BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles began a 10-game homestand, their longest of the year, on Friday against the Detroit Tigers (2-1)...The Tampa Bay Rays (1-0, 2 to play) and Toronto Blue Jays (4 G) will be at Oriole Park this week...Baltimore went 1-5 on the last road trip at Washington (1-2) and Tampa Bay (0-3).

⚾ The Orioles snapped a three-game skid against Tampa Bay following yesterday's 9-7 walk-off win...It marked the O's first 13-inning game since May 20, 2022 vs. Tampa Bay, when Ronged Odor hit a walk-off two-run blast off Ralph Garza Jr.

⚾ Yesterday's 4-hour, 12-minute affair is tied for the longest game, by time, of any MLB game in 2026, joining the Rays and Pirates, who played a 13-inning game on April 18 at PNC Park.

⚾ The Orioles' victory yesterday marked the first time in franchise history (regular season or postseason) in which they trailed in at least three separate extra innings and won the game...It also marked the ninth time in MLB history in which a team trailed in 3+ separate extra innings and won the game (including regular season and postseason), becoming the first team to do so since the Oakland Athletics defeated the Detroit Tigers on September 6, 2024 after trailing in the 10th, 11th, and 12th innings before securing the win in 13 innings.

⚾ Kyle Bradish has allowed no more than two runs in at least three straight starts for the first time since doing so in eight straight from June 8, 2024-September 28, 2025...Has completed at least 5.1 innings in four straight starts for the first time since doing so in eight straight games from August 13-September 26, 2023.

⚾ Colton Cowser recorded his second walk-off homer in as many days, having walked off the Tigers in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Cowser became the second player in franchise history (since 1954) to hit a walk-off home run on consecutive days, joining Fred Lynn, who did so from May 10-11, 1985.

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game, the Orioles recalled LHP Nick Raquet from Triple-A Norfolk and designated LHP Dietrich Enns for assignment.

THE WIZARD OF BAZ: Shane Baz has allowed three runs or fewer in three of his last five starts since April 28, including allowing just one run in two of those starts (4/28 vs. HOU & 5/20 at TB).

⚾ His last start marked the first time in which he's completed at least 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer hits since April 14, 2025 vs. Boston (also 6.0 IP & 2 H).

⚾ He has completed at least 13.0 innings over a two-game span for the eighth time in his career and for the first time as an Oriole after last doing so from July 1-7, 2025 (also 13.0 IP).

MOVING THINGS ALONG: Colton Cowser is slashing .333/.368/.833 (6-for-18) with three home runs, five runs scored, seven RBI, one walk, and one stolen base over his last eight games since May 17 after slashing .067/.125/.067 (1-for-15) in his previous seven games from May 5-15.

⚾ His 440-foot walk-off home run in Game 1 of Sunday's doubleheader was the third furthest of his career (455 ft. - 6/7/25 at ATH & 443 ft. - 6/16/24 vs. PHI).

⚾ The 440-foot shot marked the furthest hit home run at Oriole Park this season, surpassing Samuel Basallo's 437-foot blast on April 1 vs. Texas.

⚾ His three Outs Above Average (OAA) lead the Orioles, while being tied for seventh most among all AL outfielders.

MAY IN BLOOM: Blaze Alexander is slashing .333/.373/.417 (16-for-48) with two doubles, one triple, five runs scored, six RBI, three walks (1 IBB), and three stolen bases over 20 games in May after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

⚾ Coby Mayo owns an .816 OPS with one double and two homers in 12 games since May 7 after posting a .501 OPS with three doubles and three homers through his first 31 games of the season.

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: Samuel Basallo is slashing .348/.385/.584 (31-for-89) with seven doubles, one triple, four homers, 13 runs scored, 15 RBI, and six walks in 27 games since April 20...Among players with at least 90 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (4th), slugging percentage (T-5th), and OPS (7th, .970).

