DANIEL LYNCH IV is making his 4th start (50th appearance) of the season and the 60th (174th appearance) of his career this afternoon in the series finale of this 3-game set here at Kauffman Stadium vs. the Tigers...he is facing the club for the 18th time in his career but for the ninth time as a starter and first since July 18, 2023.

- + On Aug. 7 vs. the Cubs, Lynch IV joined the Royals rotation, filling the void of **Luinder Avila**, who was placed on the Injured List with right forearm tightness on Aug. 2 before undergoing **Tommy John** surgery...the outing marked his 1st MLB start since May 27, 2025 vs. the Reds, when he spun 2.2 innings as an opener.
- + Daniel's transition to the rotation comes after each of his 1st 46 appearances to begin the year came in relief, a role that he assumed during the 2024 season...in that stretch, he posted a 1.96 ERA (10 ER in 46.0 IP), which was the 4th lowest by a Royals left hander through their 1st 46 appearances of a campaign, behind **José Mijares** (1.72) in 2012, **Tom Burgmeier** (1.75) in 1971 and **Ron Mahay** (1.78) in 2008.
- + Per *Elías*, Lynch IV is one of three active players to have at least 50 starts and 100 relief appearances with one team, joining **Andre Pallante** with the Cardinals (193 G, 85 GS) and **Reynaldo Lopez** with the White Sox (205 G, 91 GS).

LAST TIME OUT: Lynch IV did not factor into the decision of the Royals 4-3, walk-off victory last Tuesday night vs. the Athletics after spinning 4.0 innings of 1-run ball on 2 hits and 2 walks with 1 strikeout...he allowed 4 straight 1-out baserunners to reach in the 1st, capped off by a **Tommy White** RBI single, but the damage was limited after **Nick Loftin** threw out **Jeff McNeil** on a play at the plate...he retired each of his final 10 batters to finish his outing, striking out **Lawrence Butler** to complete a season-high 4.0 innings before exiting trailing 1-0 in favor of **Mason Black** to begin the 5th.

- + Daniel threw a season-high 45 pitches, his most since June 12, 2024 vs. the Yankees, when he threw 95 pitches to complete 6.2 innings out of the bullpen.
- + He completed 4.0 innings for the first time since that same June 12, 2024 game, but it marked his first time doing so as a starter since June 7, 2024 vs. Seattle (4.0 IP).

THE RUNDOWN: After being selected 34th overall in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Virginia, Lynch IV made his Major League debut in 2021 and each of his 1st 52 MLB appearances were starts...after struggling to find consistency over his first four seasons, he transitioned to a relief role in August 2024, where in 114 appearances (2 starts as an opener), he went 12-4 with 3 saves and a 2.21 ERA (33 ER in 134.1 IP), becoming one of the game's best left-handed relievers.

- + Following the Royals loss on Aug. 6 vs. Minnesota, Manager **Matt Quatraro** told reporters that Lynch IV would make the start the following night vs. the Cubs and would get opportunities to do so moving forward, as the Royals look for ways to fill a rotation that has been decimated by injuries this season.
- + As Daniel has been getting built up as a starter over his last 3 games, he has been working in tandem with **Mason Black**, who has pitched in relief of him in each outing and covered a total of 11.0 innings...Black was recalled on Aug. 7 from Triple-A Omaha, and in 3 Major League outings since, he owns a 4.09 ERA (5 ER in 11.0 IP).

IN SINK: One of the biggest differences for Daniel since joining the Royals bullpen in August 2024 is the evolution of his sinker, a pitch that he was using just 5.6% of the time but over 117 appearances (5 starts) since, is throwing to 22.2% of hitters.

- + Daniel's sinker usage has jumped each season since and this year, he's throwing it 30.4% of the time, which is up from his 18.9% rate a year ago...opponents are slashing .180/.254/.262 (11-for-61) vs. the pitch this season, the 8th-lowest OBP and 12th-lowest average on the pitch among American League pitchers (min. 50.0 IP).

VS. TIGERS: Lynch IV is making his 9th career start (18th appearance) vs. the Tigers, and his 1st since July 18, 2023 here at Kauffman Stadium, where he earned the win in the Royals 11-10 victory after yielding 5 runs on 6 hits (2 HR) and 2 walks over 5.0 innings...all 5 runs came via 2 home runs by **Spencer Torkelson**: a 2-run shot in the 1st to open the scoring before connecting on a 3-run HR in the 5th...over his previous 8 starts vs. the club, he owns a 4.79 ERA (22 ER in 41.1 IP), which is more than 2 runs higher than his 2.61 ERA (3 ER in 10.1 IP) in 9 relief outings.

- + This season, Daniel has been dominant against the AL Central, posting a 1.69 ERA (3 ER in 16.0 IP) over 18 appearances, which is the 3rd-lowest ERA vs. the division in the Majors (min. 15 G), behind **Brent Headrick** (0.56) and **Sean Newcomb** (1.32).

