TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets tonight continue a three-game weekend series with what is the 12th of 13 scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...This weekend marks the final scheduled games of the season between the intradivision opponents.

 New York never trailed in a win, 12-7, in the series opener last night, but Atlanta is 7-4 in 11 total games between the teams this season...The seven wins have already clinched the season series for the Braves this year, despite what happens this weekend.

 The Braves have now taken the season series from their NL East rivals for eight consecutive seasons dating to 2018, and are 75-48 (.610) against the club overall in that stretch...The Braves have won 30 of the last 44 games with New York dating to the 2022 season, outscoring the Mets 257-187 (+70) over the stretch.

 Atlanta swept all three games versus New York here at Truist Park earlier this season, outscoring the Mets, 17-5 (+12), from June 17 to June 19... Since Truist Park opened in 2017, the Braves are 41-27 (.603) against the Mets here in their home park.

 RH Clay Holmes tonight makes the fourth start and 14th appearance of his career against Atlanta, and owns a 2-1 record with a 3.70 ERA (10 ER/24.1 IP) all-time against the Braves...Five of the 10 career earned runs he has surrendered to Atlanta came 11 days ago at Citi Field, when the right-hander allowed six hits and five runs over just 3.2 innings in a no-decision...In three total starts against the Braves this season, the Alabama native is 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (9 ER/13.1 IP) and has walked 15 batters.

CAL QUANTRILL: Is set tonight to make his Braves debut, after the club claimed him off waivers from the Miami Marlins on Thursday...In 24 starts for Miami this season, the 6-foot-3, 195-pound Canadian went 4-10 with a 5.50 ERA (67 ER/109.2 IP).

 Quantrill allowed no more than three earned runs in 17 of his 24 starts this season, including two starts against Atlanta in which he allowed just one run over 9.0 combined innings.

 The right-hander has never beaten New York, pitching to an 0-1 record with a 7.07 ERA (11 ER/14.0 IP) in three career turns against them...In his only such start this season, March 31 in Miami, he allowed eight hits and six runs over 4.0 innings to take the loss.

 The eighth overall selection in the 2016 First-Year Player Draft by the San Diego Padres, Quantrill is a veteran of parts of seven major league seasons and owns a career record of 47-44 with a 4.26 ERA over 185 appearances, 147 of which have been starts.

 A native of Port Hope, Ontario, Quantrill compiled a career-best 3.7 bWAR with Cleveland in 2021, pitching to a 2.89 ERA over 40 total appearances and 22 starts.

NUMBER OF STARTERS: Cal Quantrill tonight will become the 17th different starting pitcher for Atlanta this season, tying the Chicago White Sox for the most in baseball...The 17 different starters are also the most in a single season in franchise history.

 Quantrill joins Grant Holmes (21 starts), Bryce Elder (21), Spencer Schwellenbach (17), Spencer Strider (17), Chris Sale (15), AJ Smith-Shawver (9), Joey Wentz (7), Erick Fedde (4), Didier Fuentes (4), Hurston Waldrep (3), Carlos Carrasco (3), Aaron Bummer (2), Davis Daniel (2), Austin Cox (1), Scott Blewett (1) and Reynaldo López (1) to pitch in the Braves rotation this year.

 The franchise had used 16 different starters in five prior seasons, last using as many just two years ago in 2023...The club also did so in 2016, 1945, 1936 and initially in 1911.

 The highest amount of unique starting pitchers by any club in history is 24, done twice by the Athletics...The franchise first did so while in Philadelphia in 1915, and matched it in 2023 while in Oakland.

JURICKSON PROFAR: Went 3-for-4 and plated four more runs last night, and has driven in 13 total runs over his last five games dating to Sunday's series finale in Cleveland...That is by far the most RBI over any five-game stretch of his career.

 Since RBI became official in 1920, Profar is one of just five MLB players to record 13 RBI in a five-game span exclusively out of the leadoff position... He joins Jack Tobin (SLB, 1923), Max Kepler (MIN, 2019), Kyle Schwarber (WSH, 2021) and Shohei Ohtani (LAD, 2024)...Research confirmed by the Elias Sports Bureau.

 Regardless of batting order position, Profar is one of eight major leaguers with a matching span this season.

 Since 2008, he joins three other Braves in driving in 13 runs in a five-game span: Freddie Freeman (16 RBI, 2020), Ozzie Albies (13 RBI, 2021) and Austin Riley (16 RBI, 2023).

NACHO ALVAREZ JR.: Doubled twice last night, going 2-for-4 with a pair of runs scored...The two hits extended his career-best hitting streak to six straight games, including back-to-back multi-hit efforts.

 Alvarez Jr. is 10-for-24 in the six games, batting .417/.440/.542 with a .982 OPS...He has driven in three.

 The 5-foot-10 native of Fontana, CA is batting .259/.337/.341 over a career-most 25 games with Atlanta this season, after appearing in just eight games during his debut campaign last year...He is currently rated by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 6 prospect, and as the No. 3 position prospect in the system.

Their league-leading ERA comes on the heels of a 5.91 ERA (70 ER/106.2 IP) in July, fourth-highest in all of baseball and the highest single-month ERA for a Braves bullpen since July of 2017.

Atlanta has yet to blow a save this month, going a perfect 9-for-9 in save opportunities. The Athletics, who have converted all four save chances, are the only other team yet to blow a save in August.
