THE WORD ON THE BIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals play the middle game of a three-game series against the Cincinnati Reds this afternoon. St. Louis rallied from a 3-0 1st inning deficit with 10 unanswered runs for their 17th come-from-behind win last night and are now 4-3 on this current nine-game homestand, the longest before the All-Star Break.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis pulled back into second place in the National League Central with last night's win, currently 5.0 games behind division leading Milwaukee. All five teams in the N.L. Central are .500 or better.

WHAT'S THAT LIGHT?: This afternoon's game ends a streak of seven straight night games to begin this homestand. The Cardinals last played a day game on May 27 at Milwaukee. The Cardinals are 10-15 (.400) in day games, ranking 27th in the league in winning percentage, losing 6 of their last 7 home day tilts.

THE OCTOPUS: Eight different Cardinals recorded an RBI last night, marking the first time since May 22, 2022 at Pittsburgh. That afternoon, all 10 Cardinals who played knocked in a run en route to an 18-4 rout of the Pirates. The last time the home fans witnessed eight with an RBI was Sept. 12, 2017 vs. Cincinnati.

NO FLY ZONE: Through four games in June, Cardinals pitchers are the only team in MLB that haven't allowed a home run (36.0 IP). The last player to homer off the Cardinals was Alex Bregman (CHI), in the 6th inning on May 31. Cardinals starting pitchers haven't allowed a home run since the 1st inning on May 29 (Ian Happ).

STRIKEOUT ARTIST: Today's starting pitcher **Matthew Liberatore** enters June coming off a May in which he struck out a career-best 38 batters, 4th-most by a Cardinals lefty in May and most since Hall of Famer **Steve Carlton** set the franchise record with 52 punchouts in May 1970.

NOOT SCOOTIN' BOOGIE: Outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** returned to action last night and went 2-for-5 with a double, an RBI and beat out an infield single while playing nine innings in left field. Nootbaar also recorded his 250th career run.

WHEN LEFT ON LEFT IS RIGHT: Entering play today, Cardinals OF **Victor Scott II** ranks 7th among National League left-handed batters in batting average (.286, 14-49) against left-handed pitchers. Arizona All-Star **Corbin Carroll** leads the N.L. list with a .410 BA (32-78). Scott has one home run against a LHP this season, a 415-foot shot into the Allegheny River off **Braxton Ashcraft** at PNC Park on April 28.

HEIR JORDAN: **Jordan Walker** smacked his 12th and 13th doubles of the season last night as part of a three-hit game, matching his doubles total from 2025 in 51 less games. Walker's career-high is 19 doubles from 2023. He's posted back-to-back three hit games and his 7 games of 3+ hits rank 2nd only to **Otto Lopez** (MIA, 8) in MLB. Walker needs one home run to tie his career-best of 16 from his rookie season in 2023. With four more hits, he'll reach 300.

ROOKIE RACE: This weekend features a matchup between two of the top candidates for National League Rookie of the Year in Cardinals INF **JJ Wetherholt** and Reds INF **Sal Stewart**. The two rank in the Top 2 among National League rookies in runs (JJ 40 - Sal 35), home runs (JJ 9 - Sal 12) and walks (JJ 29 - Sal 34).

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Former Reds Executive, the late **Walt Jocketty**, served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06) & one World Series Championship ('06).

Terry Francona played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five as pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ.(1995-97).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11)

Reds Asst. Pitching Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

Justin Bruihl pitched for the Reds Triple-A Louisville affiliate in 2024.

Riley O'Brien made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Bryan Torres made his MLB debut at Cincinnati on May 23, 2026 (G1) ...singled off Chris Paddack for his first MLB hit and homered off Jose Franco.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals.TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St. Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds Special Asst. to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons (1986-90) with the Cardinals.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME:

- The 26-year-old Cardinals Opening Day starter makes his team-leading 13th start of the season this afternoon. Today's game marks his 133rd career Major League appearance and his 66th career start.
- Is facing the Reds for the 1st time on 2026 after making a three starts vs. CIN last season, including one at Busch Stadium (9/15/25).
- Is looking to follow up his win on 5/31 vs. CHC that marked his 1st Home win since a 7-2 victory over the Dodgers on 5/1.
- Brings a 9.1 scoreless IP streak into today's game and is looking to win back-to-back starts for the 2nd time this season.
- Tied for the Major League lead with three pick-offs; most pick-offs by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4, 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5, 2005).
- Sports a 3-3 record, but the Cardinals are 8-4 in his 12 starts this season, including a 5-2 mark in games he's started at Busch Stadium
- The Cardinals are 17-15 in his 32 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 12-10 with a 3.91 ERA (161.0 IP/70 ER) with 10 quality starts.

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, May 31 vs Chicago Cubs): W,5-1; 5.1 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO; 85 pitches

- Pitching on NBC Sunday Night Baseball won for the 1st time since 5/7 at San Diego.
- It was his 1st scoreless start of the season and extended his scoreless IP streak to 9.1 IP

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Had his deepest start (5.1 IP) since a 6.0 inning effort on 5/7 at SD and led the Cardinals to a series win over the Cubs on NBC Sunday Night Baseball in his 5-1 win vs Chicago on 5/31.

K-CLUB: Libby notched single-game career highs for strikeouts in consecutive starts when he fanned 9 on 5/19 vs. PIT and then he bettered that with 10 K's on Memorial Day (5/25) at MIL; He and Brewers starter Jacob Misiorowski (12) combined for 22 strikeouts in the 5/25 game.

LIBBY & LEFTY: Recorded 38 strikeouts in May, the most by a Cardinals lefty in the month of May since Hall of Famer **Steve "Lefty" Carlton** fanned 52 in May, 1970.

SLAMMED: Took the loss in Sacramento (5/13) allowing his first career grand slam (**Nic Kurtz**) in a 4-3 loss, coming during an inning where he threw a career-high 43 pitches.

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning **Nick Castellanos** in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hence**.
- Is a career 16-24 with a 4.77 ERA (315.0 IP) in his 65 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. CINCINNATI:

- Making his 4th career start vs. the Reds, following 7 straight relief appearances. Two of starts have come at Great American Ball Park and has one start at Busch Stadium (9/15/25).
- Is 1-1 with a 3.32 ERA in his 11 career games (3 starts) vs. Cincinnati.
- Earned a win in his first career appearance at CIN (9/8/23) tossing 1.1 scoreless innings in relief with three strikeouts.
- Did not allow a run in his first five career appearances (4.2 IP) vs. the Reds.
- Suffered his only loss to the Reds in his first career start at CIN (5/1/25), which was delayed, causing him to exit after 3.0 innings allowing two runs in a loss.
- Pitched 6.0 innings in his last start vs. the Reds on 9/15/25; Exited with a 4-3 lead, but St. Louis allowed 8 runs over the final three innings in an 11-6 loss.
