YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Yankees, 4-1, in the opener of the three-game series YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Yankees, 4-1, in the opener of the three-game series in Charm City...Have dropped four in a row, their second-longest losing streak of the year behind a five-game skid from June 21-25...Have lost five straight home games for the first time since September 11-15, 2021...Snapped a 25-inning scoreless streak dating back to July 9 vs. Chicago-NL with Ramón Urías' triple in the second inning; marks Baltimore's longest scoreless streak since a 26-inning stretch from June 22-25, 2021...Have been held to just one run in their last three games; marks Baltimore's first time being limited to one run in a three-game span since June 22-24, 2021...The O's have failed to homer in three straight games for the second time this season, joining April 6-9; the last time they did not homer in at least four consecutive games was a five-game drought from September 20-24, 2023...Manager Brandon Hyde was ejected in the ninth inning; marks his 15th career ejection and first since May 7 at Washington.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles have been selected to the All-Star Game: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, Anthony Santander, and Jordan Westburg...Henderson (SS) and Rutschman (C) won the fan vote and will start for the AL, marking the first time the Orioles have had multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since Adam Jones and Nelson Cruz in 2014...Burnes earned his fourth consecutive selection as a result of the Player Ballot...Santander and Westburg were added to the roster as replacements for Houston's Kyle Tucker and Boston's Rafael Devers, respectively...This marks the first time the O's have had five representatives at a Midsummer Classic since 2016, when they sent Brad Brach, Zack Britton, Manny Machado, Mark Trumbo, and Matt Wieters...Henderson, Santander, and Westburg each earned their first career All-Star nod.

O: Rutschman received 70 percent of the vote to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and earned his first starting assignment; he'll become the third O's backstop (fourth occurrence) to start an All-Star Game, along with Gus Triandos in 1958 and 1959, and Terry Kennedy in 1987; Wieters was voted to start in 2014, but did not play (injury).

Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the vote; he is the first

O's Burnes becomes the first Orioles starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since John **Means** in 2019.

Santander joins **Austin Hays** (2023) and **Cedric Mullins** (2021) as outfielders to represent the O's at the All-Star Game in the last four seasons.

Westburg is the first Orioles third baseman to be selected to the All-Star Game since Machado in 2016.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 147 home runs, 12 more than the second-place Yankees (135) and 20 more than the Dodgers (127), who are third...The team record for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

① Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (27), Anthony Santander (23), Adley Rutschman (16), Jordan Westburg (15), Colton Cowser and Ryan Mountcastle (12), and Ryan O'Hearn (11).

① Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramírez (23) and Josh Naylor (22), and New York-AL's Aaron Judge (33) and Juan Soto (22).

② The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; Gunnar Henderson has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with Cedric Mullins (2021), trailing only Brady Anderson (12, 1996).

② The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

② Anthony Santander led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014) and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966), and finished behind Jim Gentile (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson will participate in the 2024 T-Mobile Home Run Derby in Arlington He will be the third Oriole in the last four seasons to hit in the derby, joining **Adley Rutschman** (2023) and **Trey Mancini** (2021)...Two Orioles have won a Home Run Derby, both shortstops: **Cal Ripken, Jr.** at Toronto's SkyDome in 1991 and **Miguel Tejada** at Houston's Minute Maid Park in 2004

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand tonight with the second of three games against the Yankees...After being swept by the Cubs and dropping the opener against the Yanks, the Orioles are guaranteed their first losing homestand since September 11-17, 2023, when they went 3-4...At 29-21 (.580), the O's own the sixth-best home record in the AL this year and the 10th-best in MLB...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 78-53 (.595) at Oriole Park, the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.616, 77-48), Dodgers (.633, 81-47), Braves (.638, 81-46), and Phillies (.644, 85-47).

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The Orioles and Yankees continue the third of four series with the ninth of 13 overall matchups this season tonight in Charm City...The 0's are currently 1.0 game up on the Yanks in the AL East...The Orioles took three out of four in Baltimore from April 29 to May 2 and two of three in the Bronx from June 18-20, including a 17-5 win in the rubber game of that series... The Birds will travel to Yankee Stadium to conclude the season series from September 24-26 (3 G)...The Orioles won the season series (7-6) against the Yankees last year for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2014-16...The Orioles are 12-9 (.571) against New York since the start of last season. the start of last season

AL BEAST: Entering the current series, the Orioles had gone 22 straight sets against AL East opponents without a series loss, going 16-0-6 in series during that time and 49-23 (.681) overall... That is the longest streak by a team against its own division without a series loss since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the Elias Sports Bureau...The Orioles need to win each of the next two games to extend the streak to 23 consecutive series.

