TODAY'S GAME: The Giants open up their penultimate series of the first half with the first of three against Toronto tonight.

- SF went 3-3 on its six-game road trip, its final in the first half away from Oracle Park.
- The Giants are 8-5 in their last 13 games dating to June 24, taking series from the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1) while dropping their last series at Cleveland (1-2).
- The Giants have won three of their last four home series, and six of their last eight games at Oracle Park.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following moves prior to tonight's game.

- SF made a trade on Sunday with Cincinnati... LHP Alex Young joined the Giants organization in exchange for OF Austin Slater and cash considerations.
- Both Young and LHP Kolton Ingram were optioned to TripleA Sacramento on Sunday.
- LHP Blake Snell (\#7) was returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List.
- Additionally, IFs Thairo Estrada (\#39) and Wilmer Flores (\#41) were also reinstated from the IL
- Lastly, IF Nick Ahmed was designated for assignment today.

STAY GOLDEN: IF Matt Chapman will be presented his 2023 Gold Glove in a pregame ceremony today...Chapman won the award as a member of the Blue Jays...it is the fourth Gold Glove of Chapman's career (also 2018, 2019 and 2021).

LONG TIME NO SEE: The Giants are 14-12 all-time against Toronto, and 8-5 at Oracle Park...in last season's matchup in Toronto, the Blue Jays took two of three games.

- This is the first time the Giants will host the Blue Jays since splitting a two-game set May 14-15, 2019.
LA ESTRELLA DE MAUNABO: OF Heliot Ramos is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since OF Chili Davis in 1986.
- He's also the youngest Giants All-Star (pitcher or position player) since IF Joe Panik in 2015, who was 24 years, 257 days old...Ramos will be 24 years, 313 days old.
- Ramos earned the nod by slashing .299/.370/.517 with 10 doubles, 12 homers, 41 RBI, 26 runs and an . 886 OPS in 54 games since being recalled on May 8.
- His 12 homers are tied for the team lead with IF Matt Chapman while his 41 RBI and $2.3 \mathrm{fW} A \mathrm{R}$ are second-most behind Chapman's 42 RBI and 2.4 fWAR.
- Ramos' 14 multi-hit games at home since his recall on May 8 are most in MLB over that span (Stats, LLC)
- His 41 RBI since May 8 are tied for most in the NL and for fifth-most in MLB in that time.

ALL-STAR ACE: In addition to OF Heliot Ramos, RHP Logan Webb was also named to his first All-Star team.

- This marks the first time SF had both a homegrown outfielder and homegrown pitcher named as All-Stars since 1971 (OF Willie Mays, RHP Juan Marichal and OF Bobby Bonds).
- Webb is the first Giants homegrown starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since LHP Madison Bumgarner in 2016.
- Webb currently leads the NL with 119.1 innings (second in MLB behind KC's Seth Lugo, 122.0ip) ...his 3.09 ERA is ninth in the NL.


PEN TO PAPER: The SF bullpen has pitched 25.0 innings over its first six games this month.

- The Giants' 379.2 bullpen innings this year are most in MLB.
- RHP Tyler Rogers leads the Majors with 46 appearances, followed by teammate RHP Ryan Walker (45 appearances).
- LHP Erik Miller has made 42 appearances in his rookie campaign, which is second-most among rookie pitchers behind Cleveland's Hunter Gaddis (44)
THE RETURN OF SNELLZILLA: LHP Blake Snell makes his return today from a left groin strain, which has held him out of Major League action since June 3.
- In this most recent rehab stint, Snell made three appearances for Triple-A Sacramento, totaling 15 strikeouts over 9.2 innings...in his last start, July 3 vs. Reno, Snell struck out nine while allowing only a walk across 5.0 shutout innings.
BIG MIKE: With a home run on Sunday, OF Michael Conforto is slashing . $314 / .405 / .714$ with 13 RBI over his last 14 games dating to June 22 with nine of his 11 hits in the span going for extra bases (six doubles, one triple, two homers).

LONGBEARD: With Sunday's trade of OF Austin Slater (debuted June 2, 2017), OF Mike Yastrzemski is now the longest tenured Giants player (debuted on May 25, 2019). after Yastrzemski, it's RHP Logan Webb (debuted August 17 , 2019) and RHP Tyler Rogers (debuted August 27, 2019).

