It was announced during the Mariners 50 Seasons weekend that Rick Rizzs will be inducted into the Mariners Hall of Fame during the 2027 season, becoming the 12th member and joining long-time broadcast partner Dave Niehaus as the only non-uniformed members of the Mariners Hall of Fame...Rizzs is in his 41st and final season as voice of the Mariners.

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners begin a 9-game road trip with the 1st of 3 games against the New York Yankees...the Mariners will also travel to Houston to face the Astros (3 G, 8/14-16) and to Milwaukee to face the Brewers (3 G, 8/18-20) on the road trip...tonight's game will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Dave Valle** on the call and **Brad Adam** serving as field reporter...the game will also be televised nationally on **TBS** with **Brian Anderson** and **Jeff Francoeur** on the call...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Gary Hill Jr.** and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** on the call.

**ODDS & ENDS**...the Mariners fell to the Rays in Sunday's game by a 4-1 final...the Mariners are 41-15 (.732) when they score at least 4 runs in a game and 35-8 (.814) when they score at least 5 runs.

- Quality Check** - The Mariners starting pitching staff has recorded 54 quality starts this season, the most in the American League and 2nd-most in MLB behind only the Dodgers (61 G).
- Vargas Begins Rehab** - On Saturday, **Carlos Vargas** made the first appearance of his rehab assignment with High-A Everett, tossing a 1-2-3 inning...in 70 appearances in 2025, Vargas went 5-5 with a 3.97 ERA (34 ER, 77.0 IP), 23 walks and 54 strikeouts.
- Small Roster Move Yesterday** - The Mariners yesterday claimed RHP **Nolan Kingham** off waivers from the Texas Rangers...Kingham will report to Triple-A Tacoma.
- 50 Seasons, 50 Greatest Mariners** - The Mariners unveiled the 50 greatest Mariners players in franchise history on Saturday, selected based on a combination of fan vote, and input from Mariners alumni, Mariners baseball operations and longtime Mariners front office and Seattle media...visit [Mariners.com/Top50](https://mariners.com/Top50) to view the full list.

**RICK RIZZS TO BE INDUCTED TO MARINERS HOF IN '27**...the Mariners announced on Saturday that legendary broadcaster **Rick Rizzs** will be the 12th inductee into the Mariners Hall of Fame during the 2027 season...Rizzs is in his 41st and final season as a Mariners broadcaster, as he previously announced his plans to retire following the season...Rizzs will join his friend and long-time broadcast partner Dave Niehaus as the only non-uniformed members of the Mariners Hall of Fame.

**RED SKY AT NIGHT, NAYLOR'S DELIGHT**...in 21 games since the All-Star break, **Josh Naylor** is batting .312 (24x77) with 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 5 stolen bases, a .376 OBP and slugging .445 for an .831 OPS...he has reached base safely in 20 of those 21 games and 28 of his last 29 games (7/4-c)...overall this season, his 23 stolen bases rank T-8th most in MLB...Naylor is 7 stolen bases away from becoming the only first baseman since Hall of Famer George Sisler (1920-22) with the St. Louis Browns to record consecutive 30+ stolen base seasons.

**J-ROD PUTTING ON A SHOW**...**Julio Rodríguez**'s 8-game hitting streak was snapped in Sunday's game, but he has reached base safely in his last 9 games (7/31-c), batting .344 (11x32) with 3 runs, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 2 stolen bases, 6 walks, a .447 OBP and slugging .531 for an .979 OPS...Julio is also approaching his 5th-consecutive 20+ homer season and with 2 more home runs would become the 8th player since 2022 to record 5 seasons with 20+ home runs, joining Pete Alonso-NYM/BAL, Rafael Devers-BOS/SF, Manny Machado-SD, Matt Olson-ATL, Shohei Ohtani-LAA/LAD, Kyle Schwarber-PHI and Juan Soto-3Tms...he would also join Hall of Famer Ken Griffey Jr. and Alex Rodriguez as the only Mariners players to accomplish the feat at age 25-or-younger.

**YOUNG AT HEART**...in 21 games since the All-Star Break, **Cole Young** is batting .314 (27x86) with 9 runs, 1 double, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 9 RBI and 6 walks, reaching base at a .366 clip and slugging .477 for an .842 OPS over 93 plate appearances...Young ranks as the best second baseman in the American League this season by *Baseball-Reference* wins above replacement (3.8).

