TONIGHT'S GAME: Is Game 1 of a 3-game series vs **Mauricio Ortiz' Nationals** and the fourth game (2-1) of a 7-day/6-game homestand that includes a weekend series victory vs the **Astros**.

- Following Thu's game vs **Wsh**, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **Cle** (5/15-5/17) and **Phi** (5/18-5/20).
- Cin is coming off a 0-7 road trip at **Pit** (0-3) and **Chc** (0-4).

SERIES OF FORTUNATE EVENTS: With the weekend series victory vs **Hou** (2-1), the Reds improved to 8-4-1 in series play this season...only the **Braves** (11) and **Yankees** (9) have more series wins.

- The Reds' 8 series victories in 2026 are their most before the end of May since 2013 (11-7-0).
- Are on pace for 31 series wins, which would be the club's most since the 2010 National League Central Division championship team went 32-16-4 (.654) in series play.
- Are 8-5 in series openers...have gone on to win 6 of those 8 series when taking the first game (6-1-1).

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have avoided being swept in 38 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds avoided being swept at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

ELLYTRICITY: In Sun's 5-0 win vs Hou, **SS Elly De La Cruz** went 3-for-4 with 2 runs scored and a stolen base...it was his fifth 3-hit game of the season...only **LAD's Andy Pages** has more (6).

- Elly** has 8 hits over his last 14 at-bats to lift his batting avg to .288.
- Among all Major League shortstops this season, ranks with the leaders in TB (85, 1st), runs (29, 1st), avg exit velocity (93.9, 1st), homers (10, T1st), XBH (18, T1st), RBI (29, 2nd), SLG (.521, 2nd), games (41, T2nd), OPS (.875, 3rd), hits (47, T3rd), and stolen bases (9, T3rd).
- Half of his 10 HR have come off left-handed pitching (47 PA)...hit 5 HR off lefties last year (210 PA).
- Is 2 stolen bases shy of 150 for his career...aiming to become the youngest Red (currently 24 years, 121 days old) since 1900 to reach the mark since 1900 (**Eric Davis**, 25 years, 82 days old).
- Is also 2 stolen bases shy of ranking among the fastest players since the live-ball era (since 1920) to reach 400 hits, 200 RBI, and 150 stolen bases for his career.
- Is on pace for 39 HR and 35 SB...would become the fourth Red in franchise history to join the "30-30 club"...(**Brandon Phillips** in 2007, **Barry Larkin** in 1996, **Eric Davis** in 1987).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds went 2-4 in 2025 vs **Wsh**, dropping both 3-game series (1-2, 5/2-5/4 in **Cincy** & 1-2, 7/21-7/23 in **D.C.**).

- Cin is 22-38 vs **Wsh** since 2016 with a -56 run margin (282-338).
- In the final game of the 2025 season series, **LHP Nick Lodolo** pitched a complete-game shutout in Cin's 5-0 win on 7/23 at **Nationals Park**.
- The Redlegs have dropped 19 of the last 27 games vs **Wsh** here at **Great American Ball Park** since 2017.
- Cin has won 9 of its last 16 games at **Nationals Park** dating back to 5/25/21, but is just 12-18 there since the beginning of 2016.

KEEPIN' IT CLEAN: **2b Matt McLain** has produced a career-high 75 consecutive errorless games at second base, beginning 8/11/25.

- McLain's** last error at the keystone came on 8/10/25 at **Pit** (throwing error in the 8th inning).

MINIMIZING MISCUES: The Reds rank sixth in the majors with a .990 fielding percentage (**Ath** .994, **SD** .993, **KC** .991, **LAD** .990, **Sea** .990)...Cin's 15 errors rank T5th...only the **A's** (8), **Padres** (10), **Royals** (13), and **Dodgers** (14) have fewer errors so far this season.

3-4-5: Reds' 3,4,5 batters have combined to slash .263/.339/.492 in the first 41 games of the 2026 season (124-for-472, 28hr, 83rbi, 180 times on base).

- The rest of the Cin lineup has combined for a .196/.287/.322 slash line with the fewest hits in the majors (174).
- Cin 3-4-5 hitters lead their ML counterparts in home runs (28).

HEN FRUIT: The Reds have blanked opponents 4 times already over the season's first 41 games...they're only the sixth Cin team in the **Great American Ball Park** era (since 2003) to have 4 or more shutouts over the season's first 41 games (2019, 2017, 2014, 2013, 2009).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 7-6 loss at Chc (6.0ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 96TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Produced a season high 14 swings-and-misses.
- 8 of his 25 batters reached.
- Allowed a 1st-inning, 2-out, 2-run HR to Ian Happ...were his 13th and 14th runs allowed this season with 2 outs.
- Pitched a scoreless 6th before turning it over to Sam Moll.

MAY 1 at PIT: Suffered the 9-1 loss on Fri, 5/1 at Pit (3.1ip, 7h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 1k, 2hr, 56TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 11 of his 19 batters.
- Both homers he allowed came when he was ahead in the count (0-2 to Bryan Reynolds in the 1st inning; 0-1 to Henry Davis in the 4th inning).
- Pitched into the 4th inning and retired leadoff batter Konnor Griffen before allowing a home run to Henry Davis and a double to Oneil Cruz...Cruz was his last batter...turned it over to Zach Maxwell who got out of the inning without further damage.

APRIL 25 vs DET: Earned the 9-2 win on Sat 4/25 vs Det (5.1ip, 8h, 2r/2er, 0bb, 3k, 2hr, 94TP).

- Allowed a season-high 8 fly balls, 8 hard-hit balls, 2 HR, and 13 swings-and-misses.
- Gave up a leadoff home run to Kevin McGonigle on the first pitch of the game...was the second time in his career he allowed a HR on his first offering (J.P. Crawford, 8/25/23 at Sea)...allowed 2 more runners to reach in the 1st inning before escaping without further damage.
- Scattered 5 hits and allowed 1 more run over the next 4.1 innings (HR, Spencer Torkelson in the 4th inning) before turning it over to Connor Phillips in the top of the 6th with 1 out and a runner on first...Phillips retired his 2 batters.

APRIL 19 at MIN: Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 7-4 win at Min on Sun 4/19 (6.0ip, 5h, 3r/3er, 4bb, 2k, 0hr, 104TP).

- Was his second straight quality start and the 66th of his career.
- His 104 pitches and 4 walks were both season highs...last threw 104 or more pitches on 8/5/24 for KC vs Bos (107)...last walked 4 or more batters on 9/6/25 vs NYM (4bb).
