#### Abstract

Weird Win Atlanta beat the Marlins, 5-0, last night despite collecting just three hits, including two homers and a triple. The win was just the fourth for the Braves over the last 112 seasons when they did not record a single or double in a game. They last did it on July 19,2012 , when they beat San Francisco, 3-2, on the strength of a triple and two home runs.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins complete a three-game series tonight with the 19th of 19 match-ups between the teams this season...These three games will conclude the season series between the clubs.

A The Braves have gone 14-4 against the Marlins this season, tying the franchise record for most single-season victories against Florida/Miami.. Atlanta went 14-5 (.737) against Miami last season, matching the mark first set in 2004 and repeated in 2012.

A The Braves' 28 wins over Miami the last two seasons are the most by any National League team against a single opponent...Atlanta has outscored Miami 199-113 (+86) in these games.
A RH Mike Soroka is 2-0 with a 0.68 ERA (2 ER/26.2 IP) in four career starts against Miami, includig a 1-0 record with a 0.41 ERA (1 ER/22.0 IP) in three starts this season...Last faced them on August 10 at Marlins Park, and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings...He has never faced Miami in his home park.

A RH Sandy Alcantara makes his third career start against Atlanta, all of which have come this season...Is $0-0$ with a 3.86 ERA ( $5 \mathrm{ER} / 11.2 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in his first two turns, including allowing three runs over 7.2 innings in his last start against the Braves, August 10.
FOURTEEN WINS: With last night's win, Atlanta has 14 wins over Miami for the second consecutive season...The Braves went 14-5 against the Marlins last year.

A The last time the franchise won at least 14 games against a single opponent in consecutive years was 1965 and 1966, when the Milwaukee Braves and Atlanta Braves had identical 14-4 records against the Houston Astros.

A The Washington Nationals are the last team in the majors to beat a single opponent at least 14 times in consecutive seasons, when they went 14-5 and 15-4 against Atlanta in 2015 and 2016.
REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Braves SS Dansby Swanson will begin a rehabilitation assignment with Single-A Rome tonight.

A Swanson has been on the 10-day injured list since July 24 with a right foot contusion.
SERIES WIN: The Braves have taken the first two games from Miami to improve to 26-9-6 in series play on the year, including a 13-4-4 mark at SunTrust Park.

A The Braves have now surpassed their series win total from last season's 90 -win club, which won the NL East...Atlanta went 24-19-11 in series play last season.

A Atlanta is 6-0-2 in it last eight series, and has not lost a set since a two-game sweep by Kansas City, July 23-24.

LOOKING FOR 30/30: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. enters today's game with a National League-most 29 stolen bases this season, leaving him one shy of the fifth 30 home run $/ 30$ stolen base season in Braves franchise history.

A Acuña Jr. is also looking to become the second player in baseball history to have at least 30 home runs and 30 stolen bases in a season prior to his 22nd birthday...The only player to do so was Mike Trout, who had 30 home runs and 49 stolen bases as a 20 -year-old in 2012.

A Only three Braves have gone $30 / 30$ at any age, with OF Ron Gant doing it last in 1990 and 1991.
A OF Hank Aaron was the first to do so, accomplishing the feat in 1963, while OF Dale Murphy also did it in 1983.

30/30 BY TEAM GAME: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. stands one stolen base away from a $30 / 30$ season, and today is team game No. 129...The quickest a Braves player has ever recorded a $30 / 30$ season is team game No. 149 , set by Ron Gant in 1991...The quickest major leaguer to accomplish the feat in the modern era was Cincinnati's Eric Davis, who needed just 105 team games and 90 personal games in 1987.
A Gant needed 154 games for his first 30/30 season in 1990...Hank Aaron used 160 team games for the first 30/30 season in Braves history, while Dale Murphy accomplished the feat in 153 team games during the 1983 season.

THIRTY-THIRTY-THIRTY: 3B Josh Donaldson hit his 29th home run of the season Saturday, and is looking to join 1B Freddie Freeman and OF Ronald Acuña Jr. with 30 homers this season.

A Six different Braves teams have had at least three different players reach 30 homers in a season, with the last being the 2003 club (Andruw Jones, Javy Lopez, Gary Sheffield).

SOROKA ERA: Tonight's starter RH Mike Soroka ranks second in the majors with a 2.41 ERA (36 ER/134.2 IP) in 22 starts this season.
A Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu has been better... Ryu has a 1.64 ERA in 23 starts.

A Soroka's current ERA is the second best by a Braves rookie in the live-ball era (since 1920)...Righthander Jim Turner went 20-11 with a 2.38 ERA for the 1937 Boston Bees.

A Soroka's ERA is the lowest by any rookie in the majors since 2013, when Miami's José Fernandez compiled a 2.19 mark over 28 starts.
HIGH-WATER MARK: With last night's win the Braves moved to 76-52 and a season-high 24 games over . 500 , establishing the club's high-water mark for the last six seasons...The last time the Braves were 24 games or better over . 500 was 2013 , when that club finished the season 96-66 (30 games over).

