**METSCELLANEOUS:** The Mets opened a three-game set against the Rockies with a 4-2 victory...The Mets are once again a season-high 16 games above .500...New York has won six of their last eight games and 10 of their last 13...The Mets are in a stretch of 10 straight games (6-2)...The Mets continue their seven-game road trip (3-1) to Los Angeles (2-1) and Colorado (1-0)...The Mets are off on Monday before the start of six-game homestand against the Nationals (three games) and Rays (three games).

**ON THE RECORD:** The Mets own a 40-24 record this season...That is the best record in the National League...It is the fifth-best record to start a season...Only the 1986 (45-19), 1988 (41-23), 2022 (41-23) and 2006 (41-23) teams had better season-opening records...The Mets are 16-5 in series openers...They improve to 11-6 against the NL West.

**SERIS-LY SPEAKING:** The Mets are seeing their 13th series victory of the season and their fourth on the road...New York is looking for their first road series victory since the went 2-1 against Arizona on May 5-7.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** New York is 16-17 (.485) on the road compared to 24-7 at Citi Field in 2025...The Mets have not won back-to-back games on consecutive days on the road since April 13-14...The Mets have posted a 3.11 ERA on the road, which is the best mark in the majors.

**IN A PINCH:** Francisco Lindor recorded a pinch-hit two RBI double in last night's victory...As a pinch hitter in his career, Lindor is 3-8 with two doubles, five RBI, one walk with a 1.080 OPS.

**AIN'T IT GRAND?:** Juan Soto's next contest will mark his 1,000th career major league game...Soto has 212 home runs and 820 walks...Only two other players in major league history had at least 200 homers and 800 walks in their first 1000 career games in the major leagues: Ted Williams (220 HR, 908 BB) and Frank Thomas (238, 829)...Credit Elias...He has recorded 988 career hits, marking him 12 shy of 1,000.

**JUAN OF A KIND:** Soto is batting .316 (6-19) with six runs, one double, two homers, four RBI, eight walks, a .536 OBP and a .684 SLG in six games in June... He has recorded 51 walks in 63 games this year...His 51 walks are tied with Rafael Devers for the major league lead...His 51 walks through the team's first 64 games is the second-most in franchise history...Joen Olerud recorded 52 walks in 64 team games in 1999...He would go on to set the single-season franchise record with 125 walks that year...Soto has recorded at least 125 walks in a season four times in his career (145 in 2021, 135 in 2022, 132 in 2023 and 129 in 2024).

**FOR PETE'S SAKE:** Pete Alonso has safely reached base in 15 straight games...The 15-game on-base streak is tied for the fourth-longest of his career...He is batting .310 (18-58) in that span with four doubles, six homers, 20 RBI, three walks, a .388 OBP and a .690 SLG in that span...Alonso has collected 57 RBI in 64 games this season...That is the most in the major leagues...He recorded 88 RBI in 162 contests last year...His 57 RBI through the team's first 64 games is the second-most in franchise history...In 2022, Alonso recorded 59 RBI through the team's first 64 games.

**MARTE PARTY:** Since May 1, Starling Marte is batting .316 (18-57) with 11 runs, two doubles, two homers, five RBI, six walks, two steals, a .409 OBP, a .456 SLG and an .865 OPS...Over his last six games, Marte is batting .353 (6-17) with seven runs, a double, a home run, two walks, a steal with a 1.009 OPS.

**STEAL THIS BASE OR DON'T:** Mets runners have recorded an 86.0% (49-57) stolen base percentage this season, the best in the majors...The team's catchers have caught 18 potential base stealers this season, which is tied for the fifth-most in the majors...Mets catchers have caught 38.3% potential base stealers this year, the second-best mark in the majors.

**PITCHING IN:** The Mets lead the majors with a 2.84 ERA and are sixth with 573 strikeouts...New York's starting staff has posted a 2.86 ERA this year, the best in the majors...The bullpen has posted a 2.81 ERA, which ranks second.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his sixth win of the season and allowed three runs over a career-high 7.0 innings on June 1 vs. Colorado...Allowed three hits, recorded three strikeouts and did not issue a walk for the first time since May 2 at St. Louis (4 GS)...After he allowed a game-tying two-run homer to Tyler Freeman with two outs in the fifth, Holmes retired each of his final seven batters faced.

