## Cincinnati Reds (39-45) at New York Yankees (54-32) RHP Graham Ashcraft (4-4, 5.45) vs RHP Luis Gil (9-3, 3.15) Game #85 / Road Game #42 - July 2, 2024 - Yankee Stadium - 7:05 p.m. ET TV: Bally Sports Ohio | Radio: 700 WLW

**TODAY'S TRANSACTION:** Returned from the family medical emergency list **C Tyler Stephenson**; designated for assignment **C Austin Wynns**.

### TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Is the first game of a 3-game series vs **Kaitlyn Brennan's Yankees** and Game 5 (2-2) of a 7-game road trip that includes a 4-game series split vs the **Cardinals** at **Busch Stadium** (Thu-Sun).
- The Reds on Sun at **StL** concluded a stretch in which they played 23 of 31 games against the NL Central (1-2 vs **StL**, 2-1 at **Chc**, 3-1 vs **Chc**, 1-2 at **Mil**, 1-2 at **Pit**, 1-2 vs **Pit**, 2-2 at **StL**)...**Col** (3-0), **Cle** (1-1), and **Bos** (1-2) were the non-NL Central opps in that span which began 5/27.
- Following this series in the Bronx, the Redlegs return home to host **Det** (3g), **Col** (4g), and **Mia** (3g) in a 10-game homestand before the break.

**STRIKES AND GUTTERS:** The Reds are in fourth place in the National League Central, trailing the first-place Brewers by 10.5 games, the second-place Cardinals by 4.5 games, and the third-place Pirates by 1.5 games.

- Cin opened the season by winning 16 of its first 29 games (.552).
- From 4/30-5/23 the Reds went 4-17 (.190).
- The Redlegs won 7 straight games from 6/2-6/8 and 14 of 19 games from 5/24-6/14 but have dropped 10 of their last 15 games.
- The Reds are winless in their last 6 series (0-4-2)...last won a series when they took 3 of 4 games from the Cubs at GABP 6/6-6/9.

**SERIES NOTES:** The Reds and Yankees are meeting for the third straight year.

- Cin is 4-4-1 in 9 regular season series vs NYY...the Yankees swept the Reds in 3 games last year at Great American Ball Park.
- The teams met in 3 World Series, including Yankees wins in 1939 (4-0) and 1961 (4-1) and the Big Red Machine's 4-0 sweep in 1976.
- Before the interleague schedule expanded last season to include games vs all 15 American League teams, from 1997-2022 the Redlegs went 188-247 (.432) vs the American League, the lowest interleague winning percentage of any Major League team.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Major League Baseball yesterday announced **2b Jonathan India** as the National League Player of the Week for 6/24-6/30.

- India hit safely in all 7 games he played last week.
- Led the league in batting avg (.538), hits (14), doubles (10), SLG (.923), OPS (1.536), runs scored (8), XBH (10), TB (24), and ranked second in OBP (.613)...from 6/24-6/26 he reached base safely in 11 straight PAs.
- It's his first career NL Player of the Week Award.
- India is the second Red to be named NL Player of the Week in 2024, joining **Spencer Steer** (4/1-4/7).

**LOCKED IN(DIA):** **2b Jonathan India** is currently riding a 12-game hitting streak (22-for-45, .489)...Sun at StL went 1-for-4 with a double...it was 1 of only 2 hits Cin had in the 2-0 loss...the notes below are courtesy of **Elias**.