(b) The O's are 19-8 (.704) against the AL East this year and have gone 51-28 (.646) against division opponents since the start of 2023.

(c) The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014; the Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.

Today's game will air on FS1, with Jason Benetti and Tom Verducci on the call...Tomorrow's game will air on Roku MLB Sunday Leadoff, with Matt Vasgersian doing play-by-play, Ben McDonald and Jeff Nelson as analysts, and Brett Hollander as the field reporter.

POPULARITY CONTEST: MLB yesterday announced the most popular player jerseys for the first half of the 2024 season...Orioles catcher **Adley Rutschman** - who finished last year at No. 20 - has climbed to No. 16 on the list.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today selected the contract of right-handed pitcher **Vinny Nittoli** from Triple-A Norfolk...He will wear No. 67 and his first appearance will be his Orioles debut...In corresponding moves, left-handed pitcher **Cade Povich** was optioned to Norfolk after last night's game and left-handed pitcher **Danny Coulombe** (left elbow surgery) was transferred to the 60-day Injured List.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 17th start of the season this afternoon against the Yankees...Is the first Oriole to win at least 11 of their first 16 outings to begin a season since Jimmy Key in 1997 (also 11); the last Oriole to win 12 of his first 17 appearances was Jim Palmer in 1975 (also 12)...Activated from the 15-day Injured List prior to the game on May 18 vs. Seattle (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to April 30...Posted a 7-4 record and 4.35 ERA (59 ER/122.0 IP) across 23 starts in his rookie campaign last year...Began last season with Triple-A Norfolk before being promoted and making his MLB debut on April 5 at Texas...Optioned to Norfolk on May 27...Recalled on July 17 for the remainder of the season...Originally selected by the Orioles in the first round (No. 11 overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up his 11th win of the season on July 7 at Oakland after tossing 6.0 innings, allowing three runs on six hits, one hit batter, and one walk with eight strikeouts...Left the game with two runners on, one of which scored... Has won six of his last seven starts since the beginning of June, the first Orioles pitcher to do since Tyler Wells (5/30-7/3/22)...His five total games with 8+ strikeouts this year lead Orioles pitchers...His 11 wins are tied with Kansas City's Seth Lugo for the most in the AL and tied for second in MLB...Threw 95 pitches,

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Scheduled to make his third career start against the Yankees...Owns a lifetime 1-0 record with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER/12.0 IP) across his two prior starts against New York-AL...Picked up the win in his last start against the Yankees earlier this season on April 29 at Oriole Park after tossing 5.2 shutout innings, allowing five hits and three walks with three strikeouts.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Making his 14th career start against the AL East and sixth of the season...Owns a lifetime 5-3 record with an 2.71 ERA (23 ER/76.1 IP) in his 13 prior starts against the division...His 2.71 ERA is his best mark against any division (min. 3GS)...Has gone 3-1 with a 2.73 ERA (9 ER/29.2 IP) with 28 strikeouts to seven walks against the AL East this year; division opponents are slashing .233/.282/.353 (27-for-116) this season.

REVERSE SPLITS: Lefty hitters are slashing .200/.275/.297 (35-for-175) off him this season while righties are hitting .270/.330/.459 (50-for-185)...Has allowed three extra-base hits to left-handed batters in his last six starts.

GAME OF ADJUSTMENTS: In Rodriguez's 10 starts in his initial stint with the club in 2023, he notched a 7.35 ERA (37 ER/45.1 IP)...After being optioned to Norfolk, he returned to Baltimore on July 17 and has gone 16-5 with a 3.10 ERA (59 ER/171.1 IP) across 29 starts since...Has posted 16 quality starts in his last 27 outings, dating back to July 28, 2023...Did not register a quality start in his first 12 outings to begin his career.

GAS 'EM UP: Punched out 129 batters for the 0's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20th rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters...His 226 strikeouts are the most in an O's pitcher first 38 games with the team in club history.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a careerhigh 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest O's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

<u>POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:</u> Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the
