/24).

WHERE WE LEFT OFF: The Yankees won their fourth straight game with an 8-4 victory against the Guardians on Wednesday at Progressive Field...**LHP Carlos Rodón** (6.OIP, 4H, 3R/ER, 3BB, 7K, 1HR) earned his second win of the season after allowing only 3R/ER over 6.OIP...**RF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (1-for-4, 2R, 1 triple, 3RBI, 1BB, 1SB) drove in three runs, hitting a go-ahead two-run triple in the second inning...also drove in a run on a fielder's choice in the seventh inning...**RF José Caballero** (2-for-4, 1R, 2RBI, 1SF) drove in two runs, hitting a go-ahead sac fly in the sixth inning and an RBI single in the seventh inning...**SS Anthony Volpe** (1-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base twice and hit an RBI double in the sixth inning...**DH Paul Goldschmidt** (2-for-4, 1RBI, 1BB) reached base three times and hit an RBI single in the sixth inning...**CF Trent Grisham** (2-for-3, 3R, 1 triple, 1BB, 1SB) reached base three times...**LHP Brent Headrick** (1.OIP, 1H) tossed a scoreless seventh inning...**LHP Ryan Yarbrough** (2.OIP, 1H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 2K) allowed 1R/ER in 2.OIP.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt reached base three times for his second straight game on Wednesday at Cleveland, including an RBI single in the sixth inning...**has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games (since 5/25), batting .339/.381/.542 (20-for-59) with 8R, 3 doubles, 3HR, 14RBI, 4BB and 1SB over that span.**

- Has recorded multiple hits in each of his last two games and three of his last four games (since 6/7).
- Is batting .319/.386/.563 (38-for-119) with 18R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 7HR, 25BI, 11BB, 2HP and 1SB over his last 33 games (since 4/26).
- Has recorded 5RBI in his last four games (since 6/7) and 14RBI in his last 12 games (since 5/27).
- **Has hit .400/.538/.667 (12-for-30) with 2 doubles, 2HR, 20RBI, 7BB and 2HP with RISP this season**...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .331/.424/.453 (46-for-139) with 8 doubles, 3HR, 54RBI, 21BB/5IBB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

HIP HIP JOSÉ: INF/OF José Caballero drove in two runs on Wednesday at Cleveland, hitting a go-ahead sac fly in the sixth inning and an RBI single in the seventh inning...has reached base safely in 33 of his last 41 games with a PA (since 4/13), batting .291/.347/.455 (39-for-134) with 21R, 7 doubles, 5HR, 14RBI, 9BB, 3HP, 1SF and 10SB over that span.

PEN PAL: LHP Brent Headrick has not allowed a run in 26-of-33 appearances this season, going 4-1 with a 1.97 ERA (32.OIP, 7ER) and 35K...has stranded 22 of his 25 inherited runners this season.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice has hit .295/.389/.617 (67-for-227) with 49R, 15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR, 45RBI, 34BB/3IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 62 games this season...has reached base safely in 47-of-58 starts...35 of his 67H this year have been XBH (15 doubles, 2 triples, 18HR).

WALK IT OUT: Yankees batters lead the AL and are tied for second in the Majors with 287BB...marks their most walks through their first 67 games of a season in the last 22 years (since 2005) and their most since recording 297BB in 2004.

McMAHON OF THE HOUR: INF Ryan McMahon has hit .326/.341/.628 (14-for-43) with 6R, 1 double, 4HR, 8RBI, 1BB and 1SB over his last 13 starts (since 5/19)...since 4/25, is batting .323/.344/.516 (10-for-31) with 2HR, 12RBI and 1BB with RISP.

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. reached base twice and drove in three runs on Wednesday at Cleveland...hit a go-ahead two-run triple in the second inning and drove in a run on a fielder's choice in the seventh inning...has recorded 7RBI over his last four games (since 6/7) and 9RBI over his last seven games (since 6/3).

