BIRDLAND BITES: On Wednesday, Baltimore defeated Texas, 8-3, avoiding a series sweep and snapping a four-game losing skid to the Rangers...The Birds completed their first homestand of the 2026 campaign with a 3-3 record, having taken two of three from the Twins to open the year.

♫ **Trevor Rogers** earned the win on Wednesday after tossing 6.0 innings, permitting two runs on six hits and one walk with three strikeouts...Since making his 2025 season debut on May 24 (G2) at Boston, Rogers' 1.76 ERA (24 ER/122.2 IP) is the lowest in MLB (min. 100.0 IP), ahead of DET's Tarik Skubal (1.82) and PIT's Paul Skenes (2.09).

♫ **Albert Suárez** had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk prior to Wednesday's game and earned the save that afternoon, allowing one run on two hits (1 HR) and one walk with two strikeouts across 3.0 innings...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, he became the third Oriole (fifth occurrence) to earn a save of 3.0+ innings in his season debut since saves became an official stat in 1969, joining **Mickey Weston** (1989) and **Sammy Stewart** (1985, 1981, and 1979).

♫ **Dylan Beavers** produced career highs in hits (3) and runs (3) in Wednesday's victory.

INTERLEAGUE INTEL: Over his last nine Interleague starts since August 6, 2023, **Kyle Bradish** is 3-0 with a 1.95 ERA (11 ER/50.2 IP) and 53 strikeouts...The 11 total runs Bradish has allowed during that period are the fewest permitted by a Baltimore starter over nine Interleague starts in franchise history (since 1954), per *STATS Perform*.

NIP AND TUCK: Each of the last five meetings between the Orioles and Pirates dating to April 6, 2024 have been decided by one run.

♫ Baltimore played in 51 one-run games in 2025, tied for sixth most in the majors, while its .529 winning percentage (27-24) in such contests ranked 14th in MLB.

EXTRA EXTRA! Ten different Orioles have recorded at least one extra-base hit this season, tied for the most such players in the AL along with the Astros and Guardians...The only clubs to have more players record 1+ extra-base hit are the Diamondbacks (12) and Marlins/Mets/Rockies (each 11).

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: Entering play today, the Birds are one of five teams in MLB that have yet to face a left-handed starting pitcher, joining the Guardians, Tigers, Rockies, and White Sox.

TWO-OUT TENDENCIES: Baltimore hitters have registered a .903 OPS with two outs, the fifth-highest mark in the majors behind Washington (.965), Philadelphia (.938), Milwaukee (.928), and Houston (.910).

♫ **Taylor Ward** is 5-for-7 with two doubles, three RBI, one walk, and zero strikeouts with two outs, while **Adley Rutschman** is 3-for-5 with two doubles, two walks, and zero strikeouts.

♫ The O's have 24 two-out hits, tied for second in the majors behind the Astros (25 H).

♫ With zero and one outs, the Birds have posted a combined .600 OPS, ranking 24th in the majors.

BOTTOMS UP: O's eight and nine-hole hitters have combined to slash .350/.400/.425 (14-for-40) with three doubles and eight RBI...The eight RBI are third most in the majors behind the Braves (10) and Pirates (9), while the .400 on-base percentage ranks third behind the Blue Jays and Phillies (both .458).

♫ **Jeremiah Jackson** is 4-for-10 with three RBI when batting ninth, compared to a combined 0-for-5 when hitting sixth or eighth.

POLAR BEAR PETE: **Pete Alonso's** 62.5 percent hard-hit rate ranks ninth among all MLB hitters (min. 25 PA), including sixth in the AL behind BOS' Roman Anthony (72.7%), TB's Jonathan Aranda (68.4%), CWS' Munetaka Murakami (66.7%), HOU's Christian Walker (65.0%), and MIN's Josh Bell (63.6%).

♫ Following an 0-for-3 performance with one walk on Opening Day, Alonso is 7-for-20 (.350) with one home run, two RBI, and two walks over his last five contests.

RISPY BUSINESS: The Birds have posted a .945 OPS with runners in scoring position, the third-highest clip in the majors behind the Brewers (1.090) and Dodgers (.976)...Their .324 RISP average ranks fifth in MLB behind the Brewers (.366), Tigers (.357), Dodgers (.344), and Braves (.327).

DOWN ON THE FARM: In four rehab appearances with Triple-A Norfolk, **Jackson Holliday** is 4-for-13 (.308) with two doubles, one RBI, one run, and two walks...He did not play in last night's contest at Memphis...**Andrew Kittredge** made his first rehab appearance with the Tides on April 1 and tossed 0.2 innings, allowing one run on two hits and one walk with one strikeout.

♫ Double-A Chesapeake opened its season last night with a 7-4 win over Hartford...**Thomas Sosa**, tabbed by *Baseball America* as the Orioles No. 16 prospect, went 3-for-5 with a triple, home run, four RBI, and two runs.

♫ Single-A Delmarva dropped its season opener to Salem yesterday, 5-4.

♫ High-A Frederick is set to kick off its season tonight at Hub City.

