LAST GAME: The D-backs lost, 5-4, yesterday @ Nationals in the series finale.

- Corbin Carroll (3-for-5, 2B, 3B) came a homer shy of hitting for the cycle with his first 3-hit performance of the season.
- · Jose Herrera (2-for-3, HR, RBI) slugged his second career homer in the second inning.
- Pavin Smith (2-for-3, RBI) delivered his second multihit game of the season.
- Alek Thomas pulled the D-backs within a run with his RBI triple in the eighth inning.
- · Jalen Beeks worked 2.0 scoreless innings with 4 strikeouts.

TEAM OFFENSE: Among all teams, the D-backs are tied for second with 45 walks (66 Cubs, 45 Mariners, 45 Red Sox), tied for fourth with 37 extra-base hits (46 Yankees, 41 Cubs, 39 Dodgers, Red Sox 37), fifth with 58 runs (77 Cubs, 76 Yankees, 63 Red Sox, 62 Cardinals) and sixth with a .450 SLG (.585 Yankees, .482 Cardinals, .471 Dodgers, .452 Tigers, .451 Red Sox).

LATE-INNING PRODUCTION: The D-backs' 28 runs in the seventh-ninth innings lead the Majors, ahead of the Cardinals (24), Phillies (23), Yankees (20) and Red Sox (18).

• In addition, Arizona leads the Majors in hits (40) and total bases (62).

VS. PENS: The D-backs, among all teams against opposing bullpens, rank first with a .301 AVG, second with an .872 OPS (1.047 Phillies), .398 OBP (.438 Phillies), tied for third in hits (54 Cubs, 50 Red Sox, 42 Yankees) and fourth with a .475 SLG (.609 Phillies, .506 Yankees, .480 Dodgers).

THE PEN IS PICKING UP: In the last 4 games, the D-backs' bullpen has allowed just 1 run over 13.1 innings (0.68 ERA) and owns a 0.90 WHIP, opponent .170 AVG., with 4 walks and 15 strikeouts.

PERDOMO PERFORMING: Geraldo Perdomo ranks among all top qualified shortstops in RBI (T-1st, 12), AVG (2nd, .314), hits (T-3rd, 11) and OPS (8th, .799)...is tied for third most RBI overall in the NL.

- Corbin Carroll has reached base in each of his 10 games this season (11 H, 5 BB, 2 HBP) and is slashing .282/.391/.641.
- · Alek Thomas, in 6 games, is hitting .381 (8-for-21)/.963 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 7 RBI, including 3 multi-hits...has recorded 1+ RBI in 5 games.
- Pavin Smith, in 9 games, is hitting .350 (7-for-20)/.958 OPS with 3 doubles, 2 RBI and 4 walks.
- Geraldo Perdomo, in 10 games, is hitting .314 (11for-35)/.799 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 12 RBI...has reached base in 9 of his 10 games.

2023 ROYs REVISITED: The three-game series will feature Corbin Carroll and Gunnar Henderson, who won the 2023 Rookie of the Year Awards in their respective leagues...both were also named Rookie of the Month for June that same season.

GENO'S CAREER HOMER LOG: Eugenio Suárez enters the series looking to homer against the Orioles for the first time in his career...Suárez has homered at least once against every club in the Majors except for the Orioles over his 12-year career.

VS. THE O's: The D-backs are 16-11 all-time against the Orioles (10-5 at home).

- · Arizona took 1-of-3 in its last series on May 10-12, 2024 @ Baltimore.
- The D-backs also took 1-of-3 in their last series @ Chase on Sept. 1-3, 2023.
- Josh Naylor, in his last 12 games since May 30, 2023, is hitting .385 (15-for-39)/1.120 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers and 16 RBI.
- Lourdes Gurriel Jr. is batting .353 (6-for-17)/1.036 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 2 RBI and 1 walk in his last 4 games.
- · Corbin Carroll has hit safely in 4 of his 6 career games, with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 2 RBI.
- Eugenio Suárez has reached base in 16 of his 17 career games since 2017 (16 H, 8 BB)/.329 OBP.

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT: Single-A Visalia catcher, Adrian De Leon, was named California League Player-of-the-Week after hitting .400 (4-for-10)/1.362 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 homer, 10 RBI and 2 walks in his first 3 games.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (1-1, 10.00)

- Will make his second home start this season...earned the win in his last start @ Chase on March 28 vs. Cubs in his season debut (W; 1 ER in 5.1 IP, 3 H, 4 BB, K).
- Marks his second career start vs. Orioles...lost his lone start on July 23, 2019 @ Chase Field.

AT A GLANCE: Seventh season with the D-backs.

 Named the 2024 D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona Chapter of the BBWAA for the fourth time ('20, '22, '23) after going 14-6 with a 3.65 ERA (62 R-60 ER in 148.0 IP), opponent .237 AVG (133-for-561), 54 walks and 156 strikeouts over 28 starts.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: Third start of the season, second home start.

- Second consecutive start against an AL East opponent...currently owns a 12.2 scoreless inning streak against AL East teams (0 ER in 12.2 IP, 5 H, 4 BB, 22 K).
- In 6 career home starts on Monday's, is 4-0 with a 1.13 ERA (5 ER in 39.2 IP) and 48 strikeouts.

