THE TWINS: After completing their season-long 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a record of 5-5 (1-2 at Tampa Bay, 1-2 at Seattle and 3-1 against the A's), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive losses to the Blue Jays...today, the Twins will continue the homestand with the three-game series finale against Toronto...they will have the day off tomorrow before hosting the Rangers for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.
✦ Twins are 27-15 in their last 42 games since April 22, tied with St. Louis (27-14) for second most wins in baseball since that date, and trailing only Detroit (28-15)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.
✦ Twins have dropped three-straight for the first time since April 29-May 2, when they lost four-straight, three to Cleveland and one to Boston.
✦ Twins are 18-10 through 28 home games this season, winning 12 of their last 16 and 16 of their last 21 at Target Field.

SPRINGER OF RAIN: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-4...Chris Paddack was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and two strikeouts...Griffin Jax was dealt his fourth loss in relief, allowing a two-run homer to George Springer in the top of the eighth inning...the offense recorded seven hits...Matt Wallner hit his fourth home run of the season and second since coming off the IL on May 31...Kody Clemens added a home run in the ninth inning, his sixth of the season, setting a single-season career-high.
✦ The loss snapped a streak of three-straight series wins over the Blue Jays and marked their first series loss to Toronto since May 26-28, 2023.

EVERYBODY BE COUL: The Twins have returned left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 15-day Injured List...Coulombe made one appearance on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning on Friday night against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...prior to being placed on the IL on May 18, Coulombe made 19 appearances for the Twins, pitching 16.2 scoreless innings with eight hits allowed, two walks, 19 strikeouts and a .138 opponent batting average.
✦ To make room for Coulombe on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews on the 15-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain...Matthews, who was recalled by the Twins on May 18, made four starts for the Twins, going 1-1, 5.21 ERA (19.0 IP, 11 ER), eight walks and 25 strikeouts.

LAKES AND LEAFS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the third of six games this season...their next series will be three games at Rogers Centre from August 25-27.
✦ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 8-5 in their last 13 games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023.
✦ In 33 career regular and Postseason games against the Blue Jays, Carlos Correa is hitting .320 (41-for-128) with eight doubles, seven home runs, 25 RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, a .557 slugging percentage and a .967 OPS...he has reached safely in 18-straight.
✦ In eight career regular season games against the Jays, Matt Wallner is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two home runs, four RBI and a .953 OPS.
✦ In nine career regular season and Postseason games against the Jays, Royce Lewis is hitting .484 (15-for-31) with two doubles, three home runs, 10 RBI, a .556 on-base percentage, an .839 slugging percentage and a 1.394 OPS...he has reached safely in all nine.
✦ Byron Buxton has posted an .899 OPS with nine doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBI and a .558 slugging percentage in 30 career regular season games against the Blue Jays.

IEFFEL POWER: Ty France has reached base safely in a career-high 19-straight games...it marks the longest for a Twin this season and longest since Carlos Correa's 19-game streak from June 26-September 22, 2024...the last Twin with a streak of 20-plus was Edouard Julien, who reached in 23-straight from September 6, 2023-March 30, 2024...the last in a *single* season was Byron Buxton with 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.
✦ During the streak, France is hitting .306 (22-for-72) with two doubles, one home run, 13 RBI, seven HBP and a .367 on-base percentage.

FOREST RAKE: Matt Wallner has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, dating back to April 13...in his last 16 games, dating back to April 6, Wallner is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, six RBI, three HBP, seven walks, a .419 on-base percentage, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.035 OPS.

UNBE-LEE-VABLE: Brooks Lee has hit safely in nine-straight games, extending his career-high...his previous high for a hitting streak was six, done twice, once in 2024 and once earlier this season...the current streak matches Harrison Bader (April 26-May 7) for the longest by a Twin this season...Minnesota's last double-digit hitting streak was from Kyle Farmer, who hit in 13-straight, from September 3-22, 2024.
✦ During the current streak, Lee is hitting .289 (11-for-38) with one double and five RBI.

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the third time this season...the other two were in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30, and April 18-20 at Atlanta...the last time the Twins were swept at home was in three games to end the 2024 regular season, from September 27-29 vs. Baltimore.
✦ The last time the Twins were swept by the Blue Jays was in three games at Rogers Centre from August 26-27, 2016...last time they were swept by the Jays at home was in three games from September 6-8, 2013.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita first baseman Aaron Sabato and High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Brandon Winokur minor league co-Players of the Week, and Low-A Fort Myers left-handed pitcher Dasan Hill has been named minor league Pitcher of the Week.
✦ Sabato, 26, played in four games for the Wind Surge, hitting .357 (5-for-14) with one double, two home runs, six RBI, five walks, a .526 on-base percentage and a 1.383 OPS...the Rye, NY native was selected by the Twins in the first round (27th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of North Carolina.
✦ Winokur, 20, played in five games for the Kernels, hitting .350 (7-for-20) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBI and a 1.109 OPS...the Newport Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the third round (82nd overall) in the 2023 MLB Draft out of Edison High School.
✦ Hill, 19, made one start for the Mighty Mussels at Tampa, pitching 3.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, two walks and five strikeouts...the Grapevine, TX native was selected by the Twins in the second round (69th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Grapevine High School...he is ranked by MLB.com as the club's 13th-best prospect and seventh-best pitcher.