**WHAT UP HOLMES?:** Holmes is one of seven pitchers in franchise history to win five or more games and strike out 50 or more batters, while sporting a sub-3.15 ERA in their first 12 games with the franchise...The others are Max Scherzer, Pedro Astacio, Al Leiter, Pedro Martínez, R.A. Dickey and Steven Matz.

**THE GAME OF RISP:** This season, Holmes has held opposing batters to a .143 (6-42) average with runners in scoring position, tied for the fourth-best mark in the National League and tied for the seventh-best mark in the majors (min. 50 at-bats w/RISP)...Out of the six hits Holmes has allowed this season with runners in scoring position, only one has gone for extra bases, tied with teammate Tylor Megill and Randy Vasquez for the fewest in the majors (min. 50 at-bats w/RISP).

**STAYING GROUNDED:** Since 2019, Holmes' 65.1% groundball rate is the third-highest mark in the majors during that span behind Aaron Bummer's 66.7% clip and Andre Pallante's 65.8% rate (min. 1000 BF)...In each of the last four seasons, Holmes' groundball rate has ranked in the top five in the majors, including a league-leading 77.0% mark in 2022 (min. 250 BF each season).

**ROAD IMPROVEMENT:** In 157 career road outings, Holmes has pitched to a 4.15 ERA (87 ER/193.0 IP)...In 102 road games since 2022, Holmes has posted a 2.66 ERA (37 ER/125.0 IP), a 4.22 earned run average improvement from his first 56 career road games...Since 2022, Holmes ranks seventh in the majors in road ERA (min. 100.0 IP).

**NEW PITCH ON THE BLOCK:** Holmes has added a new pitch to his arsenal, the "kick change"...He has thrown the pitch 15% of the time, his third-most used pitch behind only his sinker (37.4%) and his sweeper (17.5%)...The right-hander has held opposing batters to a .200 (7-35) average in at-bats ending with the pitch and has produced a 36.6% whiff rate...His 37.1 K-rate with his "kick change" is the fourth-best mark among all major leaguers who possess a changeup in their arsenal (min. 10 Plate Appearances).

**ALLOWING HOLMES RUNS:** Over his last five starts, Holmes has allowed seven home runs...In his first seven starts of the season, Holmes did not allow a homer and became the sixth pitcher in franchise history not allow a home run through their first seven starts with the team...Holmes has allowed two home runs in three of his last four starts after he never surrendered multiple home runs in his first 319 career Major League games...At the time, it was the fifth-longest active such streak by a pitcher to begin their Major League career game.

**10 K CLAY:** On April 8 vs. Miami, Holmes made his Mets Citi Field debut...The right-hander allowed four runs over 5.1 innings, issued three walks and struck out a career-high 10 batters...Holmes became the fifth Met all-time to record 10 or more strikeouts in their home pitching debut joining Dennis Ribant (10 K on 8/17/1964 vs. PIT), Dick Selma (13 K on 9/12/65 vs. HOU), Aaron Harang (10 K on 9/12/13 vs. WAS) and Max Scherzer (10K on 4/19/22-G2 vs. SF)...Courtesy of *Elias*...Holmes struck out five straight batters starting at his final batter of the third inning until the first batter he faced in the fifth...His 5.1 innings were the second-most he has ever thrown in an outing behind his 6.0 innings pitched in his second career big league start on July 14, 2018 with Pittsburgh.

**NEW ROLE WHO DIS:** Holmes started for the Mets on Opening Day (3/27 at HOU) in just his fifth career major league start...The first four starts of Holmes' career came in his first big league season, 2018 with Pittsburgh...Holmes is 7-5 with a 3.94 ERA (36 ER/82.1 IP) in 16 career starts...He is just the 10th pitcher in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to start Opening Day having made four or fewer career starts prior, joining Marty Pattin (4, 1969), Tom Hall, (4, 1969), Fernando Valenzuela (1981, 0), Al Holland (1982, 3), Dave Nied (1993, 2), Tanner Scheppers, (2014, 0), Dustin May (2020, 4), Garrett Crochet (2024, 0) and Sean Burke (2025, 3)...Courtesy of Sarah Langs.

