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WINNING WAYS

The Washington Nationals will face off against the Philadelphia Phillies in game four in Philadelphia tonight.

- The Nationals beat the Phillies last night, 10-4...**Brady House** hit his first career pinch-hit home run...**CJ Abrams** finished 3-for-5 with a triple, three RBI and two runs scored...**Miles Mikolas** made his third career pinch-hit appearance in the 11th inning.
- The Nationals are in the midst of a stretch of 17 games in 17 days that began on July 24 until their next day off on Aug. 10...Washington is also on a run of 39 games in 41 days from July 24 through Sept. 2.

Miles Mikolas is celebrating 10 years of Major League service today...Some of Mikolas' career highlights:

- Made Major League debut on May 5, 2012 with San Diego.
- Two time All-Star selections (2018 and 2022).
- Finished sixth in Cy Young award voting in 2018.
- Led Major League Baseball with 35 starts in 2023, becoming the first pitcher to record 35 starts in a season since **Jhoulys Chacin** (35) in 2018 with Milwaukee.

Following a month in which he led the National League in home runs, OPS, and slugging percentage, **CJ Abrams** was named National League Player of the Month for July on Monday..This is Abrams' first career Player of the Month award and the first National to win Player of the Month since **Daylen Life** in September of 2025.

- Abrams hit .348 (31-for-89) with five doubles, 10 home runs, 23 RBI, 11 walks, six stolen bases, 17 runs scored, a .742 slugging percentage and a 1.149 OPS across 23 games in July...He hit safely in 19 of the 23 games and reached base safely in 21 of the 23.
- He ranked among National League hitters in extra-base hits (3rd, 15), RBI (3rd, 23), batting average (3rd, .348), hits (T6th, 31) and on-base percentage (6th, .408) in July.
- Abrams is at the top of the Major League and National League leaderboards in several offensive categories... See chart to the right for the list.

Washington leads Major League Baseball with 167 home runs, just three ahead of the New York Yankees (164).

- The Nationals have clubbed 130 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 19 more than the Astros (111)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in MLB.
- Washington has homered at least once in 28 of its last 33 (58 total HR), 35 of its last 41 (70 total HR) and 45 of its last 53 games (88 total HR).

The Nationals are 13-4-1 in road series this season and 33-26 (.559) on the road overall this season...The .559 winning percentage ranks sixth in Major League Baseball while 32 wins are tied for fourth.

- Washington has won four of its last five and nine of its last 11 road series...This current series defeat at the hands of the Braves was the Nationals first road series loss since June 21 against Tampa Bay..Washington's four road series losses are all separated by more than a month (4/1 at PHI, 5/10 at MIA, 6/21 at TB, July 31 at ATL).

The Nationals acquired 10 players at the 2026 Trade Deadline: left-handed pitcher **Connelly Early** from Boston for **Curtis Mead**...Right-handed pitcher **Jake Bird**, right-handed pitcher **Ben Grable**, right-handed pitcher **Yovanny Cruz** and right-handed pitcher **Jack Ceibert** from New York-AL for **Luis García Jr.**...Right-handed pitcher **Joey Glassey** from Baltimore for **Christian Franklin**...Left-handed pitcher **Will Dion**, outfielder **Nick Mitchell**, left-handed pitcher **Josh Hartle** and right-handed pitcher **Kendeglys Virguez** from Cleveland for **Foster Griffin**.

- **Jack Ceibert** (No. 14), **Ben Grable** (No. 26), **Josh Hartle** (No. 29) and **Yovanny Cruz** (No. 30) were added to MLB Pipeline.com's Top 30 Nationals Prospects.

The Washington Nationals lead Major League Baseball with 127 stolen bases and with 9.4 baserunning runs above average, according to FanGraphs.

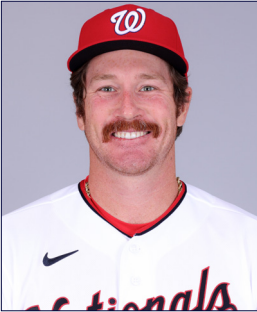
- **Nasim Nuñez** leads the league with 40 stolen bases, 10 ahead of **Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (30) and **Bobby Witt Jr.** (30).
- He is seven stolen bases shy of tying **CJ Abrams'** Nationals record (2005-pres.) of 47 stolen bases in 2023... He is one of four players in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to steal at least 40 bases joining Alfonso Soriano (2006, 41), Trea Turner (2017, 43 and 2017, 46) and CJ Abrams (2023, 47).

Andrew Pinckney made his Major League debut last night pinch running in the 10th inning...The Nationals selected his contract on Aug. 5, after hitting .271 with 11 doubles, a triple, 13 home runs, 51 RBI, 37 walks, 18 stolen bases and 63 runs scored in 94 games for Triple-A Rochester this season.

- Pinckney is tied with **Oneil Cruz** for the hardest hit ball in Major or Minor League Baseball this season at 119.0 mph.

Two-time National League All-Star (2018, 2022) signed with the Nationals on Feb. 11...A veteran of 10 Major League seasons, most recently with the St. Louis Cardinals (2018-25).

- Is tied for eighth in Major League Baseball with 140 starts and fifth with 839.2 innings pitched since the start of the 2022 season.
- Is 1-2 with a 2.20 ERA (4 ER/16.1 IP) in four career Postseason games (three starts).
- Spent three seasons in Nippon Professional Baseball, pitching for the Yomiuri Giants from 2015-17.
- Participated in the 2018 All-Star Game at Nationals Park.

LAST START

Mikolas tossed 6.0 innings and allowed four earned runs on nine hits and one walk with three strikeouts...He took the loss in the 8-3 defeat to the Atlanta Braves on August 1.

vs. PHILADELPHIA

Mikolas is set to make his tenth career start and 12th career appearance against the Phillies...He is 2-5 with a 4.14 ERA (27 ER/58.2 IP) and 34 total strikeouts.

DON'T WALK SIGN

Mikolas leads Major League Baseball with just 1.09 walks per 9.0 innings since May 22...He's walked just eight batters in 66.1 innings over this stretch...His 3.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio (27 SO/8 BB) over this stretch is ranked eighth in the National League.

2025

Went 8-11 with a 4.81 ERA in 31 starts...Marked his fourth consecutive season with 31 or more starts.

- Went 4-0 with a 1.34 ERA and a .192 opponents' average in six starts from April 23 to May 23.
- Posted a 2.77 ERA in five starts from Aug. 28-Sept. 20 with a record of 1-1...Allowed two or less earned runs in all the five games and struck out 15 batters across 26.0 innings.