- Has recorded a double in 8 straight games, a franchise record since at least 1900.
- Is 1 of just 4 players since 1900 with a double in 8 straight games.
- Is just the second Reds batter and the fifth Major Leaguer since 1900 to produce 11 doubles over any 8-game, single-season span (**Joey Votto** 2009, **Goose Goslin** 1933, **Paul Waner** 1932, **Sam West** 1931).
- Has an extra-base hit in each of his last 8 games, the longest-such streak by a Redlegs batter since **Joey Votto** in 2021 (8g, 7/23-7/30)...only 2 other Reds have collected an XBH in 9 straight games: **Pete Rose** in 1966 and **Sam Crawford** in 1900.
- From 6/22-6/29 had multiple hits in 8 straight games...was the longest multi-hit game streak by a Cin batter since **Chris Stynes** did it in 8 straight games from 7/8-7/18, 2000...only 2 Reds since 1901 had multi-hit streaks of 9+ games (**Tony Pérez**, 11g in 1973 & **Ted Kluszewski**, 9g in 1955) .

**ELLECTRICITY:** **SS Elly De La Cruz** leads the majors with 40 stolen bases.

- Is on pace to steal 77 bases, which would be the most by a Major Leaguer since **NYM's José Reyes** stole 78 bases during the 2007 season.
- Has 14 HR (on pace for 27 HR)...trying to become the fourth Red with 30+ HR & 30+ SB in the same season (last: **Brandon Phillips** in 2007).
- 6/6 marked the 1-year anniversary of his Major League debut...entered that night's game with 67 career steals and 57 career extra-base hits...no other player since 1900 collected as many as 65 steals and 50 XBH within 1 year of his first game in the majors *courtesy Elias*.

**RUNNIN' REDLEGS:** The Reds lead MLB with 123 steals, including 100 steals of second, 21 steals of third, and 2 steals of home (**Spencer Steer**, 4/6 vs NYM and **Elly De La Cruz**, 4/26 at Tex)...have 6 games with 5+ SB, incl. Sat at StL.

- Cin led the majors with 190 SB in 2023...haven't led the majors in steals in consecutive seasons since 1972 & 1973...would be the first team to lead the majors in steals in back-to-back years since KC in 2013 & 2014...would be the first NL team to do it since Fla in 2002 & 2003.
- Are on pace for 237 SB, which would be their most since 1912 (248sb).

**STARTING OFF STRONG:** The Reds won the first game of each of their last 3 series (6/27 at StL, 6/24 vs Pit, & 6/21 vs Bos), giving them 12 wins in their last 15 series openers (since 5/10 at SF)...the only Game Ones they lost in that span were 5/13 at AZ, 6/11 vs Cle, and 6/17 at Pit.

- The Reds are 18-9 (.667) in series openers in 2024....went 30-20 in 2023.

## 2024:

- On Wed was recalled from AAA-Louisville and made that day's start vs Pit (L, 5.1ip, 9h, 6r/6er, 1bb, 3k, 2hr, 89TP).
- Made 2 starts for the AAA-Louisville Bats (1-1, 3.00era, 2 quality starts, 12.0ip, 10h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 12k, 1hr).
- Was optioned to Louisville following his start on 6/5 at Col (3.2ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 0bb, 2k, 1hbp, 18bf, 73TP)...that outing was his shortest of the season and his shortest since 6/8/23 vs LAD (2.2ip).
- Made 41 consecutive starts with the Major League Reds dating back to 9/24/22 until he was optioned to AAA-Louisville on 6/5.
- Will make his 14th start for the Reds in 2024, his 59th career start, and his second-ever vs the Yankees (7/12/22).
- On 5/24 vs LAD earned the 9-6 win (5.1ip, 8h, 5r/5er, 1bb, 3k, 1hr, 89TP) and eclipsed the 300.0-inning mark for his Major League career.
- On 4/26 at Tex, exactly 1 year after he last faced the Rangers, produced a season-high 6.1 innings and held Tex to 1 run in the 2-1 Cin loss.
- On 4/14 at CHW, earned the 11-4 victory...collected his 200th career strikeout (**Andrew Vaughn**, 6th inning)...marked his 14th career app in which he pitched at least 5.2 innings and allowed 1 earned run or fewer.
- In his season debut on Tue (4/2) at Phi, gave up 3 runs (2er) on 4 hits over 6.0 innings (1bb, 5k) in the 9-4 loss...was his 25th career quality start.
- In Spring Training went 1-1 with a 5.52 ERA in 4 starts (14.2ip, 13h, 9r/9er, 8bb, 12k, .241oba).