**CALL IT MACARONI**...RHP **Bryan Woo** is set to make his 6th career start against the Yankees tonight...over his first 5 starts against the Yankees, Woo is 2-1 with a 2.73 ERA (9 ER, 29.2 IP), 6 walks, 30 strikeouts, a 0.84 WHIP and holding opponents to an .179 average...the only team he has a lower ERA against (min. 5 GS) is the Athletics (2.22 ERA in 10 GS)...Woo earned his first MLB win at Yankee Stadium (6/22/23).

**GIMME! GIMME! GIMME! (A MUÑ AFTER MIDNIGHT)**...closer **Andrés Muñoz** has recorded three consecutive 20+ save campaigns, joining Kazuhiro Sasaki (2000-02) as the only Mariners with three consecutive 20+ save seasons...Muñoz also has 98 saves in his career, inching closer to becoming the 40th pitcher in MLB history to record 100 saves by age 27-or-younger...97 of his 98 saves have come with the Mariners (1 with San Diego), 3 saves shy of becoming the fourth pitcher in Seattle history with 100+ saves, joining Sasaki (129 SV), Edwin Díaz (109) and J.J. Putz (101).

**STATE OF THE FARM**...C **Boston Smith**, who was acquired from the White Sox in exchange for RHP Luis Castillo on Aug. 2, took home Texas League Player of the Week honors in his first week in the Mariners organization after batting .381 (8x21) with 5 HR and an 1.554 OPS in 6 games...LHP **Kade Anderson** has continued his dominance of the Double-A level, recording his 12th scoreless outing of the season on Friday...he owns an 1.13 ERA (11 ER, 87.2 IP) on the season with 128 strikeouts to just 12 walks...INF/OF **Michael Arroyo** and OF **Lazaro Montes** tore up Las Vegas with the Triple-A Tacoma Rainiers, with Arroyo batting .304 (7x23) with 3 HR and an 1.191 OPS and Montes batting .385 (10x26) with 4 HR, 9 RBI and an 1.369 OPS.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...INF/OF **Brendan Donovan** has been a productive hitter for the Mariners this season despite being limited to 29 games due to injury, batting .258 (25x97) with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and an .778 OPS, and...**AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...Donovan has fared well against the Yankees during his career, batting .414 (12x29) with 6 runs, 2 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 4 walks, a .514 OBP and slugging .690 for an 1.204 OPS, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...his 1.204 OPS against the Yankees is the 3rd-highest OPS among active players with at least 30 plate appearances against Yankees?...he trails only Kyle Manzanardo-CLE (1.447) and James Wood (1.218).

## ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - AUGUST 11

- 1994** - Randy Johnson K's a ML season high 15 batters in a 4-1 complete game victory at Oakland. He also throws the final pitch of the 1994 season (players strike), fanning the A's Ernie Young.
- 2002** - John Olerud scores his 1,000th career run in a 6-5 loss at Chicago. Olerud finished the game 3x4 with three runs scored.
- 2014** - Félix Hernández extended his Major League record with his 16th and final consecutive start allowing 2 or fewer runs in at least 7.0 innings in the Mariners 11-1 win over the Blue Jays at home. Felix allowed 1 run in 7.0 innings with 8 strikeouts.

ABOUT BRYAN WOO...

- The 26-year-old right-handed pitcher is set to make his 23rd start of the season and 93rd career start...is also making his 1st start against the Yankees this season and the 6th of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 6th round (174th overall) of the 2021 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of California Polytechnic State University...signed by Mariners scout Chris Hom.
- Spent 3 seasons at Cal Poly before being drafted, making 31 appearances (6 starts) for the Mustangs. Did not pitch in 2021 while recovering from right elbow surgery.
- Was selected to the 2025 American League All-Star team for the 1st time in his career.

**LAST TIME OUT...**W#8 on Aug. 5 vs. Detroit...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings of work, allowing 3 hits, 1 walk and 3 hit batters while striking out 5 batters...threw 91 pitches and 61 strikes...marked his 12th quality start of the year and his 7th-consecutive quality start at home...his 7.0 innings pitched matched his season-high (done 5x)...has also tossed 5.0+ innings in each of his last 6-consecutive starts (6/30-c) and in 19 of his 22 starts this season.

**SHUTTING IT DOWN...**has thrown 7.0+ IP without an earned run allowed in 4 games this season, tied for 4th-most such games in MLB this season (also: 6 others)...has also recorded 6.0+ innings without an earned run in 6 starts this season, tied for 3rd-most in MLB (also: 5 others)...his 11 such games since 2025 are tied for 7th-most across that span (also: 2 others).