**CLAYMATION:** Holmes became the seventh Mets pitcher to make their team debut as the club's Opening Day starter...The others are Roger Craig (4/11/62 at STL), Don Cardwell (4/11/67 vs. PIT), Mike Hampton (3/29/00 vs. CHC), Tom Glavine (3/31/03 vs. CHC), Pedro Martínez (4/4/05 at CIN) and Johan Santana (3/31/08 at FLA)...Courtesy of *Elias*...Additionally, Holmes celebrated his 32nd birthday on Opening Day...He became the seventh pitcher in major league history to start Opening Day on their birthday joining Vic Willis (4/12/1906 PIT at STL), Marty Pattin (4/6/1971 MIL at MIN), Bert Blyleven (4/6/73 MIN at OAK and 4/6/79 PIT vs. MTL), Catfish Hunter (4/8/76 NYY at MIL), Jon Lieber (4/2/01 CHC vs. MTL) and Ryan Drese (4/5/05 TEX at LAA)...Courtesy of *Elias*.

**LET'S TAKE A LOOK BACK AT LAST SEASON:** In 2024, Holmes made 67 relief appearances with the Yankees and pitched to a 3.14 ERA (22 ER/63.0 IP)...His career-high 30 saves ranked fourth in the American League and eighth in the majors...In his final outing of 2024, September 29 vs. Pittsburgh, Holmes locked up his 74th career save and moved into a tie with John Wetteland for seventh-most in Yankees history (since saves became an official stat in 1969)...Did not allow an earned run in his first 20 games of the season from March 28 - May 19, marking the second-longest season-opening streak in franchise history, trailing only Dellin Betances' season-opening 26-game streak in 2015 (since ER became an official stat in 1913)...His 20.0IP over that span were the most by any major league reliever who had not allowed an earned run during that stretch...Also did not allow an earned run in 23 games from September 25, 2023 - May 19, 2024, the second-longest streak of his career, trailing only a 29-game stretch from April 9 - June 18, 2022...Did not allow an earned run in 29 of his first 30 appearances of the season from March 28 - June 9, going 1-1 with 19 saves and a 1.23 ERA (4 ER/29.1 IP) over that stretch...His 19 saves were tied with Cleveland's Emmanuel Clase (19) for the second-most over that span, trailing only St. Louis' Ryan Helsley (21)...Allowed 14 runs (10 ER) in 14 games from June 13 - July 30...Was named to his second career All-Star team (also: 2022)...Over his final 22 appearances of the year, held opponents to a .188 (12-64) average and was unscored upon in 17 of those appearances...Appeared in 13 Postseason games and went 3-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts...Pitched in the Yankees first eight Postseason games...Became the fifth pitcher in major league history to appear in each of their club's first eight postseason games, joining Tyler Matzek (2021 with Atlanta), Greg Holland (2014 with Kansas City), Wade Davis (2014 with Kansas City) and Jesse Orosco (1996 with Baltimore)...Became the 11th relief pitcher in major league history with three or more wins in a single Postseason and the third Yankee to accomplish the feat (also: Sparky Lyle, 1977 and Mike Stanton, 2000).

**REELIN' IN THE YEARS:** Holmes was selected by Pittsburgh in the ninth round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Slocomb High School (AL)...He was signed by Pirates scout Darren Mazerowski, the son of Hall of Famer Bill Mazerowski...The 6-5, 245-pounder made his major league debut on April 6, 2018 with Pittsburgh vs. Cincinnati and appeared in 91 career games with the Pirates from 2018-2021...Was acquired by the Yankees on June 26, 2021, in exchange for INF Hoy Park and INF Diego Castillo...Established career highs in games (69), innings (70.0 IP), wins (8) and strikeouts (77) during the 2021 season...Became the Yankees closer in 2022 and recorded 74 saves from 2022-2024, the third-most in the AL and the 11th-most in the majors during that span...Earned a career-high 30 saves in 2024 and became the 11th pitcher in Yankees franchise history to record 30+ saves in a season...Is a two-time American League All-Star (2022, 2024) and was twice named American League Relief Pitcher of the Month (May 2022, Sept./Oct. 2023)...Over 16 career Postseason appearances, is 3-1 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP), a 0.90 WHIP and a .172 (11-64) batting average.