- Is batting .289/.362/.566 (24-for-83) with 17R, 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 15RBI, 10BB, 1SF and 6SB over his last 22 games (since 5/13).
- **Has hit 2HR in his last four games (since 6/7), 3HR in his last seven games (since 6/3) and 4HR in his last 11 games (since 5/26).**

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger reached base twice on Wednesday at Cleveland...is hitting .295/.388/.532 (41-for-139) with 21R, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 29RBI, 23BB, 55B and 3SF over his last 38 games (since 4/28).

- Has recorded 11RBI in his last 14 games (since 5/25).
- Is batting .305/.370/.441 (18-for-59) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 28RBI, 9BB and 5SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs, leads all Major Leaguers in DRS (15)...is tied for first in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (13, tied for first in AL) and tied for fifth in game-winning RBI (seven, tied for second in AL).

MERRY GRISHMAS: OF Trent Grisham reached base three times on Wednesday at Cleveland...**has hit safely in 15 of his last 18 games (since 5/19), batting .377/.449/.565 (26-for-69) with 14R, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 6RBI, 9BB and 3SB over that span.**

- Has reached base multiple times in nine of his last 13 games (since 5/26) and 12 of his last 18 games (since 5/19).
- Has recorded multiple hits in three of his last four games (since 6/7) and four of his last six games (since 6/4).
- **Owns a season-high six-game hitting streak** (since 6/4), marking his longest hitting streak since an eight-game streak from 7/30-8/7/23 with San Diego...is batting .423/.464/.692 (11-for-26) with 7R, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR, 2RBI, 2BB and 2SB over his hitting streak.
- **Has reached base safely in each of his last 13 games** (since 5/26)...marks his longest on-base streak since a 15-game streak from 9/15/25-3/28/26 and longest single-season streak since a 15-game streak from 6/23-7/9/21 with San Diego.

FAST AND FURIOUS: Yankees baserunners recorded 35B on Wednesday at Cleveland...have recorded 16SB over their last nine games (since 5/31)...their 67SB this season are the most in the AL and the fourth-most in the Majors.

- **Their 67SB this season are their most through their first 67 games of a season in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) and most since recording 78SB in 2001**...marks only the third time in the last 37 years (since 1990) the Yankees recorded as many stolen bases through their first 67 games of a season (78SB in 2001 and 86SB in 1998).
- **INF Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (175B) is tied for sixth in the Majors in stolen bases and **INF/OF José Caballero** (155B) is tied for eighth in the Majors.

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.17 ERA (368.2IP, 130ER) and 360K in 67 starts this season...have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 55 starts this season, the most in the AL and tied for the third-most in the Majors...marks their third-most in franchise history through their first 67 games of a season, trailing only their 58 starts in 2022 and 56 starts in 2024.

- Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.335) and opponents' OPS (.617), rank second in ERA (3.17, first in AL), WHIP (1.11, first in AL), opponents' BA (.212, first in AL), opponents' OBP (.282, first in AL) and HR/9.OIP (0.88, first in AL), sixth in strikeout rate (23.9% third in AL) and K/BB (2.98, third in AL), seventh in strikeouts (360, fourth in AL) and eighth in innings pitched (368.2, fourth in AL) and BB/9.OIP (2.95, fourth in AL).

ON A ROLL: OF Spencer Jones has hit .500/.500/.786 (7-for-14) with 1R, 1 double, 1HR, 3RBI and 1SB over his last four starts (since 5/21).

CRUZ CONTROL: RHP Fernando Cruz has not allowed a run in 19 of his last 21 games (since 4/25), going 2-1 with one save, a 0.86 ERA (21.OIP, 2ER) and 24K during that stretch.

