THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The I-70 Interleague series begins tonight as the St. Louis Cardinals and cross-state rival Kansas City Royals kick off a three-game weekend series at Busch Stadium as part of Major League Baseball's "Rivalry Weekend" ... The Redbirds six-game/seven-day homestand continues Tuesday with a three-game series with the division rival Pittsburgh Pirates ... The Cardinals recently went 4-3 over their seven-game/eight-day Golden State road trip through San Diego (2-2) and the Athletics in West Sacramento (2-1), enjoying their 4th straight roadie with a .500 or better record.

FLIGHT PATTERN: Winners of 11 of their last 16 since April 27, the Cardinals enter play today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.5 games behind first place Chicago and pct. points behind 2nd place Milwaukee (24-17).

• All five NL Central teams won yesterday for the 4th time this season (April 5, April 15, April 17, & May 14), following two days ago (May 13) when all five teams lost for the only time all season ... All five National League Central teams have winning records with Cincinnati anchoring the division at 23-21. - *Elias*

CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .590 regular season win pct. (79-55) against the Royals is the best of any of tonight's 15 Rivalry Weekend Matchups ... The two Missouri teams have split each of the last 18 meetings dating back to the start of the 2022 season.

CARDIAC CARDS: Yesterday was the 12th comeback win for the Cardinals, 3rd-most in MLB behind the Diamondbacks (14) and Dodgers (14) ... St. Louis paces MLB in extra inning wins (5-1) and is tied for 3rd in last at-bat wins (7) behind the Rays (8) and Padres (8) ... The Cardinals also lead MLB in two-run wins (17-7) and share the MLB lead in one-run victories (9-3) with the Phillies (9-4), Cubs (9-2), and Rays (9-1) ... In "high leverage" situations, per *FanGraphs*, the Cardinals lead MLB in runs scored (65) and rank 2nd in RBI (62) behind Atlanta (63).

SAVE CRAVE: With his 13th save yesterday, **Riley O'Brien** is tied for the 3rd-most saves by a Cardinal through 43 games behind **Lee Smith** (14 in 1992) and **Jason Isringhausen** (14 in 2006) ... O'Brien has combined for 64 pct. of the team's 25 victories with his 13 saves/3 wins, highest by any Cardinal through the first 43 games.

MANAGER MATH: With a victory tonight, **Oliver Marmol** will reach 351 managerial wins and tie Hall of Fame manager **Joe Torre** (1990-95) for 9th in Cardinals history ... **Eddie Dyer** (1946-50) ranks 8th with 446 wins ... The 39-year-old Marmol is the 3rd-longest tenured National League manager (**Dave Roberts** & **Torey Lovullo**) and Major League Baseball's 2nd-youngest skipper (Nationals 33-year-old **Blake Butera**).

NOOT NEWS: OF **Lars Nootbaar** is scheduled to begin his 20-day injury rehab assignment tonight at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium as Palm Beach (A) faces Daytona (A-Reds) ... Nootbaar, who underwent offseason surgery on both heels, is on the 60-day injured list and eligible to be activated as early as May 24.

KANSAS CITY CONNECTIONS

The Cardinals and Royals faced off in the 1985 World Series, also known as the "Show-Me Series" or "I-70 Showdown Series."

Ryne Stanek graduated from Blue Valley High School in nearby Stilwell, KS, winning the 2010 Kansas High School 6A State Championship... named the 2010 *Kansas City Star* All-Metro Baseball Player of the Year.

Jon Jay played 59 games for the Royals in 2018 before being traded to Arizona for RHP **Elvis Luciano** and LHP **Gabe Speier** (June 6, 2018).

Gordon Graceffo and **Thomas Saggese** were teammates with **Jac Caglianone** and **Vinnie Pasquantino** on Team Italy during the 2026 WBC.

Jac Caglianone made his MLB debut on June 3, 2025 against the Cardinals at Busch Stadium.

Michael Wacha, the Cardinals 1st round draft selection in 2012, pitched seven seasons (2013-19) in St. Louis and was voted MVP of the 2013 NLCS against the LA Dodgers...became the 105th player to appear in at least one game for both the Royals and Cardinals...made his MLB debut on May 30, 2013 vs. the Royals while pitching for St. Louis.

Bobby Witt Jr.'s father, **Bobby Witt**, pitched in 17 games (5 starts) for the Cardinals in the second half of the 1998 season.

Cardinals 2026 Hall of Fame inductee **Albert Pujols** moved to Independence, Mo., in 1996 when he was 16 years old...graduated from Fort Osage High School in Independence...played college baseball at Maple Woods Community College in Kansas City (now named Metropolitan Community College).

Lane Thomas played in 84 games for the Cardinals from 2019-21 after St. Louis acquired him from Toronto on July 2, 2017 in exchange for international bonus slot money.

Nick Mears's great-grandfather **Alyn Butler** was a catcher in the Cardinals farm system.

Michael Massey played college baseball at the University of Illinois (2017-19).

Cardinals broadcaster **Brad Thompson** (16 games) appeared on the 2010 Royals squad.

Royals VP of Scouting **Danny Ontiveros** was a Cardinals scout from 1998-2004.

Royals broadcaster **Rex Hudler** played in 251 games over three seasons in St. Louis (1990-92).

Royals VP of Tech & Bus. Analytics **Brian Himstedt** graduated from Missouri S&T and spent four years working at Brighton, a St. Louis ad agency.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 179 games across parts of two seasons with Kansas City (1994-95).

