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THE TWINS: Have gone 1-2 through three games on their final roadtrip of the season, losing on Thursday in Anaheim, winning on Friday, then losing again last night...today, Minnesota will play the four-game series finale at Angel Stadium...after today's game, they will head north to San Francisco for their final road series of the season, playing three against the Giants at Oracle Park from Monday-Wednesday.
✦ Twins have seven games remaining...after this roadtrip, they return home to finish the season with a three-game series vs. the Rangers from September 25-27.

ANOTHER LATE NIGHT LOSS: The Twins lost to the Angels last night in Anaheim by a score of 6-5 in 11 innings...it marked Minnesota's third extra-inning game in their last four days (1-2)...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...A.J. Minter blew his second save since joining the Twins, allowing a Vaughn Grissom solo home run in the ninth inning to tie the game at 5-5...the offense recorded 11 hits and went 3-for-18 with runners in scoring position...Victor Caratini led the offense, going 2-for-5 with two RBI...Walker Jenkins reached three times, going 2-for-4 with a walk...Ryan Kreidler hit his eighth home run of the season, a solo shot in the fifth inning.

MMM CALIFORNIA...BEAUTIFUL: The Twins and Angels are playing today for the seventh and final time in 2026...Twins are 3-3 vs. the Angels this season, going 2-1 at Target Field in July and 1-2 this week in Anaheim.
✦ These two will play seven games in 2027, four at Angel Stadium from May 3-6 and three at Target Field from June 7-9.
✦ Minnesota has gone 15-8 in its last 23 against the Angels, dating back to May of 2023...in that span, have a run differential of +49 (137-88).
✦ Minnesota's .667 winning percentage (12-6) vs. the Angels since the start of 2024 is their second-highest against any MLB opponent (Texas - .688, 11-5).
✦ Notables vs. Angels pitching this season: Brooks Lee is 7-for-21 (.333) with three doubles, three RBI and three walks...Walker Jenkins is 8-for-12 (.667) with two home runs, three RBI and one walk...Josh Bell is 7-for-24 (.292) with three doubles.
✦ Twins have gone just 6-12 against California teams this season, going 3-3 vs. the Angels, 0-3 vs. the Dodgers, 0-3 vs. San Diego and 3-3 vs. the Athletics.

S-LEE-PING GOOD ON THE ROAD: Over his last 14 road games, Brooks Lee is hitting .304 (17-for-56) with five doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .607 slugging percentage, and a .917 OPS...he has struck out just seven times in 58 plate appearances (12.1%).
✦ Lee has 23 home runs, ranking third on the Twins, trailing Kody Clemens (26) and Byron Buxton (25)...his 23 HR are tied with Cal Raleigh for third-most in baseball among switch hitters, trailing Elly De La Cruz (28) and Ian Happ (24).
✦ Lee's 23 homers are tied with Carlos Santana (2024) for fourth-most by a switch hitter in Twins history (since 1961), trailing Jorge Polanco (33 in 2021), Chili Davis (29 in 1991) and Roy Smalley (24 in 1979).
✦ Lee has 20 homers as a left-handed batter and three as a right-handed batter.

DOWN JENKINS, UP JENKINS: Walker Jenkins has eight hits in 12 at-bats this series, including two home runs, three RBI and just one strikeout...below are his first 16 career games (August 28-September 16), compared to his last three games:

KEEP THEIR HEADS RINGIN': Josh Bell drove in his 89th run on Friday night, which leads the team, in front of Brooks Lee (81) and Kody Clemens (76).
✦ 89 RBI are tied for eighth-most in the AL...the last Twin to finish the regular season in the top 10 in the AL in RBI was Eddie Rosario, completing the 2020 pandemic season tied for sixth with 42 RBI...the last in a full 162-game season was Rosario (109) and Nelson Cruz (108), finishing sixth and seventh in 2019.
✦ 89 RBI are the third-most of Bell's career (116 in 2019 and 90 in 2017).
✦ Bell is on pace to finish with 92 RBI, which would be the most for a Twin since Jorge Polanco drove in 98 in 2021.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis has set career-highs this season in games (119), runs (49), hits (100), doubles (24), RBI (54), stolen bases (15) and walks (38)...he needs two more home runs to match his career-high of 16, set in 2024.

BIG AL: Alan Roden has seven hits in his last 15 major league at-bats in five games, dating back to August 12...over that span, he is hitting .467 (7-for-15) with three doubles, two walks, a .529 on-base percentage, a .667 slugging percentage and a 1.196 OPS.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need a win today to draw a tie in the series...they have gone 21-26-2 in series play, 14-10-1 at home and 7-16-1 on the road.
✦ Twins have gone 1-2-2 in four-game series this season, going 4-0 vs. Detroit (April 6-9), 2-2 vs. Toronto (April 30-May 3), 1-3 vs. Chicago-AL (May 25-28), 1-3 vs. Kansas City (June 4-7) and 2-2 at Cleveland (July 20-23).
✦ Twins have gone 5-1-0 in their last six series vs. the Angels since September of 2023.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Kala'i Rosario and left-handed pitcher Kendry Rojas as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
✦ Rosario, 24, played in five games for the Saints, going 5-for-21 with one double, two home runs, four RBI, one walks, three runs scored and an .844 OPS.
✦ Rojas, who has made 12 appearances (4 starts) for the Twins earlier this season, started two games for the Saints this week, pitching 4.0 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, two walks and four strikeouts.

YOU THINK YOU KNOW D-SPAN: Did you know, Twins.TV analyst Denard Span hit his third career home run in this ballpark on August 22, 2008, a three-run shot off Shane Loux...he finished the day with three hits and four RBI in five plate appearances...fellow analyst Glen Perkins started and pitching 8.0 shutout innings in a Twins 9-0 victory.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2004, the Twins won their 88th game of the season and clinched the AL Central with an 8-2 win over Chicago-AL...it marked the Twins third consecutive division championship...they went on to lose to the Yankees in the ALDS, winning game one before losing the next three.