- Has not allowed a run in 27 of his 32 games this season, going 3-1 with one save, a 1.84 ERA (29.1IP, 6ER) and 37K.
- **Has stranded 25 of his 29 inherited runners this season, including 21 of his last 22 inherited runners (since 4/24).**

PEN PALS: Yankees relievers have posted a 1.17 ERA (23.OIP, 3ER) and 20K over their last six games (since 6/4).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP RYAN WEATHERS (2-4, 3.86 ERA)

LHP Ryan Weathers will make his 13th start of the season in Friday's series opener at Toronto...the 26 year-old will make the start on extended six days' rest...made his 12th start of the season on 6/5 vs. Boston, recording his fourth loss of the year after allowing a season-high-tying 5R/ER over 6.0IP (7H, 1BB, 4K, 2HR, 1WP)...has gone 2-4 with a 3.86 ERA (70.0IP, 61H, 32R/30ER, 20BB, 79K, 13HR) in 12 starts this season...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in eight of his 12 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in seven of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in five of his starts...went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Miami Marlins in 2025...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 9-12 with a 3.78 ERA (195.0IP, 176H, 91R/82ER, 56BB, 196K, 31HR) in 36 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 27 of those 36 starts...since 2021, his 19 pickoffs are tied for fourth-most in the Majors...has pitched in over parts of six Major League seasons with the San Diego Padres (2021-23), Miami Marlins (2023-25) and the Yankees (2026)...has made four career Opening Day rosters (2021 and '23 with San Diego, '24 with Miami and '26 with the Yankees)...began the 2025 season on the injured list...is the son of David Weathers, who pitched in parts of 19 seasons in the Majors (1991-2009), including two seasons with the Yankees from 1996-97, where he won the World Series with the club in '96...became the fifth father/son duo in Yankees history to both play for the club, joining Clay Bellinger and Cody Bellinger, Mark Leiter and Mark Leiter Jr., Ron Davis and Ike Davis, and Yogi Berra and Dale Berra...was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the first round (seventh overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft...was acquired by Miami from San Diego in exchange for INF Garrett Cooper, RHP Sean Reynolds and cash considerations on 8/1/23...was acquired by the Yankees from Miami in exchange for OF Dillon Lewis, OF Brendan Jones, INF Dylan Jasso and INF Juan Matheus on 1/13/26.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his 12th start of the season on 6/5 vs. Boston, recording his fourth loss of the year after allowing a season-high-tying 5R/ER over 6.0IP (7H, 1BB, 4K, 2HR, 1WP)...his 5R/ER matched his season high (also 5R/ER on 4/14 vs. Los Angeles-AL, 5/18 vs. Toronto and 5/30 at the Athletics).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Will make his fifth road start of the year tonight...is 0-1 with a 3.97 ERA (22.2IP, 17H, 10R/ER, 5BB, 30K, 4HR) in four road starts this season.

- ✦ Has allowed 2R-or-fewer in three of his four starts.
- ✦ Is holding opposing batters to a .202 (17-for-84) batting average on the road this season.
- ✦ **Over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 5-5 with a 3.12 ERA (98.0IP, 77H, 39R/34ER, 32BB, 87K, 13HR) in 18 starts on the road.**

2026: Is 2-4 with a 3.86 ERA (70.0IP, 61H, 32R/20ER, 20BB, 79K, 13HR) in 12 starts this season...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in eight of his 12 starts, 2ER-or-fewer in seven of his starts and 1ER-or-fewer in five of his starts.