A Last faced them on August 10 at Marlins Park and pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just three hits...Marlins batters are hitting just .120/.185/.147 against him in 75 at-bats this season.
A He has never faced Miami in his home park.
A Held the Marlins scoreless over 7.0 innings in his last start against them August 10... The start was his 14th this season allowing one earned run or less.
A The 14 such starts are tied for third most in the majors among traditional starters...Only the Dodgers' Hyun-Jin Ryu (16) and rotation-mate Julio Teheran (15) have more.

A Ryne Stanek had 25 such starts while opening for the Rays.
A The Atlanta-franchise record for such starts is 20, set by Greg Maddux in 2002.
Atlanta has lost each of his last three starts, despite Soroka pitching to a 2.61 ERA (6 ER/20.2 IP) in those turns.
A The Braves have lost seven of Soroka's 22 starts this season, and his ERA in those losses is just 2.68 (13 ER/43.2)...It is the lowest ERA in team losses by a starter in the majors this season (min. 20 starts).

A The Nationals' Max Scherzer ranks second, with a 3.26 ERA in the 11 games Washington has lost in his starts.

Is a perfect 6-0 with a 1.32 ERA (12 ER/81.2 IP) in 13 starts away from home.. Has a 4.08 ERA (21 ER/46.1 IP) in his home park.
A Soroka's 1.32 ERA on the road is best in the majors among qualified starters, and nearly a full point lower than the closest pitcher (Jacob deGrom, 2.30).
A Soroka's 1.32 ERA is the second-lowest mark by a Braves pitcher on the road since 1913...Greg Maddux went a perfect 13-0 and pitched to a 1.12 ERA in 15 starts on the road in 1995.
Turned 22 years old, August $4 \ldots$...Went $12-3$ with a 2.58 ERA ( 40 ER/139.2 IP) in 24 starts aged 21 or younger.
A Soroka's 24 starts before turning 22 are fourth-most in franchise history since 1908, and the most since Steve Avery made 56 such starts.
A He is one of 145 pitchers in the live-ball era (since 1920) to make at least 24 starts aged 21 or younger...Of those 145 pitchers, Soroka's 2.58 ERA was fifth lowest, trailing just José Fernandez (2.25 in 36 starts), Dwight Gooden (2.28 in 99 starts), Mark Fidrych (2.34 in 29 starts) andVida Blue (2.36 in 49 starts)
Lost to Washington, 7/20 at SunTrust Park, to snap a 10-game winning streak that spanned 15 starts...Allowed nine hits and four runs over 6.0 innings.
A Became just the sixth Braves pitcher in the live-ball era (since 1920) with a double-digit win streak and the first since Greg Maddux also won 10 straight in 2001.
A John Smoltz holds the franchise record during the live-ball era, winning 14 consecutive decisions during the 1996 season.
Went 9-1 with a 2.42 ERA (24 ER/89.1 IP) over 15 starts to open the season, and became the youngest pitcher in franchise history to be named an All-Star.
A Made his All-Star Game debut with a scoreless sixth inning, July 9 at Progressive Field...Retired Whit Merrifield, Carlos Santana and Dan Vogelbach.
Beat the Mets, 6-2, in his start on $6 / 28$ to move to $9-1$ on the season, the most wins by a rookie pitcher before the All-Star break.
A No Braves rookie has ever had double-digit wins at the break...Soroka is tied with Lou Fette (9-3 in 1937) and Jair Jurrjens (9-4 in 2008) for the most.
\& Allowed a then season-high four runs, including three earned, $6 / 1 \mathrm{vs}$. DET...The outing snapped a streak of eight straight starts allowing one earned run or less to start the season.
$\mathcal{A}$ Was the third major league starter in the live-ball era to open his season with eight consecutive starts of one earned run or less, and the first Braves pitcher to do so...Edinson Vólquez (2008) and Mike Norris (1980) also did so.

Season Long Streak: 10 games, twice, last: 7/31-8/9 (18-47, .383, 7 HR) Has 36 homers and a NL-most 29 steals...Seeking to become second player in baseball history to have at least 30 homers and 30 steals in a season prior to turning $22 \ldots$...Mike Trout is the other ( 30 HR and 49 SB in 2012 as a 20 -year-old)....Only three other Braves have gone 30/30 at any age (R. Gant, 1990 and 1991; D. Murphy, 1983; H. Aaron, 1963). Earned MLB's Play of the Week for the period of $8 / 12-18 \ldots$...Playing left field on $8 / 15$ ran to the wall, jumped, and robbed a potential home run from the Mets' J.D. Davis. Scored in first inning on $8 / 13$, his 100 th run this season...It was ATL's 121 st game...Became third-quickest Brave in the modern era to reach 100 runs...The only players quicker were Tommy Holmes (1945) and Dale Murphy (1983)...Acuña Jr. leads the NL with 106 runs. Homered twice, $8 / 9$ at MIA, his third career multi-homer game...Was last of four straight games with a homer...Had franchise record-tying five-game streak last season...Is first player in majors history to have two homer streaks of four or more games prior to turning 22 . Hit 50th career home run on $7 / 21$ vs. WSH...At 21 years, 215 days old, became fourth youngest player to reach the 50 -homer milestone (M. Ott, T. Conigliaro and A. Jones).
