SNAKEBITES

ON YOUR MARK...GET SET...GO: The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefiting cancer research and patient care is tomorrow morning at Chase Field.

NL WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race on August 1 but were one of baseball’s best teams the last 2 months, playing nearly .600 baseball, to pull into a tie for fourth place and 1.0 game behind entering Thursday’s game...overall, went 29-22 in 51 games from Aug. 1-Sept. 25 to enter last night’s game fifth in the race and 2.0 games behind before being eliminated from postseason consideration.

SNAKE BITES: The D-backs are 8-6 in their last 14 games.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez**, in his last 2 road starts, both wins, has tossed 12.1 shutout frames (6 H, 6 BB, 10 K)...in his last 5 road starts (3 quality), is 4-1 with a 2.70 ERA (8 ER in 26.2 IP).
- **Geraldo Perdomo’s** 15-game on-base streak is tied for the longest streak of his career (third time; April 3-19, 2025; July 29-Aug. 14, 2025)...during his current 15-gamer, is hitting .382 (21-for-55)/1.144 OPS with 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers, 7 RBI, 11 walks (7 K) and 3 hit by pitches.

LAST GAME: The D-backs lost 7-4 @ Padres.

- **Zac Gallen** allowed 6 runs (5 earned) over 4.1 innings (7 H, 3 BB, 3 K) in his final start of the season.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** had 2 doubles and 1 walk, his 43rd game reaching base 3+ times, first in the NL and second in the Majors to Aaron Judge/ NYY (51)...tied for the fifth-most such games by a D-back all-time.
- **Ketel Marte** and **Jake McCarthy** both hit solo home runs.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** had 2 singles, 1 RBI and 1 walk.

STIFF COMPETITION: The D-backs’ last 27 games (16-11) included all 3 NL division winners (@ Brewers, @ Dodgers, vs. Phillies, vs. Dodgers), 2 Wild Card qualifiers (vs. Red Sox, @ Padres) and 2 teams in the thick of the Wild Card Race at the time (vs. Rangers, @ Giants, vs. Giants).

START ME UP: The D-backs starting rotation is among the best in the Majors since Aug. 27 ranking tied for first with 17 quality starts, fourth with a 3.07 ERA, tied for fourth with 12 starter wins, fifth with 152.1 innings, sixth with 57 runs allowed and sixth with an opponent .659 OPS.

ROUNDTRIPPERS: The D-backs’ 212 home runs are fourth most in a season in franchise history behind 2017 (220), 2019 (220) and 1999 (216) and ahead of 2024 (211) and 2001 (208).

- The D-backs have 4 seasons of 200+ homers since 2017 (2017, ‘19, ‘24, ‘25) after having 2 such seasons from 1998-2016 (1999, 2001).
- The D-backs are 1 of 4 teams with 200+ homers in each of the last 2 seasons (423 HR: 211 in 2024, 212 in 2025) with the Yankees (506 HR: 237 in 2024, 272 in 2025), Dodgers (473 HR: 233 in 2024, 240 in 2025), and Mets (430 HR: 207 in 2024, 223 in 2025).

EXTRA BASES: **Corbin Carroll’s** 80 extra-base hits are tied for second most in a season in club history with Luis Gonzalez (2000), behind Gonzalez in 2001 (100 XBH).

- 1 OF 3: Geraldo Perdomo** (171 H, 94 BB, 97 R, 98 RBI) is the third D-back (seventh time) with a minimum of 160 hits, 90 walks, 90 runs and 90 RBI in a season with Luis Gonzalez (2001, ‘03) and Paul Goldschmidt (2013, ‘15, ‘16, ‘17).
- Since Perdomo’s first full season in 2022, is 1 of 7 players in the Majors (10 times) to reach a minimum 160 hits, 90 walks, 90 runs and 90 RBI with Mookie Betts (2023), Alex Bregman (2023), Aaron Judge (2022, ‘24, ‘25), Shohei Ohtani (2025), Matt Olson (2023, ‘25) and Juan Soto (2024).

1 OF 1: Corbin Carroll (.884 OPS, 107 R, 146 H, 32 2B, 17 3B, 31 HR, 84 RBI, 67 BB, 32 SB) is the only player in Major League history with a season with an .850+ OPS, 100+ runs scored, 140+ hits, 30+ doubles, 15+ triples, 30+ home runs, 80+ RBI, 60+ walks and 30+ stolen bases.

- Lowering the qualifiers to 10+ triples, Carroll is 1 of 2 players all-time to reach those marks with Ken Williams/St. Louis Browns (1922).

700 PA, 2900 P: Geraldo Perdomo is the third D-back with 700+ plate appearances in a season with Luis Gonzalez (2000, ‘01) and Paul Goldschmidt (2013, ‘16).

- Perdomo (2,965 pitches) is 1 of 3 D-backs to see 2,900+ pitches in a season with Jay Bell (1999 - 3,022) and Paul Goldschmidt (2013 - 2,930 / 2015 - 2,917 / 2016 - 3,012 / 2018 - 2,905)...since his first full season in 2022, is 1 of 10 players (14 times) to see 2,900+ pitches.

VETERAN LEADERSHIP: James McCann has hit safely in 7 of his last 9 games (.313 AVG, 10-for-32, .896 OPS, 2 2B, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 1 HBP).