WELCOME TO BIRDLAND: Eight players on the Opening Day roster have made their O's debut: **Blaze Alexander**, **Pete Alonso**, **Chris Bassitt**, **Shane Baz**, **Ryan Helsley**, **Anthony Nunez**, **Leody Taveras**, and **Taylor Ward**...Nunez made his major league debut on March 28.

♫ Alonso, Bassitt, Helsley, and Taveras signed as free agents, Alexander (AZ), Baz (TB), and Ward (LAA) were acquired via trade during the offseason, while Nunez (NYM) was acquired via trade at last year's trade deadline.

AHOY! The Birds and Pirates play their lone series of the 2026 campaign this weekend... Baltimore swept the three-game set last season at Camden Yards from September 9-11.

♫ All three matchups between the clubs in 2025 were decided by one run, with the first two contests ending in extra-innings...On September 9, **Samuel Basallo's** RBI-single in the 11th secured a 3-2 Baltimore win...The following night, **Dylan Beavers'** RBI-single in the 10th clinched a 2-1 win.

♫ Since the clubs first met in 2005, Baltimore is 20-12 (.625) opposite Pittsburgh, marking the highest winning percentage against a single opponent in team history (since 1954).

♫ Pittsburgh Third Base Coach **Tony Beasley** was selected by Baltimore in the 19th round of the 1989 First-Year Player Draft before being acquired by Pittsburgh on September 5, 1991.

QUICK HITS: Bradish is scheduled to make his second start of the season and 69th of his career in the series opener today at Pittsburgh...He made six starts in his return from Tommy John surgery last season, going 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER/32.0 IP) on 23 hits (3 HR), 10 walks, and one hit batter with 47 strikeouts...Made his 2025 season debut on August 16 vs. Boston (L, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 HR, 0 BB, 10 K) and became the fifth Oriole (since 1954) to strike out at least 10 batters in his season debut.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss in his last outing on March 28 vs. Minnesota after throwing 4.2 innings, permitting three runs (2 ER) on two hits (1 HR), three walks, four strikeouts, and 83 pitches (50 strikes)...Bradish has allowed five or fewer hits in each of his last nine starts dating to June 8, 2024.

⚾ The last Oriole starter to allow five hits or fewer in 10 straight starts was **Trevor Rogers**, who did so in 10 straight from August 19, 2024-August 1, 2025.

STEEL CITY: Bradish is set to make his third career start against Pittsburgh and first at PNC Park...He holds a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) over two starts vs. the Pirates with his most recent outing on September 9, 2025 at Camden Yards, where he spun 7.0 innings of one-run ball on four hits and two walks with six strikeouts...Both of his appearances against Pittsburgh have been quality starts.

⚾ Bradish is 1-0 with a 2.50 ERA (11 ER/39.2 IP) over seven career starts vs. the NL Central, during which the O's have gone 6-1 (.857)...He's pitched 5.0+ innings and allowed two runs or fewer in five of his seven starts against the division.

ROAD WARRIOR: Bradish is 6-0 with a 1.77 ERA (13 ER/66.0 IP) and 96 strikeouts against 20 walks in 12 road starts since August 13, 2023.

⚾ He has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his last 12 road starts, the longest streak by an Oriole starter in franchise history (since 1954), ahead of **John Means** (11 G, 8/28/20-5/24/21) and **Hoyt Wilhelm** (10 G, 9/26/58-7/24/59).

ACE UP THE SLEEVE: Bradish has a 2.80 ERA (76 ER/244.2 IP) in 45 starts since the beginning of 2023...Among starting pitchers during that period, he has the sixth-lowest ERA in the majors (min. 200.0 IP) behind PIT's Paul Skenes (2.10), DET's Tarik Skubal (2.34), LAD's Blake Snell (2.53), LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto (2.68), and TB's Drew Rasmussen (2.72).

LEFTY FREEZE: Bradish didn't allow a hit to left-handed batters (0-for-8) in his season debut, yielding two walks with three strikeouts...He's held lefties to a .217 opponents average (123-for-566) throughout his career, which is 16 percentage points lower than his mark against righties (.233, 180-for-722).

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: In 2023, finished fourth in the AL Cy Young voting, the first Oriole to receive a Cy Young vote since Zack Britton in 2016...Went 12-7 with a 2.83 ERA (53 ER/168.2 IP), 168 strikeouts, and a 1.04 WHIP in 30 starts (18 QS)...Became the first qualified O's pitcher with a sub-3.00 ERA since Mike Mussina posted a 2.54 ERA (68 ER/241.0 IP) in 1992.

⚾ In 2022, made his MLB debut on April 29 vs. Boston (6.0 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).
 ⚾ Earned his first career win on May 10 at St. Louis after pitching 7.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits (1 HR) with a career-high 11 strikeouts...Became the first Oriole to pitch 7.0 innings with zero walks and 11 strikeouts since John Means threw a no-hitter on May 5, 2021 at Seattle...Was only the second pitcher in MLB history to have an outing with 11+ strikeouts and no walks in one of his first three career starts, joining WSH's Stephen Strasburg on June 8, 2010 vs. Pittsburgh (14 K).
