THE GRAPEFRUIT LEAGUE: The St. Louis Cardinals enter their 135th season of play in the National League and are conducting their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) ... The Cardinals previously hosted spring training at Al Lang Stadium (1947-1997) in St. Petersburg.

THE GRAPEFRUIT GANG: The 2026 Cardinals Major League Spring Training roster sports 68 players with 28 non-roster invitees ... 49 in camp were signed/drafted and developed by the Cardinals, including seven first round picks: INF Nolan Gorman (2018), LHP Zack Thompson (2019), OF Jordan Walker (2020), RHP Michael McGreevy (2021), LHP Cooper Hjerpe (2022), OF Chase Davis (2023), and INF JJ Wetherholt (2024).

FINS AND FEATHERS: The Cardinals play their 2nd of six Spring matchups today against the Miami Marlins in the stadium that both teams call home during Spring Training ... Since 2006, the Cardinals are 24-30-7 against the Fish as the visiting team at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium.

NEW TO THE FLOCK: Hunter Dobbins is scheduled for three up-downs this morning on the Cardinals Back Fields, while Ryne Stanek is penciled to make his Grapefruit League debut this afternoon against the Marlins ... Dustin May, who threw parts of three innings in a simulated game on the Cardinals Back Fields yesterday, is scheduled to start March 5 in Bradenton against the Pirates.

BE OUR GUEST: Those scheduled to visit Jupiter in a coaching capacity this Spring Training include special Guest Instructors David Freese, Kolten Wong, Adam Wainwright, and Ozzie Smith, and Cardinals Special Assistants Yadier Molina and Willie McGee.

GEORGE KISSELL AWARD: Dominican Summer League Cardinals (R) Manager Fray Peniche was recently named the 2025 recipient of the George Kissell Award ... Since 2008, winners have been selected by a poll of Cardinals minor league staff ... The award is presented to a Cardinals staffer who exhibits excellence in player development ... Peniche, 52, enters his 16th season as a coach in the Cardinals organization (28th overall), all as manager for the DSL Cardinals at the Cardinals Dominican Academy in Boca Chica ... The Dominican native has compiled a 449-462 record since he was hired in 2011.

PARDON OUR DUST: St. Louis moved into its newly-renovated Cardinals Complex this spring, featuring a new performance center, conference center, clubhouse and "Birdfeeder" dining hall...the final phase of the three phase project that began back in 2023 is slated to be completed later this year.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (February 28, 1989): Hall of Fame president Ed Stack calls Red Schoendienst to share the good news that the 10-time All-Star and two-time World Series Champion has been elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame by the Veterans Committee ... The 66-year-old Schoendienst was inducted in Cooperstown with Johnny Bench, Carl Yastrzemski, umpire Al Barlick, broadcaster Harry Caray, and writers Bob Hunter and Ray Kelly.

HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES: The Cardinals recently celebrated their 7th high school graduating class with three players earning their diploma from the Cardinals Baseball Academy in the Dominican Republic: Jarol Baez (hahr-ohl), Edward Guribe (goo-REE-bay), and Xavier Cruz (zah-vee-air).

WORLD CLASS: The Cardinals have nine players, two coaches, and one athletic trainer on provisional rosters for the 2026 World Baseball Classic taking place from March 5-17 ... Among those in Major League camp include Riley O'Brien (Korea), Leo Bernal (Panama), Gordon Graceffo (Italy), Thomas Saggese (Italy), Luis Gastelum (Mexico), Matt Koperniak (Great Britain), Bryan Torres (Puerto Rico), coaches Stubby Clapp (Canada), Julio Rangel (Panama), and Certified Asst. Athletic Trainer Chris Conroy (Puerto Rico).

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced Chaim Bloom on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by John Mozeliak who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

THE NEST: A newly-released Cardinals Productions feature about Matthew Liberatore has debuted online at youtube.com/Cardinals ... The 20-minute long-form video offers Cardinals fans an inside look at a Major League offseason alongside the starting pitcher and his wife, Natalie, at their home in Arizona.

