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THE TWINS: Through five games on their current six-game homestand, the Twins have gone 3-2, going 1-2 vs. Chicago-AL and 2-0 vs. Detroit...Minnesota will complete the homestand tonight with the three-game series finale against the Tigers...tomorrow afternoon, Minnesota will travel to Chicago to begin their penultimate roadtrip of 2026...they will play the White Sox at Rate Field for three games over the weekend and the Tigers at Comerica for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ Twins have won three-straight for the first time since sweeping the Braves in three games from August 17-19...last time they won four-straight was July 4-8...four-straight is their season-high, done five times previously.

TIGER ERROR OPENS THE DOOR FOR OFFENSE: The Twins beat the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 15-2, one run short of their season-high in runs (16, 6/20 at ARI) and largest margin of victory in 2026...Andrew Morris was the Opener, allowing one run in the first inning...Connor Prielipp made his first career relief appearance and earned the win, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with three hits allowed...the offense scored 10 runs in the sixth inning, matching their high for 2026 (also 10 in 5th inning on 6/20 at ARI)...Royce Lewis reached four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk and a three-run homer...Kody Clemens added a home run, his 24th of the season, and Ryan Jeffers hit his 13th.

☞ Second time in club history (since 1961) the Twins have won by 10-or-more runs in back-to-back dates against Detroit (also: April 24-25, 1996).

RIGHT DOWN THE LINE: Derek Shelton is using the same lineup for the fourth-straight game tonight...according to *Elias*, the last time the Twins used the same lineup for four-straight was August 23-27, 2014: 1) Danny Santana, 2) Brian Dozier, 3) Joe Mauer, 4) Kennys Vargas, 5) Oswaldo Arcia, 6) Trevor Plouffe, 7) Kurt Suzuki, 8) Eduardo Escobar, 9) Jordan Schafer

☞ This also marks the second-straight day Jordan Schafer has been referenced in the notes.

TIGER THINGS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 13 games today...Twins are 7-2 vs. the Tigers this season, going 6-0 at Target Field and 1-2 at Comerica Park.

☞ The Twins have gone 46-24 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 48-21).

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 165, 38 ahead of Cleveland (127).

☞ Luke Keaschall is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with four doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, seven walks, a .458 on-base percentage and a 1.026 OPS in 14 career games vs. Detroit.

☞ In 29 career games vs. Detroit, Royce Lewis is hitting .309 (29-for-94) with five doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, 20 walks, a .426 on-base percentage, a .521 slugging percentage and a .947 OPS...he has reached base safely in all 29 career games.

☞ Notables this season vs. Detroit: Josh Bell is 12-for-35 (.343) with one double, two home runs, five RBI and four walks...Royce Lewis is 12-for-31 (.387) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and seven walks...Luke Keaschall is 10-for-28 (.357) with two doubles, one home run, six RBI and four walks...Ryan Jeffers is 6-for-14 (.429) with one double, three home runs, 10 RBI, three walks and a .529 on-base percentage.

SERIES BUSINESS: Twins have scored 26 runs this series, already their most in a series for 2026...previous season-high in a three-game series was April 13-15 vs. Boston, scoring 24.

☞ 26 runs are their most in a three-game series since scoring 29 from August 2-4, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field.

☞ Last time they scored 30-plus in a three-game series was April 26-24, 2024 at Los Angeles-AL, scoring 32.

JUST GONNA KEEP RUNNING THIS NOTE: Luke Keaschall has 14 multi-hit games in his last 28 games overall (50%)...in that span, he is hitting .349 (37-for-106) with a 1.011 OPS...below are Keaschall's offensive comparisons through June and since July 1:

LEADOFF LUKE: Since being inserted into the leadoff spot on August 17, Keaschall has led off in all 14 Twins games and has hit .356 (21-for-59) with a .966 OPS, reaching safely in 13 of the 14...since August 17, he leads all leadoff hitters in batting average and hits.

SWEEP MUSIC: Twins are seeking their fifth sweep of the season today...their other four were a four-game sweep of the Tigers at Target Field from April 6-9, a three-game sweep of the Red Sox at Fenway Park from May 22-24, a three-game sweep of the Rangers at Globe Life Field from June 15-18 and a three-game sweep of the Braves at Target Field from August 17-19...they recorded four sweeps in 2025 — all in three games.

☞ Twins have entered a finale with a chance to sweep eight times this season, going 4-4...their four misses were April 15 vs. Boston at Target Field, June 3 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field, July 1 at Houston and July 9 vs. Cleveland at Target Field.

CLEMENS TIME: Kody Clemens hit his 24th home run last night, giving him three homers in his last five games...over his last 15 games, he is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with one double, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .604 slugging percentage and a .977 OPS.

☞ Clemens is now one home run away from tying Byron Buxton (25) for the club lead in homers.

☞ Since June 16, Clemens has 45 RBI, third-most in the AL since that date, trailing Junior Camerino (56) and Jac Caglianone (46).

JOE REHAB: Joe Ryan made his first start on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul...he allowed one run on one hit in 3.0 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts, throwing 42 pitches to 10 batters faced...Ryan was placed on the 15-day Injured List on August 7 with a left glute strain.

H.B.D.A.J.: A.J. Minter is celebrating his 33rd birthday today...he has appeared in one major league game on his birthday, coming in 2023 at Los Angeles-NL, throwing 1.0 scoreless inning.

TWINS AT A STICK: The Twins are at the 2026 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...The Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (now through Monday, September 7).
