LAST GAME: The D-backs won 1-0 vs. Rockies yesterday to take the 3-game series.

- Merrill Kelly** earned his fifth win after 7.0 scoreless innings, including 5.0 no-hit, with a season-high 11 strikeouts.
- Ketel Marte**'s first-inning homer plated the game's only run.
- Shelby Miller** recorded his third consecutive save (fourth overall).

NL WEST STRETCH: The D-backs are 6-4 in a 13-game stretch vs. NL West's Dodgers (7 G, 2-2; May 19-21) Giants (3 G; 2-1) and Rockies (3 G; 2-1).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The D-backs are just the third NL West or AL West team since 1997 to open the season with 3 straight road trips to begin with a NL East or AL East opponent [source: SportRadar]:

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 games @ Dodges since May 21, 2024 and outscored them 39-16 in those games.

- Ketel Marte** has hit in 12 straight starts since April 29, 2024...is hitting .314 (16-for-51)/1.015 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI and 8 walks.
- Eugenio Suárez** has homered in 5 of his last 8 games...in his last 13 games since May 21, 2024, is batting .326 (15-for-46)/1.161 OPS with 5 doubles, 5 homers, 14 RBI and 6 walks.
- Gabriel Moreno** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 games since April 29, 2024, batting .349 (15-for-43)/.939 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 10 RBI and 4 walks...in 20 career games, is hitting .315 (23-for-73)/.875 OPS with 6 doubles, 3 homers and 16 RBI.
- Geraldo Perdomo** in his last 18 games since April 8, 2023, is hitting .327 (18-for-55)/.847 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 homer, 8 RBI and 3 walks.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a 7-game hit streak @ Dodgers since Aug. 30, 2023, batting .333 (10-for-30)/.910 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers and 6 RBI.

ROAD WARRIORS: Lourdes Gurriel Jr., in his last 11 road games, is hitting .400 (18-for-45)/1.126 OPS with 7 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 3 walks, including 8 multi-hit games.

- Josh Naylor** in his last 15 road games, is batting .317 (19-for-60)/.938 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 10 RBI and 7 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo** in his last 12 road games, is batting .341 (15-for-44)/.915 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 homer, 12 RBI and 7 walks.
- Alek Thomas** in his last 10 road games, is batting .333 (10-for-30)/.375 OBP with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 1 walk.

SLUG-OUT SERIES: Since May 5, the D-backs (2nd, .493 SLG) and Dodgers (1st, .525 SLG) are the top 2 slugging teams in the Majors.

- The D-backs' 50 extra-base hits and 21 homers since May 5 (13 G) are third in MLB, behind the Dodgers (13 G; 51/23) and Yankees (12 G; 51/22).

CARROLL AMONG LEGENDS: **Corbin Carroll** is the fourth player in the modern era (since 1900) to record 14+ homers, 5+ triples and 3+ stolen bases in the team's first 48 games, with Willie Mays/NYG (1955), Bob Meusel/NYY (1925) and Babe Ruth/NYY (1921).

HITS IN BUNCHES: The D-backs have recorded 10+ hits in 4 of their last 5 games (since May 13).

- Since May 9, the D-backs' 5 games with 10+ hits are tied for most in the Majors (also: Dodgers, Blue Jays and Tigers).
- The D-backs are 9-5 in 10+ games.

SOMETHING EXTRA: The D-backs' 35 games with 3+ extra-base hits lead the Majors, ahead of the Dodgers (32) and Mets (29).

- The D-backs have recorded 3+ extra-base hits in 9 of their last 12 games (since May 6).
- With 2 outs, the D-backs' 54 extra-base hits are tied for most in the Majors (also: Cubs).

WAR MACHINES: Geraldo Perdomo (2.4) and **Corbin Carroll**'s (2.1) bWAR is fourth and seventh, respectively, among NL position players, behind Pete Crow-Armstrong/CHC (3.1)...only the D-backs and Dodgers boast 2+ players in the top 10.

- Among shortstops, Perdomo is second in MLB to Bobby Witt Jr./KC (2.6).
- Carroll ranks fifth among NL outfielders, behind Crow-Armstrong/CHC (3.1), Fernando Tatis Jr./SD (3.0), Andy Pages/LAD (2.3) and Brendan Donovan/STL (2.1).

CARROLL AND LEADERBOARDS: Corbin Carroll, among the Majors, ranks in triples (T-1st, 5), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 28), total bases (3rd, 116), runs (3rd, 38), SLG (4th, .589) and homers (T-5th, 14).

- His career-high-tying 3 multi-homer games are tied for most in the Majors (also: Jordan Beck/COL, Tyler Soderstrom/ATH and Kyle Stowers/MIA).
- His 18 multi-hit games are most in the NL and tied for third in MLB (also: Bo Bichette/TOR), behind Aaron Judge/NYY (22) and Paul Goldschmidt/NYY (20).

AMONG TOP SHORTSTOPS: Geraldo Perdomo ranks among shortstops [min. 40 G] in OBP (1st, .401), walks (1st, 30), RBI (1st, 34), sac flies (1st, 6), OPS (2nd, .870), AVG (3rd, .300), stolen bases (T-3rd, 11), extra-base hits (T-5th, 17), SLG (5th, .469) and total bases (8th, 75).

- His 8 games with 1+ hits, 1+ walks and 1+ RBI are most in the Majors, ahead of Dansby Swanson/CHC (7) and Bo Bichette/TOR (6).

NEXT STARTER: RHP RYNE NELSON (1-1, 5.13)

- Is making his second start...has made 9 relief appearances with 1 save.
- Will make his first start vs. Dodgers since April 9, 2023...in 2 career starts, is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (3 ER in 12.0 IP), 0.83 WHIP, 4 walks and 9 strikeouts.
