EVERY SECOND COUNTS: The Giants kick off their final leg of their three-city, 10-game road trip today as they play the series opener vs. the Cubs this afternoon.

- ▶ SF enters today winners of three of its last five games after dropping each of their previous five games and nine of their previous 11.
- ▶ Giants batters are slashing .335/.374/.556 with 24 doubles, nine homers, 46 runs scored and a .931 OPS through the first seven games of this road trip...the last time SF has hit .335 or better on a road trip of six or more games was in 2000, when they hit .339 in 10 games from June 20-29.
- ▶ SF recorded 25 hits in Colorado on Sunday and 20 hits yesterday in Milwaukee...according to *Stats, LLC*, it's the first time the Giants have had a 20-hit game in two different cities on the same road trip since June 1929 (at PIT/at PHI), and the first time any MLB team has done so since the Mets in August 2015 (at COL/at PHI).
- ▶ The Giants batted around twice yesterday (1st and 7th innings)...it marked the first time SF batted around twice in a game on the road since on Sept 11, 2021 at CHC (*Elias*).
- ▶ SF is 3-4 so far on the road trip to Colorado (1-2) and Milwaukee (2-2).

THE BEAR: The Giants and Cubs meet up today for the first time this season...SF went 5-1 vs. Chicago last year and outscored them 40-23 (17) in the six games.

- ▶ SF enters today having won five straight games against the Cubs, their longest active winning streak against any opponent and the longest active winning streak by any team against the Cubs...according to *Stats, LLC*, the last time the Giants won six straight against the Cubs was in 1999 (seven).

I WEAR SUITS NOW: The Giants enter play today with the fourth-best batting average in the Majors...at .256, they trail only the Dodgers (.264), Braves (.257) and Pirates (.256).

- ▶ SF has two of the top four hitters in baseball this season in terms of average, with **IF Luis Arraez** ranking third in MLB with a .325 average and **OF Jung Hoo Lee** following him in fourth place with a .322 clip.
- ▶ The last time the Giants had an average this high as a club in their first 63 games of the season was in 2018, when they had a .265 clip and also ranked fourth in MLB.
- ▶ On day games, SF is hitting .259, third-best in MLB behind the Dodgers (.289) and Red Sox (.261)...the Giants' offense has performed particularly well over their last nine day games dating to May 10, averaging 8.11 runs per game while slashing .328/.376/.563 with 14 home runs and a .939 OPS...SF's .328 average in that span is best in the Majors and well ahead of second place Cincinnati (.277)...SF has gone 6-3 in those games.

YES, CHEF: With another four hits yesterday, **OF Jung Hoo Lee** extended his current hitting streak to a career-best 12 games...the 12 games are the longest active hitting streak in MLB and the longest by a Giant since **Dominic Smith** had a 15-game streak July 18-August 12 last season...additionally, Lee's four 4+hit games this season are most in the Majors.

- ▶ Lee hit twice in the 7th inning as part of the four-hit day, his second time hitting twice in an inning over the last five games (also: May 31 at Colorado, 5th inning)...he is the only player in MLB with two such instances this season and joined **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2003) and **Jeff Kent** (2001) as the only three Giants players to have two hits in an inning twice in one season since 2000.
- ▶ Since getting activated off the 10-day IL last Friday, Lee has gone 19-for-29 with three doubles, a triple and just one strikeout...he joined **Willie Mays** as the only Giants in the San Francisco era (since 1958) to record 19 hits and no more than one strikeout over a seven-game span (*Stats, LLC*).

YOU EVER THINK ABOUT PURPOSE?: C Eric Haase lined his third career grand slam yesterday to help the Giants to a 12-9 victory over his former team...the grand slam was SF's fifth this year, tied with the Angels for most in the Majors this year.

- ▶ The Giants have hit five grand slams in their last six victories dating back to May 17...according to *Stats, LLC*, they're just the second team in MLB history to hit five or more grand slams over a span of six wins, along with the Padres in August 2020.

HANDS!: IF Casey Schmitt homered on the first pitch of the game yesterday to record his first career leadoff home run and second by a Giant this season (also: Willy Adames on March 31 at SD)...the homer was Schmitt's 13th this season, a new career-best.