- **Ildemaro Vargas** has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 road games (.345 AVG, 10-for-29, .815 OPS, 1 HR, 7 RBI, 1 BB).
 - From Sept. 2-20, hit safely in 10 of 11 games (.343 AVG, 12-for-35, .780 OPS, 1 HR, 8 RBI, 1 BB).

BACKSTOPS: Gabriel Moreno has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .316 (18-for-57)/.868 OPS, including 5 straight road games (.429, 9-for-21, 1.214OPS).

- Had a career-best 13 game on-base streak from Sept. 7-24, hitting .354 (17-for-48)/.978 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 7 RBI and 10 walks (6 K).

YEAR OF THE SNAKE: Geraldo Perdomo’s 6.9 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is fourth in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (9.5), Cal Raleigh/ SEA (7.2) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (7.0) and ahead of Julio Rodriguez/SEA (6.8) and Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.4).

- Perdomo’s 6.9 bWAR is the fourth-best by a D-backs position player in a season all-time behind Paul Goldschmidt (8.3 in 2015), Luis Gonzalez (7.9 in 2001) and Ketel Marte (6.9 in 2019).

- **Perdomo’s** 7.1 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (7.2) and ahead of Trea Turner/ PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.5).

1-2-3-WHEEEEE: Over the last 10 games, since Sept. 15, **Geraldo Perdomo**, **Ketel Marte** and **Corbin Carroll** are hitting a combined .331 (40-for-121)/.964 OPS with 14 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers, 17 RBI, 14 walks (21 K), 3 hit by pitches and 5 stolen bases..Perdomo has hit safely in 9 of 10 games and Corbin and Marte have hit safely in 8 of 10 games.

THE RESURGENCE: Since August 1, the D-backs’ 29-22 (.569) record is third in the NL and eighth in the Majors: Phillies (34-18, .654), Mariners (32-18, .640), Yankees (32-19, .627), Brewers (32-20, .615), Guardians (32-20, .615), Red Sox (29-21, .580), Athletics (28-21, .571), **D-backs (29-22, .569).**

- The D-backs’ 12-9 record in September is tied for seventh in the Majors with the Athletics behind the Mariners (17-5), Guardians (18-6), Yankees (15-7), Phillies (15-7), Orioles (14-8) and Braves (13-9).
- The D-backs’ 17-12 mark in August was fourth in the Majors to the Brewers (21-9), Phillies (18-11) and Red Sox (17-11).

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (13-8, 5.00)

- Is making his career-best 33rd start (32 GS in 2024).
- This season, in 2 starts vs. Padres, is 2-0 with a 2.63 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP), an opponent .180 AVG (9-for-50)/.546 OPS, 3 walks and 8 strikeouts.
- In 4 road starts @ Padres, is 1-1 with a 2.92 ERA (8 ER in 24.2 IP).

SNAKEBITES

AT A GLANCE: Second season with the D-backs (10th overall in MLB; did not pitch in 2020).

- Signed a 4-year contract in December 2023 (2024-2027) with a conditional option for the fifth year.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- Finished tied for sixth in the 2019 AL Cy Young Award vote after going 19-6 with a 3.81 ERA (86 ER in 203.1 IP) and 213 strikeouts.
- Was a member of the 2018 World Series Champion Red Sox.
- From 2018-23, his 63 wins tied for third most in the AL (also: Justin Verlander), behind Gerrit Cole (86) and Jose Berrios (66).

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Since 2015, his 94 wins are third among active lefty starters, behind Clayton Kershaw (124) and Chris Sale (100) while his 1,291 strikeouts rank eighth.

- Has quality starts in 4 of his last 5 starts, going 4-0 (team is 5-0) with a 1.84 ERA (6 ER in 29.1 IP), opponent .224 AVG (124-for-107), 12 walks and 21 strikeouts.
- Owns a 14.1 scoreless streak @ NL West opponents (dating back to the sixth inning on Aug. 14 @ COL).
- In his last 3 starts @ NL West opponents, is 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER in 19.1 IP), opponent .179 AVG (12-for-67)/.510 OPS, 0.98 WHIP, 7 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- The D-backs are 9-1 in his 10 starts post All-Star Break.
- Celebrated 10 years of MLB service time on July 6.

LAST START: Earned the win in a quality start on Sept. 21 vs. Phillies, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings on 6 hits and 3 walks with 5 strikeouts.

- Is scoreless in 2 of his 3 career starts, going 1-1 with a 2.30 ERA (4 ER in 15.2 IP), 5 walks and 12 strikeouts.

VS. NL WEST: Has won 3 consecutive road starts vs. NL West and the team is 5-0 in his last 5 (vs. Giants, @ Giants, @ Dodgers, @ Rockies, vs. Rockies)...had a career-high 4-game win streak from July 12-Sept. 19, 2019 (1.80 ERA) while with the Red Sox.

- Did not factor in the decision in his most recent start on Sept. 16 vs. Giants (5 ER in 5.0 IP)...of his final 15 batters faced from the second-fifth innings, allowed only 2 singles, 1 solo homer and 1 walk.
- Earned the win in his last road start on Sept. 10 @ Giants, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings with 2 hits, 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.
