SATURDAY IN THE PARK: The Detroit Tigers today continue their final homestand of the regular season with the middle game of their three-game set against the Atlanta Braves ... the Tigers have dropped their last four games, seven of their last eight and 16 of their last 23 contests starting August 24 ... the Tigers have also lost their last five home games dating to September 7.

- The Tigers (85-69) enter the day 4.0-games behind the A.L. East-leading Blue Jays (89-65) while they are tied (sans tiebreaker) with the Mariners (85-69), the leaders of the A.L. West.
- The Tigers have reached 85 wins this year, one shy of their total from a season ago ... Detroit has 85 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since a four-year run from 2011-14.
- After tomorrow's homestand finale, the Tigers set off on their final road trip of the season, a six-game, two-city trip through Cleveland (Tuesday-Thursday) and Boston (Sept. 26-28).

AND WE HAVE LIFT OFF: Spencer Torkelson last night connected for his 30th home run, one shy of his 2023 career high, as he joins Riley Greene (34 homers) in the 30-homer club this year ... Greene and Torkelson are the first Tigers teammates to reach 30 homers in a season since Miguel Cabrera (38 homers) and Justin Upton (31 homers) in 2016 ... Greene and Torkelson are the first lefty-righty Tigers tandem to do so since Miguel Cabrera (44 homers) and Prince Fielder (30 homers) in 2012.

SOUTHERN HOSPITALITY: Detroit has a 23-15 (.605) record vs. lefty starters this year, the third-best winning percentage in all of baseball vs. opposing southpaws.

- Collectively, the Tigers have a .785 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season, the best team mark in all of baseball ... the Yankees are second-best with a .783 OPS vs. lefties.
- Individually, the Tigers have six players with an OPS greater than .800 vs. left-handed pitchers: Dillon Dingler (.974), Wenceel Pérez (.919), Gleyber Torres (.913), Jahmai Jones (.912), Spencer Torkelson (.910) and Zach McKinstry (.880) with Javier Báez (.774) just a tick behind.

SEPTEMBER MOURN: With their fourth loss in a row last night, the Tigers dropped to 5-11 (.313) thus far in September, the third-lowest winning percentage in the A.L. this month ahead of only the Angels (5-13, .278) and the Twins (4-13, .238) ... the Guardians lead the majors with a 14-4 (.778) record in September while the Mariners are 12-5 (.706), third-best in the majors this month.

- Detroit's 5.24 ERA (84 ER/144.1 IP) this month is third-lowest in the A.L. and nearly 1.50 points higher than the 3.80 team ERA the club had through August, which was fourth-best in the A.L.
- The Tigers offense has posted a collective .682 OPS thus far in September, which ranks 11th in the A.L. ... the club had a .740 team OPS through the end of August, fifth-best in the A.L.

FEAST OR FAMINE: Keider Montero this afternoon makes his 11th start of the season for the Tigers, and he has taken a bit of circuitous route to his 4-3 record and 3.55 ERA (20 ER/50.2 IP) in his first 10 starts ... he has allowed no runs or one run in six of his starts, going 4-0 with a microscopic 0.82 ERA (3 ER/33.0 IP) in those outings ... however, he has allowed four runs or more in his other four starts, going 0-3 with an 8.66 ERA (17 ER/17.2 IP) in those outings.

FINN AGAIN: Activated yesterday off the injured list, Kyle Finnegan has started his Tigers career with 14.1 scoreless innings across 12 relief outings since being acquired at the trade deadline from Washington ... he had been sidelined since early September with a right adductor strain.

- Finnegan is the first Tigers pitcher acquired midseason to begin his tenure in Detroit with at least 14.1 scoreless innings since Doug Bair started off with 19.1 scoreless innings in 1983.

VESTED INTEREST: Among pitchers with at least 20 saves, Will Vest has the second-lowest ninth-inning ERA in baseball this year at 1.18 (5 ER/38.0 IP), trailing only Aroldis Chapman (1.13).

- The Tigers are 75-0 when leading after eight innings, the best such start in club history (the Tigers went 73-0 when leading after eight in 2009).

CENTRAL CASTING: The Tigers have a 2.5-game lead in the A.L. Central over the Guardians, dwindled from where it was on September 1 when they had a 9.5-game lead on the Royals and a 10.5-game lead on the Guardians ... the A.L. Central is at its tightest since the Tigers held a 2.5-game lead following play on May 13.

A SEASON FOR THE AGES: Riley Greene enters today's game with 31 doubles, 34 homers and 108 RBI, just the second Tiger in the 125-season history of the franchise to reach those numbers in his age-24-or-younger season, joining Hank Greenberg (46 doubles/36 homers/168 RBI in 1935).

- Only four other major leaguers in the past 10 years have reached Riley's current totals in their age-24-or-younger season: Juan Soto (SD, 2023 and WSH, 2019), Rafael Devers (BOS, 2021), Cody Bellinger (LAD, 2019) and Nolan Arenado (COL, 2015).

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?: The Tigers are tied for the third-best record in the A.L. thanks to a +78 run differential, trailing the Yankees (+133), Red Sox (+106) and Rangers (+85) for the best mark in the A.L. ... in the A.L. Central, the Tigers have a +97 edge on the second-place Guardians (-19), are +78 on the third-place Royals (+0) and are +170 on the fourth-place Twins (-92).

AND FINALLY: Spencer Torkelson's 79 career homers are the seventh-most ever by a Tiger through his age-25 season and most since Travis Fryman had 90 homers through his age-25 year (1990-94).

- Began the 2025 season with Triple-A Toledo, going 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA in his two starts...allowed three runs on six hits and one walk while striking out 11 over 9.2 innings.
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 7-13, 2025, after picking up the win with 5.2 perfect innings and six strikeouts on April 10.
- Saw his first Major League action last year, appearing in 19 games (16 starts) with Detroit, going 6-6 with a 4.76 ERA (52ER/98.1IP) and 77 strikeouts. He made his Major League debut on May 29 against Pittsburgh.