1ST-INNING STRUGGLES: Of the 216 runs that Daniel has allowed in his Major League career, 57 of them (26.4%) have come in the 1st inning, in which he owns an 8.04 ERA...from the 2nd inning on, his career ERA is 3.72 (148 ER in 357.2 IP).

- + He's yielded just 1 1st-inning run so far since joining the Royals rotation, and it came in his outing last Tuesday vs. the A's, when **Tommy White** recorded an RBI single.

HOME SWEET HOME: Across 88 career appearances (30 starts) here at Kauffman Stadium, Lynch IV is 12-11 with a 5.10 ERA (117 ER in 206.1 IP), which is in stark contrast to his 3.59 ERA (84 ER in 210.2 IP) in 85 road outings (29 starts)...this year, however, his home and road splits have seemingly flipped, as he has gone 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA (7 ER in 30.1 IP) across 26 home outings (2 starts), compared to a 3-3 record with a 3.80 ERA (10 ER in 23.2 IP) in 23 games (1 start) away from The K.

- + Three of Daniel's 7 earned runs he has allowed at Kauffman Stadium this season came in his Aug. 7 start vs. the Cubs, when **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (2-run) and **Seiya Suzuki** delivered back-to-back RBI singles in the 2nd inning.
- + His 20 scoreless appearances at home this season are tied with **Steven Cruz** for the 2nd most by a Royals pitcher, trailing only **John Schreiber** (22).

TUESDAY NIGHT’S STARTER: RHP SETH LUGO (5-7, 4.71)

- + **Seth Lugo** will make his 27th start of the season and the 150th of his career (387th appearance) in Tuesday's series opener in Toronto.
- + In his most recent start last Wednesday vs. the Athletics, Lugo did not factor into the decision as the Royals won 9-7 after he allowed 5 runs on 9 hits in 6.0 innings with 3 strikeouts...the 1st 3 hitters Lugo faced each notched a hit, with **Jeff McNeil** and **Zack Gelof** coming around to score...he retired 12 of the next 13 batters he faced before running into trouble in the 5th when a string of 5 hits in 6 batters lead to 3 more being pushed across...aftering making it through the inning he pitched a clean 6th before exiting in favor of **Alex Lange**.
- + Across 12 road games this season, Lugo has factored into just 4 decisions, earing 1 win and being charged with 3 losses, though he has pitched in 64.0 innings...only Atlanta's **Grant Holmes** (3) has fewer decisions on the road this year (min. 10 GS).

MANAGER MATT QUATRARO (kwuh-TRAIR-roe)

- + **Matt Quatraro** is in his fourth season as Royals Manager...in January, he agreed to an extension that runs through 2029 and includes a club option for 2030...the option would represent his eighth season, which would mark the 2nd-longest tenure in franchise history, trailing only **Ned Yost's** 10 seasons as Manager.

+ His 281 wins are 7th most in franchise history, 5 shy of **Hal McRae** (286) for 6th...he's only 19 wins shy of becoming the fifth Manager in Royals history to reach 300 wins (Yost 746, **Whitey Herzog** 410, **Dick Howser** 404, **Tony Muser** 317).

+ Quatraro led the Royals to back-to-back winning seasons in 2024-25 for the first time since 2013-15...the Royals under Q are the eighth team in the Wild Card Era, according to *Elías*, to have back-to-back winning seasons after a 100-loss campaign.
- + Quatraro led the 2024 Royals to an 86-76 record in his second season as Manager.

+ Q finished runner-up in the 2024 American League Manager of the Year voting.

+ The 2024 Royals were the sixth team in the 162-game Era (since 1961), according to Elias, to have a 30-win improvement from one season to the next (excluding shortened seasons)...they were the third team to make the postseason following a 100-loss season, following the 2017 Minnesota Twins and 2020 Miami Marlins.

+ Before joining the Royals, he spent five years on **Kevin Cash's** staff in Tampa Bay and four seasons on **Terry Francona's** staff in Cleveland...during his 12 full seasons on a big league staff, his teams have reached the postseason seven times.

REPLAY SPECIALIST BILL DUPLISSEA

- + **Bill Duplissea** is in his 21st season with the Royals and has served as the Replay Coordinator since Instant Replay was instituted in 2014...during that time, the Royals 65.4% success rate is 1st in the Majors, ahead of the 2nd-place Yankees (64.0%).

+ Duplissea has overturned 22 of 30 challenges this season (73.3%), which is the best rate in the Majors according to the latest update sent from MLB on Friday.

+ In 12 full seasons of Instant Replay, the Royals have finished in the top 5 in success rate eight times and have finished in the top 10 in all 12 seasons.
- + Duper started with the Royals as a Bullpen Catcher in 2006, then added advance scouting duties in 2012...in his current role, he works closely with the coaching staff in scouting upcoming opponents, in addition to his in-game replay role.

+ Prior to joining the Royals, he spent 2004-05 as an Assistant Coach at the College of San Mateo, helping lead the Bulldogs to conference titles in both seasons.

+ Duplissea was a catcher for five seasons in the Los Angeles Dodgers organization, reaching Triple-A Albuquerque in 2000.