LAST START: Struck out a career-high-tying 13 batters (also: Sept. 22, 2022 @ Dodgers) while tossing 6.2 scoreless innings @ Yankees on April 2 (W; 0 ER in 6.2 IP, 3 H, 0 BB, 13 K)...was his 14th career double-digit strikeout game.

- Became the third pitcher in franchise history to record 2+ starts with 13+ strikeouts and no walks, joining Randy Johnson (8 starts) and Curt Schilling (2 starts).
- Recorded his 900th career strikeout in the sixth inning (A. Judge).
- Since 2022, his 8 starts of 10+ strikeouts and 0 walks are the most MLB, ahead of Kevin Gausman/TOR (6).

VS. ORIOLES: Third career start... won his last start on May 12, 2024 @ Orioles (2 ER in 6.0 IP, 4 K).

 His lone start vs. Baltimore @ Chase Field was on Sept. 3, 2023 (L; 5 ER in 5.1 IP, 8 H, BB, 4 K).

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: In his last 3 interleague starts, is 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 17.2), .117 opponent AVG, 0.74 WHIP and 29 strikeouts.

Over 35 career interleague starts, is 14-10 with a 3.57 ERA (88 R-85 ER in 214.1 IP), .233 opponent AVG and 243 strikeouts.

AMONG THE MAJORS: Is 1 of 11 active MLB starters to collect 10+ wins in each of the last 3 seasons (since 2022) with Corbin Burnes/BAL, Kevin Gausman/TOR, Chris Bassitt/TOR, Zack Wheeler/PHI, Framber Valdez/HOU, José Berríos/TOR, Aaron Nola/PHI, Pablo López/MIN, Michael Wacha/KC and Logan Webb/SF].

• Since 2019, his 21 starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings, 6+ strikeouts and 3-or-fewer hits allowed are second most in the Majors, behind Blake Snell/SF (24), ahead of Corbin Burnes (19).

2024 RECAP: Posted his third straight season of 12+ wins.

- In 15 home games in 2024, went 8-3 with a 3.36 ERA (33 R-31 ER in 83.0 IP), 90 strikeouts, .235 opponent average and 5 home runs allowed.
- On June 29 vs. Athletics (6.0 IP, 2 BR), recorded his fourth start as a D-back of 6.0+ innings pitched and 2-or-fewer baserunners allowed (H, BB, HBP), which tied for second most such outings in team history (also: Josh Collmenter), behind Randy Johnson (6).
- Recorded his 750th strikeout as a D-back on June 29 vs. Athletics (sixth in franchise history).
- On July 4 @ Dodgers, recorded his 800th career strikeout in the fourth inning (S. Ohtani).
- Recorded his 50th career win on Sept. 4 @ Giants
- Struck out a season-high 11 batters on Sept. 25 vs. Giants.

SUPPORT FOR ZAC: In 2024, went 6-2 with a 2.61 ERA (15 ER in 51.2 IP) and 65 strikeouts in 9 games when the offense scores 3-5 runs for him... when the offense scored 6+ runs, Gallen went 8-0 with a 3.77 ERA (32 R-31 ER in 74.0 IP) and 76 strikeouts over 14 games.

UNCORK FOR A CAUSE: His first charity event, Uncork For A Cause benefitting the Zac Gallen Charitable Fund, on May 15, 2024, raised \$100,000 for St. Mary's Food Bank to ensure children will receive milk during the difficult summer months.

 The 250 guests enjoyed an exclusive wine tasting soiree featuring limited-edition autographed bottles of Gallen's very own Sonoma Reserve Red Wine.

2023 ALL-STAR STARTER: Named to his first All-Star Game in 2023 and earned the starting nod...tossed 1.0 scoreless inning with 1 strikeout.

- At 27 years old, became the youngest D-backs pitcher, third overall (fourth time) and first since Curt Schilling (35 in 2002) to start an All-Star Game (also: Randy Johnson; 36 in 2000 and 37 in 2001.
- Was the youngest NL starting pitcher since Matt Harvey/NYM in 2013 (24).

MILKMAN DELIVERED: Tossed his first career 9.0-inning shutout on Sept. 8, 2023 @ Cubs with 3 hits allowed and 9 strikeouts.

- Previously had a 7.0-inning, complete-game shutout on April 25, 2023 – Game 1 @ Braves (7.0 IP, 1 H, 2 BB, 6 K).
- Fourth D-backs pitcher (sixth time) to toss 9.0 or more innings, 0 runs, 3 or fewer hits, 1 or fewer walks and 9 or more strikeouts (also: Curt Schilling on April 10, 2001 and May 14, 2003; Randy Johnson on Sept. 14, 2003 and May 18, 2004; lan Kennedy on April 25, 2011).

HOW HE STARTED: Cardinals' third-round pick in the 2016 draft out of the University of North Carolina.

- Made his Major League debut on June 20, 2019 for the Marlins @ Cardinals (7-6 win, ND, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 6 K).
- Acquired by D-backs on July 31, 2019 from the Marlins.
- Made his D-backs debut on August 7, 2019 vs. Phillies (6-1 win, W, 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 6 K).
