HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' 8-5 record in their last 13 games is tied for the NL's second-best mark since June 29, with the Pirates (8-5) and Marlins (8-5), behind the Cubs (8-4) and ahead of the Brewers (9-6).

- The D-backs have won 5 straight home games vs. Cardinals, including a sweep last July 18-20.
 - The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 overall games vs. Cardinals.
- Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 13 straight games and 32 straight starts.
- The bullpen has worked 9.2 scoreless, hitless frames (2 BB, 10 K) in its last 2 games - 3.2 IP on July 11 and 6.0 IP on July 12 @ Dodgers.

LAST GAME: The D-backs recorded their seventh all-time road sweep @ Dodgers, first since 2017, rebounding from an early 3-0 deficit in the third inning and scoring 5 unanswered run in a 5-3 win.

- Nolan Arenado** and **Ryan Waldschmidt** plated runs in the fifth inning...in the sixth inning, **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** tied the game and **Ildemaro Vargas** drove in the go-ahead run...**Tim Tawa's** ninth-inning, solo homer was an insurance run.
- The bullpen worked 6.0 shutout, hitless frames (2 BB, 6 K): **Taylor Clarke** (1.1 IP), **Ryan Thompson** (1.0), **Kevin Ginkel** (0.2), **Jonathan Loáisiga** (1.0), **Juan Morillo** (1.0) and **Paul Sewald** (1.0).

ROSTER MOVES: The D-backs recalled INF **Tyler Locklear** (No. 31) from Triple-A Reno today...on July 15, OF **Tommy Troy** was placed on the 10-day injured list (sprained right AC joint; retro to July 12).

ALL-STAR RECAP: Eduardo Rodriguez, in his first career All-Star Game, worked a perfect second inning (retired Ernie Clement/TOR, Mike Trout/LAA and Yordan Alvarez/HOU).

- Corbin Carroll**, in his second straight and third career All-Star Game, entered as a defensive substitution in left field in the fifth inning and struck out in the sixth inning in his lone plate appearance.

10 YEARS: Max Kepler reached 10 years of service time on Tuesday, July 15...debuted in 2015 and has played in 1,211 games over 12 big league seasons.

BULLISH ON THE PEN: The bullpen, in their last 4 games, has a 0.61 ERA (1 ER in 14.2 IP), opponent .044 AVG (2-for-45)/.152 OPS, 2 walks and 17 strikeouts.

- Among all bullpens, the D-backs ranks fifth with a 1.19 WHIP, seventh with 1.64 runs per game and inherited runners scored percentage (27.0, 31-of-115), eighth with an opponent .233 AVG and .680 OPS, and 12th with a 3.91 ERA.
- All-time in franchise history through 96 games, this season's bullpen ranks third in AVG (.233), OBP (.303) and WHIP (1.19), fourth in OPS (.680), seventh in SLG (.377) and inherited runners scored percentage (27.0, 31-of-115) and 11th in ERA (3.91).
- Paul Sewald's** 22 saves are tied for fourth most through the team's first 96 games with Fernando Rodney (22 in 2017) behind 24 by Brad Boxberger in 2018, 26 by Byung-Hyun Kim in 2002) and 28 by José Valverde in 2007.

TAWABUNGA: Tim Tawa, in his last 3 games, all @ Dodgers, hit .538 (7-for-13)/1.692 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers and 7 RBI.

IT STARTS WITH STARTING PITCHING: D-backs starting pitchers, in their last 9 starts, have a 3.78 ERA (20 ER in 47.2 IP), an opponent .250 AVG (46-for-184)/.720 OPS, 14 walks and 35 strikeouts.

VS. EVERYBODY ELSE: The D-backs, who are 8-3 in their last 11 games vs. NL West and whose 21 divisional wins are second-most in the Majors, are 5-4 in their last 9 non-division games against the Reds, Cardinals and Brewers.

GARCIA HANGING ZEROES: Brandyn Garcia has held opponents scoreless in 12 straight (10.0 IP) and held 36 batters faced to 2 hits and 3 walks with 16 strikeouts.

- Has held opponents scoreless in 26 of 28 games this season (5 R in 23.2 IP, 12 H, 6 BB, 27 K).

LOÁISIGA BLANKING FOES: Jonathan Loáisiga has held opponent scoreless in 12 straight overall games (12.1 IP, 42 BF, 5 H, 1 BB, 10 K) and 7 consecutive home games (7.1 IP, 25 BF, 4 H, 1 BB, 5 K).

MORENO'S ON-BASE STREAK: Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in 32 straight starts (C: 26, DH: 6), since June 2, hitting .348 (40-for-115)/.931 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers, 13 RBI and 21 walks (14 K).

- Majors' longest active streak and the third-longest streak this season behind 33 by Bryan Reynolds/PIT (May 23-June 29) and 48 by Nick Kurtz/ATH (April 3-May 25).
- Is tied for the sixth-longest streak in club history with Paul Goldschmidt (June 7-July 12, 2014)...next up at 33 games, and tied for the third-longest streak, are Orlando Hudson (2007), Mark Grace (2001) and Luis Gonzalez (1999).

VS. CARDINALS: The D-backs still lead the 4-game set @ Cardinals from June 22-25, dropping the first game then winning the next 2 games, before the fourth game was postponed due to rain and rescheduled in St. Louis for July 23 at 2:15 p.m. AZ.

- The D-backs split each of their last 3 season series (3-3 in 2023, '24 and '25).

- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has reached base safely in 9 of his last 10 games vs. Cardinals, hitting .318 (14-for-44) with 3 doubles and 5 RBI.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (3-1, 4.70)

- In his last 3 starts, since being recalled from Triple-A Reno on June 30, is 3-0 with a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP), an opponent .220 AVG (13-for-59)/.555 OPS, 1 walk and 10 strikeouts.
- In his last start vs. Cardinals, a 7-3 home win on July 18 last season, tossed 7.0 shutout frames (4 H, 0 BB, 6 K).
 - In 4 career starts vs. Cardinals, is 1-0 with a 4.13 ERA and a .209 opponent AVG.