JUNE 5, 2006

Jason Schmidt matched a 102-year-old Giants franchise record with 16 strikeouts, fanning his final three batters to escape a 9th-inning jam and preserve a 2-1 victory over the Florida Marlins.

WITH THE GIANTS: The 2021 Cy Young Award winner is in his third season with the Giants and his 13th season overall in the Majors... the 2026 season marks the fifth year of a five-year, \$115 million contract he signed with Seattle in late 2021...he opted into the final two years of the contract prior to the 2025 season with SF.

LAST START: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 31 at Coors Field...threw 4.0 innings, allowing three runs (one earned run) on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts in the Giants 19-6 victory over the Rockies...he received 11 runs of support in the victory...it marked his fourth consecutive start that he has not made it past the 5th inning.

PAGING DR. ROBBY: Over his first eight starts this season, Ray posted a 3-4 record with a 2.76 ERA (14er, 45.2ip) and a 1.09 WHIP...in his last four outings, he's gone 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (17er, 17.0ip) and a 2.24 WHIP.

SLIP AND SLIDE: Ray's slider has been different this year with his average velo dropping from 88mph to 85mph...he's also allowed four HR with it compared to seven all of last year...opponents are hitting .267 off his slider this season, compared to a .206 average last year (S/S).

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received one or zero runs of support in six of his 12 outings...entered his last start with a 3.07 run support average, the sixth-lowest in the Majors...however, Ray received 11 runs of support in his last outing at Coors Field, which brought his run support average up 1.38 points to a 4.45.

AGAINST THE CUBS: Is slated to make his eighth career start against the Cubs...has pitched very good against the Cubs over his career, posting a 3-1 record with a 2.20 ERA, 41 strikeouts and .177 opponents average against over his seven outings...has posted even better numbers at Wrigley Field, going 1-1 with a 1.88 ERA and a 0.92 WHIP in four career starts...his last outing against the Cubs came on May 7, 2025 when he tossed 6.0 innings and allowed one run in the Giants 3-1 victory over Chicago-NL.

HOME VS. ROAD: Has pitched better in his six starts at home, going 3-1 with a 2.78 ERA and a .188 opponents average, compared to a 0-5 record with a 6.23 ERA in six starts on the road...San Francisco has won five of his six starts at home and dropped five of his six starts on the road...last season Ray posted virtually equal stats at home vs. the road.

LEFT ON READ: Left-handers are 8-for-their-last-24 (.333) off him with three doubles and a triple...lefties were just 4-for-28 (.200) with no extra base hits off him to start the year.

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on Sunday (second stint with SF)...has surrendered seven runs in 3.0ip in three games since his recall and has a 10.50 ERA in five appearances (6.0ip) for SF so far.
- ▶ Had gone 2-1 with a 3.91 ERA (10er, 23.0ip) in 17 relief outings for the River Cats this season.
- ▶ Appeared in 31 games for SF last season, working in a bulk innings role...recorded at least four outs in 18 of the 31 games.
- ▶ Batters were 9x64 (.141) with 18 strikeouts off his sweeper in '25... left-handed batters hit .202 (20x99) with 18 strikeouts off him.

- ▶ Allowed two runs in 2.0ip last in Milwaukee...still has a 1.88 ERA (3er, 14.1ip) in his last eight games.
- ▶ Has a 1.62 ERA (3er, 16.2ip) in 12 road games...has a 4.70 ERA (8er, 15.1ip) in nine games at Oracle Park.
- ▶ Issued at least one walk in 12 of 21 contests (4.8 BB/9.0ip).
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .212 (7-for-33) off his slider, .224 (11-for-49) off his sinker and .267 (4-for-15) off his changeup.

- ▶ Has made 10 appearances with SF, logging 8.02innings and allowing two runs on four hits with 11 walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ▶ Righties are 0-for-16 off him.
- ▶ Returned from rehab and reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 10.
- ▶ Is pitching in the Majors for the first time since July 2024.
- ▶ Missed the entire 2025 season while recovering from left shoulder surgery, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache in Los Angeles on September 18, 2024...also developed some right knee soreness during his rehab and underwent arthroscopic surgery in August 2025.
- ▶ Signed one-year deal with SF on December 3, 2025.