Royals Major League Scout **Willie Fraser** pitched in 35 games for the Cardinals in 1991.

Royals Sr. Advisor to the GM **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft.

Royals Special Assistant, International Scouting **Johnny DiPuglia** worked in scouting for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

Royals Special Assistant to Baseball Operations/Player & Staff Engagement **Blaine Boyer** pitched in 15 games for the Cardinals in 2009.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for **Mark Littell** and **Buck Martinez** (Dec. 8, 1977).

Royals Assistant Director of Player Development **Kevin Howard** played in 97 games for St. Louis Triple-A affiliate Memphis in 2010.

Royals Major League Scout **Tim Conroy** worked as an Area Scout and East Coast Regional Supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

Royals Radio Producer/Engineer **Eric Guthrie** is a St. Louis native.

St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Lynn Worthy** covered the Royals for four seasons for the *Kansas City Star* (2019-22).

Royals.TV reporter **Joel Goldberg** covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals.TV reporter **Bridget Howard**'s father, **David Howard**, played in 98 games for St. Louis (1998-99).

Royals MLB.com reporter **Anne Rogers** covered the Cardinals for two seasons (2019-20).

Royals broadcaster **Steve Stewart** is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

Royals Executive Assistant to the President and GM **Emily Penning** attended SIU Edwardsville.

Royals Manager of Business & Community Communications **Kindle Biermann** attended SIU Carbondale.

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- The 28-year-old **Dustin May** makes his 9th start as a member of the Cardinals this evening; It's his 66th career start (80th appearance).
- Is making his 3rd career start & appearance vs. the KC Royals, making one start as a Dodger and one as a member of the Red Sox in 2025.
- His 2026 season has been one of streaks starting with 2-straight loses, then 3-straight wins and currently 2-straight defeats.
- Has four caught stealing on attempted base stealers, tied with Toronto's **Patrick Corbin** for the most in MLB among pitchers.
- Signed as a free-agent deal for 2026 with mutual option for 2027, in December. St. Louis becomes his 3rd team, having previously pitched for the Dodgers (2019-25) & Red Sox (2025).
- Lifetime 3-5 with a 3.56 ERA (55.2 IP) in 11 career May starts; his best ERA of any month.
- Is the 27th Cardinal to wear uniform No. 3, but the first Cardinals pitcher to have worn the number: notable former Cardinals to wear #3 are **Édgar Rentería**, **Brian Jordan**, **Carlos Beltrán** and most recently **Dylan Carlson**.
- Joins **Nathan Church** (2024-26), **Hunter Dobbins** (2026), **Mark McGwire** (1997-2001), **Red Schoendienst** (1945-56, '61-63), and **Rex Hudler** (1990-92) as notable red-headed Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, May 9 at San Diego): L, 4-2; 6.0 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO, 1 HR - 97 pitches.

- Recorded his 5th Quality Start of the season while striking out a season-high 7 and allowing just 3 hits over 6.0 IP, but suffered 4-2 loss.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

STEADY STARTER: Has quality starts in 5 of his 8 starts and has allowed 3 runs or less and worked into the 6th inning in each of his last 6 starts for a 2.55 ERA (35.1 IP/10 ER) in that span. He has received just one total run in support over his last three starts.

KICKING THE BABIP HABIT: 17 of his 50 hits allowed this season (34 pct.) came in his first two starts; he still owns the 3rd-highest BABIP (.357) in MLB.

DON'T WALK TO STRANGERS: Has the 2nd-lowest walk/batters faced percentage among Cardinals starting pitchers behind Michael McGreevy (6.0%) with 6.1%, and ranks 9th in NL; Has walked two or fewer batters in all eight starts.

MAY DAY: Started on May 3 while wearing uniform no. 3, against his former team, the Dodgers, suffering 4-1 loss that snapped his 3-game winning streak.

BACK-TO-BACK JACK: Gained a 5-3 win vs. CLE (4/15) as he paired back/back quality starts & wins over BOS & CLE during that homestand.

MILESTONE WIN: Bested his former team the Red Sox on 4/10 in a 3-2 win. It was his 1st win as a member of the Cardinals and his 20th career win.

TIGER STRIKE: Was hit for a season-high seven runs on seven hits (and struck in leg by line drive) over 3.1 innings in an 11-6 loss at Detroit (4/4) in his second start. First Cardinals pitcher since **Mike Parisi** (2008) to begin a season allowing 6 or more runs in his first two starts of a season; and the first Cardinal to pitch the Opening Day series since **Dizzy Dean** (1936).

OPENING ACT: Took the loss in his Cardinals debut at Busch Stadium vs. TB (3/29) allowing six runs over 4.0 inning. Tied his career-high allowing 10 hits, the first Cardinals pitcher to allow double-digit hits in his debut in 55 years since **Chris Zachary** surrendered 10 to the Phillies (5/3/1971) *Elias*. Recorded his 300th career strikeout retiring **Junior Caminero**.

MAY VS. KANSAS CITY:

- Is making his 3rd career start against the Royals and his 1st as a member of the Cardinals.
- His two previous starts vs. the Royals came in 2025, one as a member of the Dodgers and one while pitching for the Red Sox.
- Is 0-1 with a 8.22 ERA in his two previous starts vs. KC, taking a 7-3 loss on 8/6/25 at Fenway Park.
- Owns a 4-2 career mark with a 5.02 ERA in his 7 career starts against American League Central opponents.
