YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers lost to the Giants, 9-2, in Scottsdale.....**RHP Freddy Peralta** started for Milwaukee and allowed 3 runs on 2 hits in 2.0 innings (1bb, 3k, 2hr).....**2B Caleb Durbin** belted a solo homer, his first of the spring.

THE ROSTER: The team currently has 62 players in Major League camp: 30 pitchers, 7 catchers, 14 infielders and 11 outfielders.....there are 22 non-roster invitees in camp: 8 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders and 4 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: **LHP Tyler Alexander** (free agent), **RHP Grant Anderson** (trade with TEX), **LHP Nestor Cortes** (trade with NYY), **INF Caleb Durbin** (trade with NYY), **RHP Elvin Rodríguez** (free agent), **LHP Connor Thomas** (Rule 5 Draft from STL) and **LHP Grant Wolfram** (free agent).

GONE FROM 2024: **SS Willy Adames** (SF), **RHP Kevin Herget** (NYM), **LHP Wade Miley** (CIN), **LHP Hoby Milner** (TEX), **RHP Frankie Montas** (NYM), **RHP Colin Rea** (CHC), **RHP Joe Ross** (PHI), **C Gary Sánchez** (BAL), **RHP Devin Williams** (NYY), **RHP Bryce Wilson** (CWS) and **LHP Rob Zastryzny** (CHC).

2024 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 93-69 and finished in first place in the NL Central, 10.0 games ahead of the Cardinals and Cubs.....the team tied the Padres for the fourth-best record in baseball, trailing only the Dodgers (98-64), Phillies (95-67) and Yankees (94-68).....the Brewers lost to the Mets, 2 games to 1, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons.....they are joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 666 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

TODAY’S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS

RHP Tobias Myers, 26, made his MLB debut last season and went 9-6 with a 3.00 ERA in 27 games (25 starts) to earn Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher honors.....he had four stints with the team [4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-end of season].....the team went 13-12 in his starts.....he produced 7 quality starts.....Myers signed with Milwaukee on 11/10/22 after pitching in the Minor Leagues with Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022) and Chicago-AL (2022).....he was originally selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

RHP Jacob Misiorowski, 22, enters the 2025 season as the third-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.....he went 3-5 with a 3.33 ERA and 1 save in 33 games (21 starts) last season between Double-A Biloxi (19gs) and Triple-A Nashville (33g, 21gs).....he held opponents to a .167 AVG with 127 strikeouts in 97.1 innings.

LHP Connor Thomas, 26, was selected by Milwaukee from St. Louis in the first round of the Major League phase of the 2024 Rule 5 Draft this past December.....he was selected by the Cardinals in the fifth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Georgia Tech.....he went 7-4 with a 2.89 ERA and 3 saves in a career-high 56 games (3 starts) last season at Triple-A Memphis.

RHP Nick Mears, 28, went 1-5 with a 5.93 ERA in a career-high 54 relief appearances between Colorado (41g) and Milwaukee (13g).....he was traded to the Brewers on July 27 for RHP Bradley Blalock and RHP Yujanyer Herrera.....he had 75 strikeouts in 57.2 innings.....he was on the 15-day injured list from 8/25-9/25 with right forearm inflammation.

RHP Vinny Nittoli, 34, is a non-roster invitee.....he split last season between the Athletics and Orioles organizations.....Nittoli has appeared in 15 games - all in relief - during his Major League career with five teams: Seattle (1g in 2021), Philadelphia (2g in 2022), New York-NL (3g in 2023), Oakland (7g in 2024) and Baltimore (2g in 2024).