CITY CONNECT MAGIC: The Giants will wear their City Connect uniforms tonight, which debuted in 2021

- SF is 2-2 in the City Connects this year, but 28-12 in them since their 2021 inception with a +48 run differential.
THE MORE WE GET TOGETHER: The Giants have drawn 30,000+ fans in 32 consecutive home games dating to April 24, which is the seventh-longest active streak in MLB...it's also SF's longest streak since a 440-game streak from July 23, 2013 (second game of a doubleheader) through April 7, 2019.
- SF is averaging 33,890 fans per game through 44 home games this year at Oracle Park, eighth-best in MLB...last year, SF averaged 30,866 fans/game at home, 17th in MLB.


## This Date in Giants History

JULY 9, 1988 - Chris Speier hit for the cycle and Ernest Riles hit the 10,000 th home run in Giants history to lead SF to a $21-2$ rout of the Cardinals. The 21 runs are an SF record. Speier also cycled as an Expo in 1978, just the fourth Major Leaguer to do so for two teams, joining Joe Cronin (Washington, 1929; Red Sox, 1940), Babe Herman (Dodgers, 1931; Cubs, 1933) and Bob Watson (Astros, 1977; Boston, 1979)

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young will make his first start back from his second trip to the Injured List, and seventh start overall after joining SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after the 2024 season).
LAST TIME OUT: Made the final of three rehab starts for Triple-A Sacramento last Wednesday (July 3), striking out nine while allowing just one base runner (a walk) across 5.0 hitless/shutout innings vs. Reno.
REHAB UPDATE: Through the three tuneup starts, Snell posted a 4.66 ERA ( 5 er, 9.2ip), a 1.24 WHIP and 15 strikeouts...in the three rehab starts, opponents went 1 -for-10 (.100) with seven strikeouts against his curveball, and 2 -for-13 (.154) with a home run and five strikeouts against his fastball.
VS. TORONTO: Thanks to his five seasons pitching for the Rays, today marks Snell's 15 th career regular season start vs. Toronto... he is $4-4$ with a 2.74 ERA ( 21 er, 69.0 ip ) with 84 strikeouts, a 205 opposing batting average and a 1.26 WHIP against Toronto...in his last start vs. the Blue Jays (July 20, 2023 at Toronto), Snell drew the loss by allowing one run on five hits and a career-high tying seven walks across 5.0 innings.
YOU AGAIN: Only three active Blue Jays have more than 10 career plate appearances against Snell (including Postseason)...IF/DH Justin Turner is 3 -for- 21 (.143) with zero extra-base hits, an RBI and eight strikeouts... OF George Springer is 5 -for- 20 (.250) with a home run, three RBI and four strikeouts...C Danny Jansen is 1 -for9 (.111) with zero extra base-hits, no RBI and three strikeouts.
DOWN AND OUT: Snell has been out of MLB action since exiting vs. the Yankees on June 2 with a left groin strain.... he missed 31 games during this trip to the IL, and paired with his trip to the Paternity List (May 23-May 26) and his first time on the IL with a left adductor strain (April 23-May 22), has missed a total of 59 games for SF.
CURVE IT: Opponents are hitting .125 ( $3 \times 24$ ) against Snell's curveball with 13 strikeouts this season...the Blue Jays have a .228/.251/.333 slash line against curveballs this season with their . 585 OPS ranking T-20th in MLB...of Snell's 234 strikeouts last season, 109 came on his curveball...opponents hit 079 on the pitch with a 140 slugging percentage....his curveball had a run value of 22 last season after posting a run value of three in 2022...the 22 run value was the second-best rated curveball behind Atlanta RHP Charlie Morton's 25, and rated as the sixth-best pitch overall.
WALK IT BACK: This season, Snell has walked 14 batters in 23.2 innings... Toronto is fifth in MLB with a $9.1 \%$ walk rate, while its $29.9 \%$ 0 -Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone) is fourth-lowest in MLB...the lefty became the first pitcher since ERA was established in both leagues in 1913 to finish as baseball's leader in walks (99) and ERA (2.25), doing so last season.
FAST TIMES: Snell's four-seam fastball, which he threw 47.2\% of his pitches prior to being placed on the IL, had a .415 opposing batting average ( $17 \times 41$ ) and a .756 slugging percentage...Toronto is toward the bottom of MLB against left-handed four-seam fastballs, with a $.221 / 308 / .363$ slash line and a .670 OPS (fourthlowest in MLB).