#45 CALEB KILIAN ▶ RHP

(kill-EE-en)

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider, Curveball
Last Game: 6/4 at MIL; 1.0ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed 12 runs (10 earned) in 12.0innings in May...had allowed one run in 14.0innings in 13 March/April games.
- ▶ Left-handed batters are 11-for-57 (.193) with no XBH against him while right-handers are 8-for-42 (.190) with five homers.
- ▶ Returned to the Giants organization on a minor league deal with a spring invite this past offseason...dealt with a right shoulder strain for most of 2025 with the Cubs organization.
- ▶ Originally drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2019 draft and was one of the organization's top prospects when he was dealt to the Cubs at the trade deadline in 2021 along with OF Alexander Canario in exchange for IF/OF Kris Bryant.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, 4 Seam FB, Sinker, Changeup
Last Game: 6/3 at MIL; 0.1ip, h, bb (11 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on May 16 after missing 14 games with a low back strain.
- ▶ Has allowed 14 walks in his 17.2ip (7.13 BB/9.0).
- ▶ Has allowed just one home run in his last 62.2innings pitched dating back to August, 2024.
- ▶ Right-handers are 6-for-32 (.188) off him while left-handers are 6-for-32 (.188).
- ▶ Holding opponents 2-for-23 (.087) off his slider and 5-for-32 (.156) off his sinker.

#71 WILKIN RAMOS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Sinker, 4-Seam FB, Curveball
Last Game: 6/4 at MIL; 0.0ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, 2bb (21 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A Sacramento on Monday and made his MLB debut that night...has allowed five runs in 2.0ip over his first two career outings.
- ▶ Was 3-1 with a 2.00 ERA (6er, 27.0ip), 27 strikeouts and a 1.15 WHIP in 17 games with Sacramento...had a 1.42 ERA (2er, 12.2ip) in May.
- ▶ Was an NRI with SF this spring after signing an MiLB contract with the Giants in February of this year.
- ▶ This marks his ninth season in professional baseball, pitching for four organizations (OAK, PIT, NYM and SF), 10 different Minor League teams and totaling 205 MiLB games before being promoted to MLB for the first time on Monday.

#66 DYLAN SMITH ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Sweeper, Splitter, Sinker
Last Game: 5/31 at RNO (AAA); 2.0ip, 2h, r, er, 2k (31 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Tuesday, his second recall of the season...made one appearance for SF on May 10 vs. PIT, throwing 0.2 scorelessinnings with a walk.
- ▶ Had a 3.98 ERA (9er, 20.1ip) .205 BAA and 23 strikeouts in 15 games with the River Cats.
- ▶ Acquired from Detroit on March 30 in exchange for cash.
- ▶ Drafted by Detroit on the third round in 2021 out of the University of Alabama...had spent the past five seasons in the Tigers organization.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut with Detroit last season...in seven games at the Major League level last year, the righty went 1-0 with a 1.38 ERA (2er, 13.0ip), four strikeouts, a 0.85 WHIP and .150 BAA.

#67 KEATON WINN ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, 2-Seam FB, Splitter, Slider
Last Game: 6/3 at MIL; S, 1.2ip, h, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Earned the five out save on Wednesday night, stranding two inherited runners in the 8thinning...has allowed just two of is 10 inherited runners to score this season.
- ▶ Leads SF with 11 holds, which is tied for the seventh-most in MLB.
- ▶ 20 of his 26 appearances this year have been scoreless (2.45 ERA).
- ▶ Opponents are just 16-for-93 (.172) off him this year.
- ▶ Batters are just 7-for-49 (.143) with 17 K's off his splitter.
- ▶ His 85.8 mph average exit velocity ranks in the top 8% of the league while his 26.8% hard-hit rate ranks in the top 3%.

- ▶ Has six homers in his last 16 games dating to May 18...had just three home runs in 46 games prior.
- ▶ Hit his sixth career grand slam and first as a Giant on Sunday.
- ▶ Is 31-for-98 (.316) with 14 XBH (seven 2Bs, 3B, six HRs) and 19 RBI in his last 24 games dating to May 10.
- ▶ 28 of his 61 hits this year have been for extra-bases (18 2Bs, a 3B, eight HRs)...his 18 doubles this year are T-4th most in MLB.
- ▶ His walk rate is 5.4% this season, down from 11.7% last year.