- ✦ Among Major League pitchers this season, ranks 10th in K/9.0IP (10.16, fourth in AL) and strikeout rate (27.7%, fifth in AL)...also is tied for 10th in strikeouts (79) among American League pitchers.
- ✦ Has recorded at least 7K in seven of his starts this season, including six of his last 10 starts (since 4/9)...his seven starts with at least 7K are tied for third-most in the AL and tied for eighth-most in the Majors.
- ✦ **Is just the eighth pitcher to record at least 79K through their first 12 starts with the Yankees**, joining Gerrit Cole (94K in 2020), Masahiro Tanaka (92K in 2014), Mike Mussina (81K in 2001), Orlando Hernández (79K in 1998), David Cone (84K in 1995), Al Downing (91K from 1961-63) and Bob Turley (92K in 1955) - confirmed by *Elias*.
- ✦ In his last 10 starts (since 4/9), has gone 2-4 with a 3.77 ERA (62.0IP, 26ER) and 68K...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in six starts over that span and 1ER-or-fewer in four of those starts.
- ✦ Is holding right-handed batters to a .212/.271/.404 (44-for-208) slash line this season.
- ✦ Has received 2R-or-fewer of run support in eight of his 12 starts this season, including 0R of support in five starts...owns a 3.09 run support average this year.
- ✦ Has allowed one-or-zero HR in eight of his 12 starts, including six starts without allowing a HR...has surrendered one-or-zero HR in five of his last eight starts (since 4/19).
- ✦ Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in three starts this season (7.0IP on 5/24/26 vs. Tampa Bay, 8.0IP on 4/9 vs. the Athletics and 7.1IP on 4/19 vs. Kansas City)...prior to this year, had tossed at least 7.0IP only twice in his first 55 career starts over his first five seasons (2021-25).
- ✦ Made his Yankees debut on 3/30 at Seattle, allowing only 1R/ER over 4.1IP without recording a decision (4H, 2BB, 7K, 0HR).
- ✦ Earned his first win as a Yankee after tossing 7.1 scoreless innings on 4/19 vs. Kansas City (5H, 1BB, 8K)...recorded his first scoreless start of the season and first scoreless start since 9/11/25 vs. Washington with Miami (5.0IP)...also marked the second-longest scoreless start of his career, trailing only his career-high-tying 8.0 scoreless innings on 5/14/24 at Detroit with Miami.
- ✦ Allowed 2R/ER over 6.1IP and did not record a decision on 5/11 at Baltimore (1H, 3BB, 9K, 0HR)...did not allow a hit to his first 20BF before surrendering a single to Adley Rutschman to lead off the seventh inning...became the first Yankees left-hander to not allow a hit through their first 20BF in a game since Nestor Cortes did not allow a hit to his first 26BF on 5/9/22 vs. Texas.

VS. TORONTO: Will make his third career start vs. the Blue Jays tonight...has gone 1-0 with a 4.63 ERA (11.2IP, 6ER) and 13K in two career starts vs. Toronto.

- ✦ Faced the Blue Jays earlier this season on 5/18 at Yankee Stadium and did not record a decision after allowing 5R/ER over 5.1IP (7H, 0BB, 7K, 2HR).
- ✦ Made his first start vs. Toronto at the Rogers Centre on 9/29/24 with Miami, earning the win after allowing just 1R/ER over 6.1IP (3H, 2BB, 6K, 0HR).

2025: Went 2-2 with a 3.99 ERA (38.1IP, 37H, 20R/17ER, 12BB, 37K, 7HR) in eight starts with the Marlins...missed the majority of the season due to two injured list stints (3/24-5/14, 6/9-9/11)...allowed 3ER-or-fewer in six of his eight starts and 1ER-or-fewer in four of his starts.

- ✦ Missed the first 41 games of the season on the injured list...was placed on the 15-day I.L. on 3/27 (retroactive to 3/24) with a left flexor muscle strain...combined to make three rehab starts with Single-A Jupiter and Triple-A Jacksonville, going 1-1 with a 1.69 ERA (10.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER, 4BB, 13K, 0HR)...was reinstated on the I.L. on 5/14.
- ✦ Was placed on the 60-day I.L. on 6/9 (left lat strain), missing 83 team games...made two rehab starts with Triple-A Jacksonville, posting a 2.45 ERA (7.1IP, 9H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 9K, 1HR)...was returned from rehab and reinstated on 9/11.

WEATHERS REPORT: Over the last three seasons (2024-26), has gone 9-12 with a 3.78 ERA (195.0IP, 176H, 91R/82ER, 56BB, 196K, 31HR) in 36 starts...during that stretch, has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in 27 of those 36 starts.

- ✦ Has limited left-handed batters to a .250/.313/.382 (38-for-152) slash line over that stretch.
- ✦ Has posted a 45.0% groundball percentage over the last three seasons.