**AGAINST THE YANKEES...**owns a 2.73 ERA (9 ER, 29.2 IP) with 30 strike-outs across 5 career starts against the Yankees...has thrown 5.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer earned runs allowed and 5-or-fewer baserunners allowed in 4 of his 5 starts against the Yankees...in his last start against the Yankees (7/10/25 at Yankee Stadium), he threw 7.1 innings and allowed 2 runs (2 ER) on 2 hits and 2 walks with 5 strikeouts and no extra-base hits allowed...is 1 of only 2 Mariners pitchers with 3+ starts of 5.0+ IP and 0 ER against the Yankees, joining Félix Hernández.

**WELCOME TO NEW YORK...**across 3 career starts against the Yankees at Yankee Stadium, he owns a 0.96 ERA (2 ER, 18.2 IP) and a .589 WHIP with 17 strikeouts to 5 walks allowed...he has allowed 2-or-fewer hits over 5.0+ IP in all 3 starts...is 1 of just 4 pitchers since 1990 to hold the Yankees to just 2-or-fewer hits over 5.0+ IP in 3 games at Yankee Stadium (also: Eduardo Rodríguez-BOS, Tyler Glasnow-TB and Alek Manoah-TOR)...among pitchers against the Yankees at Yankee Stadium since 2023 (min. 15 IP), he ranks 3rd in ERA, 2nd in WHIP, and 1st in opp. AVG (.100)...across 4 career games in New York (at NYY & NYM), he owns a 1.09 ERA (3 ER, 24.2 IP) with 25 strikeouts to 7 walks allowed and a .770 WHIP.

**WATCH HIM WHIP...**his 1.013 career WHIP is 4th-best in MLB among qualified pitchers since 2023 (min. 500 IP), trailing only Tarik Skubal-DET/LAD (0.906), Zack Wheeler-PHI (0.991) and **Logan Gilbert** (0.992)...Woo's 1.013 career WHIP is also the lowest in franchise history (min. 500 IP), ranking ahead of teammates **Logan Gilbert** (1.050) and **George Kirby** (1.139).

**NO FREE PASSES HERE...**among qualified pitchers since 2025, he ranks 2nd in walks-per-nine (1.81), 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.16) and 2nd in walk rate (5.0%), trailing only Tarik Skubal-DET/LAD in all three the categories...in addition, he has tossed 6.0+ IP with 2-or-fewer walks in 13 of his 21 starts this season and in 41 total starts since 2025, which leads MLB across that span, ranking ahead of next closest Sandy Alcantara-MIA (36)...his 27 such starts in 2025 were tied with Jamie Moyer (1998) for most starts of 6.0+ IP and 2-or-fewer walks in a season in franchise history.

**PLAYING THE LONG GAME...**has thrown 6.0+ innings in 14 of his 22 starts this season and in 58 career starts, which rank 6th-most such starts through a player's first 92 career games in franchise history...his 41 total starts of 6.0+ IP since 2025 ranks T-1st in MLB (also: Logan Webb-SF) while his 314.0 IP since 2025 rank 10th...continues his quality work late into the game, owning a 0.840 WHIP and a 10.0 K/BB on pitches 76-100 this season...among pitchers this season (min. 15 GS), his 10.0 K/BB on pitches 76-100 ranks 3rd-best while his 0.840 WHIP ranks 10th.

**PREMIUM PERFORMANCES...**owns 12 quality starts this season and 33 total QS since 2025, most in the American League and 4th-most in MLB across that span...he is 1-of-6 pitchers in MLB this season to record 5-or-more quality starts with 9+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks.

**KEEPING THE PATHS CLEAR...**has thrown 7.0+ IP with 4-or-fewer baserunners allowed in allowed in 8 career games, including 3 times this season (last: 6/18 vs. BAL)...his 3 such games this season are tied for 3rd-most in MLB while Woo's 7 such games since 2025 are also tied for 3rd-most in MLB across that span (also: 4 others)...his 9.32 baserunners-per-nine innings since 2025 ranks 8th in MLB while his 9.46 BR/9 across his career ranks 6th in MLB among qualifying pitchers since 2023.

**ONE-HIT WONDERS...**has tossed 6.0+ innings with 1-or-fewer hits in 2 starts this season (4/3 at LAA, 5/6 vs. ATL) and in 5 total starts since 2025, tied for the most such games in MLB across that span (also: Yoshinobu Yamamoto-LAD)...the Mariners pitching staff has combined for 7 such games this year (Woo 2x, Hancock 2x, Gilbert 2x, Miller), tied for most in MLB this season (also: LAD) and are most in a single season in franchise history.