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#36 MICHAEL McGREEVY · RHP · 6-4 · 230 LBS · AGE 25

- Cardinals 1st round pick in 2021 made his Major League debut vs. Texas on July 31, 2024, throwing 7.0 innings and allowing one run in a 10-1 victory.
- Has 11 wins in his first 21 Major League games, 6th Cardinals pitcher to achieve that mark and first since Luis Arroyo in 1955. Jack Harper set the franchise record with 14 wins in 1901. Bobby Miller of the Dodgers was the last in MLB with 11 (2023).
- His .769 win percentage Post All-Star Break over the past two seasons (2024-25) is the best among starting pitchers. His 7 wins post All-Star Break ranked T-5th among Major League pitchers. Most by a Cardinals pitcher since Adam Wainright went 10-2 post All-Star Break in 2021.
- Ranked among 2025 NL rookies in Wins (8, T-2nd), Innings Pitched (95.2, 6th) and starts (16, 6th)
- Combined to make 31 starts over 32 appearances between St. Louis and Memphis (AAA) in 2025. Hurlled a career-high 170.2 innings and won 16 games.
- Was recalled five times to St. Louis during the season including once as the 27th player in a doubleheader (6/19 at CWS).

#49 MATT SVANSON · RHP · 6-6 · 240 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals from the Blue Jays at the 2023 Trade Deadline for INF Paul DeJong and cash considerations.
- Made his MLB debut on April 17, 2025 at the New York Mets, working a scoreless 7th inning with one hit allowed. His college head coach made the drive from Lehigh to Citi Field for the game and returned for his weekend series that night.
- Has converted 39 consecutive save opportunities since May 23, 2023, with the first six as a member of the Blue Jays organization followed by 33 straight with the Cardinals.
- The 39 consecutive save streak currently ranks as the longest active in MiLB and 4th longest since MiLB records date back to 2005 (Brian Anderson, 41, Mike James, 40, Wander Suero, 40).
- Holds an active streak of at least one strikeout in each of his final 20 appearances with St. Louis, the longest such streak by a Cardinals reliever since Jordan Hicks had a 22-game streak in 2023 and longest a Cardinals rookie relief pitcher since at least 1954, as well as the second-longest active streak by an MLB reliever (1st, CHW's Mike Vasil, 29).

#44 GORDON GRACEFFO · RHP · 6-2 · 235 LBS · AGE 25

- Made his Major League debut June 29, 2024 vs. Cincinnati in which he pitched 4.1 innings, the longest relief outing by a Cardinals rookie since Angel Rondón (5.0 IP on May 22, 2022 at Pittsburgh) the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in his MLB debut since John Martin in 1980, who threw 7.0 innings on Aug. 27, 1980 vs. Philadelphia.
- Earned his first career MLB win (4/30 at CIN), 2nd MLB win (5/5 vs. PIT) and first MLB save (5/6 vs. PIT) in 2025, becoming the 14th Cardinals pitcher with two wins and a save within his first three appearances of a season, and the first to do so since John Gant in 2019.
- Became the 6th Villanova alum to appear for the Cardinals, joining LHP/OF Mike O'Neill (1901-04), OF Ernie Lush (1910), C Mike Murphy (1912), 1B/PH Mike Pasquella (1919), and INF Steve Huntz (1967, '69).
- Earned his first career MLB win (4/30 at CIN), 2nd MLB win (5/5 vs. PIT) and first MLB save (5/6 vs. PIT) in 2025, becoming the 14th Cardinals pitcher with two wins and a save within his first three appearances of a season, and the first to do so since John Gant in 2019.RHP Max Rajcic

#55 RYNE STANEK · RHP · 6-3 · 235 LBS · AGE 34

- Signed as a free agent in January, returning to the city he was born. The Cardinals become his 6th Major League organization.
- Originally a 1st round draft pick (29th overall) by the Tampa Bay Rays out of the University of Arkansas in 2013.
- Member of the 2022 World Champion Houston Astros.
- Ranks 25th among active pitchers with 466 career appearances since 2017. Since his career began in 2017, ranks 15th among all pitchers in appearances.
- Is one of four pitchers in Major League history with a perfect fielding percentage (1.000) to have made 400 career appearances and pitched 400.0 career innings; joining Hector Rondon, Hunter Strickland and Luis Vizcaino.
- Appeared in 30 career postseason games, going 4-0 with a 2.89 ERA. Ranks 9th among active pitchers with 30 career postseason appearances and T-26th in MLB history.