**PERSONAL:** Graduated from Huntsville (AL) High School... played at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and Mississippi State University... played in the 2015 Perfect Game National Showcase... enjoys hunting and fishing and painting fishing lures.

## 2024:

- Will make his 17th start of the season, his 38th career start and his first ever start vs the Yankees.
- Has won 4 of his last 5 starts, including Thu at StL in which he allowed 2 runs on 2 hits over 5.0 innings (6bb, 2k, 1hr)...his 6 walks marked a career high...became the first Reds pitcher to pitch 6 batters and earn the victory since **RHP Luis Castillo** did it on 6/17/19 vs Hou...became the first Reds pitcher to throw at least 102 pitches with 57 or fewer strikes and earn a win since **RHP Sonny Gray** did it on 8/26/19 at Mia (102 pitches/56 strikes).
- On 6/21 vs Bos and struck out a season-high 10 batters (5.2ip, 4h, 2r/2er, 1bb, 2hr, 90TP)...earned the 5-2 win to even his record at 6-6...was his third career double-digit strikeout game (also: 12k 7/2/23 vs SD & 10k 6/21/23 vs Col).
- On 6/15 at Mil, pitched 4.0 scoreless innings before **Joey Ortiz** hit a 3-run HR in the 5th...suffered the 3-1 loss (5.0ip, 4h, 3r/3er, 3bb, 3k, 1hr, 94TP).
- On 6/8 vs Chc, earned the 4-3 win to help extend the Reds' winning streak to 7 games (5ip, 5h, 1r/1er, 4bb, 5k, 0hr, 99 TP).
- Pitched at least 6.0 innings in 4 straight starts from 5/15-6/3, matching a career high (also: 6/16-7/2, 2023).
- Didn't allow a run over 14.0 innings from 5/15-5/28.
- Pitched a season-high 7.0 innings in back-to-back starts on 5/15 at AZ and 5/21 vs SD; also on 4/12 at CHW.
- In the 2-0 win vs SD on 5/21, produced his only scoreless start of 2024...was his second-career scoreless start of at least 7.0ip (also: 8ip, 7/20/23 vs SF).
- His 3.66 ERA (199ip, 82r/81er) through his first 37 career starts is the lowest by a Cin lefthanded starter since **Norm Charlton** (3.43 ERA/ first 37 starts).
- On 5/10 at SF, allowed a pair of runs on 6 hits and 1 walk in the 4-2 win, to help snap Cin's 8-game losing skid.
- In the 2-1 loss on 5/4 vs Bal, held the Orioles to 2 runs on 7 hits with no walks and a season-high 8 strikeouts over 5.0 innings...it was his sixth career game in which fanned at least 8 batters.
- Is holding opponents to a .224/.292/.424 slash line.

## INSTAGRAHAM:

- Led the 2023 staff in starts (26), quality starts (15) and innings pitched (145.2) despite stints on the 15-day disabled list with a left calf contusion (6/9-6/23) and broken toes in his right foot (9/2-remainder of the season).
- On 9/19/23 had surgery to repair fractures in his right big toe and right second toe.
- In his last 12 apps of the 2023 season, beginning 6/30, went 4-3, 2.58 (.228baa) with 10 of his 15 quality starts.
- In the 5-3 walkoff win on 4/26 vs Tex, pitched 2 days after the death of his 82-year-old grandmother, Ann Ashcraft, a Rangers fan who lived in Fort Worth...the next day went on the bereavement list...in his next start, on 5/2 at SD, allowed 1 run in 6.0 innings.

**ACQUIRED:** Was selected by Reds in the sixth round of the 2019 first-year player draft.