⚾ He's hit safely in 19 of his 25 games since April 22, including a career-high 10 straight from May 1-17...He's also scored a run in nine of 16 games since May 5.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward ranks among MLB leaders in walks (2nd, 48), times on base (3rd, 98), doubles (T-3rd, 15), and on-base percentage (7th, .403).

⚾ According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in the majors in on-base percentage was Eddie Murray in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 98 times on base are the fifth most in a players' first 53 games to begin his time with the Orioles, trailing Roberto Alomar (115 in 1996), Frank Robinson (107 in 1966), Ken Singleton (101 in 1975), and Rafael Palmeiro (100 in 1994).

⚾ Ward has seen 1,074 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,089)...He has seen 390 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, which ranks second in MLB behind CWS' Munetaka Murakami (393).

POLAR PETE: Pete Alonso is batting .284/.337/.545 (25-for-88) with five doubles, six home runs, 13 runs, 20 RBI, eight walks, and one steal in 23 games this month...During that time, he is tied for third in the majors in RBI with WSH's CJ Abrams, CIN's JJ Bleday, and PHI's Bryson Stott, trailing ATH's Nick Kurtz (22) and LAD's Andy Pages (21)...He entered May hitting .198/.306/.362 (23-for-116) with seven doubles, four homers, 17 runs, 13 RBI, 17 walks, and one steal in 31 games.

⚾ Alonso's three defensive runs saved (DRS) are tied for the fifth most among MLB first basemen with five others, trailing SD's Ty France and ATL's Matt Olson (both 5) and MIN's Kody Clemens and PIT's Spencer Horwitz (both 4)...Last year, his -9 DRS ranked last among MLB first basemen.

HOME COOKING: Baltimore is 15-13 at Oriole Park this season...Eighteen of the team's 28 home games have been decided by three runs or less with the O's going 9-9 in those...The Orioles have split all four homestands this year.

⚾ O's hurlers have produced a 3.89 ERA (111 ER/257.0 IP) in 28 home games this season compared to a 5.86 ERA (144 ER/221.1 IP) in 26 road games.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 11th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 20 at Tampa Bay after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering two hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts...Threw 94 pitches, 57 strikes.

⚡ Has made back-to-back quality starts after not recording one in each of his first eight outings...Marks his first such occurrence since doing so in two straight from August 26-September 1, 2025...He last made three straight quality starts during a four-outing run from June 26-July 12, 2025.

⚡ Limited left-handed Rays to a 1-for-12 (.083) clip with five strikeouts, with the lone damage being a Hunter Feduccia solo homer in the second frame...Prior to the outing, lefties were hitting .316 (36-for-114) with 15 doubles and two home runs off Baz.

⚡ Has issued 3+ walks in a career-high four straight starts since May 4.

FAMILIAR FOE: Baz is set to make his second career start against his former club... He made 63 starts with Tampa Bay from 2021-25, going 17-17 with a 4.25 ERA (135 ER/286.0 IP).

LEFT SIDE STORY: He has limited lefties to a .203 (12-for-59) clip over his last five starts after they went 25-for-67 (.373) with 10 doubles over his first five outings.

⚡ During his most recent five-start stretch, Baz has limited lefties to a .148 (4-for-27) clip with one home run off his knuckle curve...Over his first five starts, left-handed hitters went 12-for-32 (.375) with five doubles on the offering.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 21 doubles, ahead of COL's Michael Lorenzen and KC's Seth Lugo (both 18)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 10 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

TEEING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .444/459/806 (16-for-36) with seven doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.265 opponent OPS on the first pitch is the second highest in MLB (min. 35 BF), ahead of AZ's Ryne Nelson (1.343).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 16 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted seven home runs over 85.2 innings (0.74 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ He has, however, allowed one homer in each of his last five starts, the second-longest streak of his career behind a seven-start stretch from May 1-June 4, 2025.

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 3-for-22 (.136) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

⚡ Has limited opponents to a .231 (18-for-78) mark the first time through the lineup, compared to a combined 40-for-138 (.290) clip the second, third, and fourth time through.
