THE TWINS: Have gone 3-3 through six games on their seven-game homestand, winning a series 2-1 over the White Sox earlier in the week, followed by going 1-2 in the first three games with the Royals...today, the Twins will play the four-game series finale against Kansas City...the Twins will have an off-day tomorrow, then travel to Detroit for a three-game series at Comerica Park from Tuesday-Thursday.

☑ Today marks Minnesota's final day in their run of 17 games in 17 days...tomorrow's off-day will be their first since May 21, just before their trip to Boston...Twins have gone 7-9 over the 16-game stretch.

☑ Twins are playing their 32nd day game today...31 day games, entering today, are tied for second-most in baseball...Minnesota is 13-18 during the day.

TWINS GET PUNCHED BY ROYALS LATE: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 3-2, making them 5-10 in one-run games...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...his only run allowed was a leadoff homer by Carter Jensen...Eric Orze (2-2) was issued the loss, blowing his third save, allowing two runs to cross in the ninth inning...the offense recorded just four hits, highlighted by a double from Victor Caratini and a pinch-hit homer by Orlando Arcia, his first of the season.

DIVISION COLLISION: The Twins and Royals are playing each other today for the seventh of 13 games in 2026...Twins have gone 2-4 vs. KC this season...these two will meet again for three games back at Target Field from July 28-30.

☑ Since the start of 2024, the Twins have gone 10-6 at home vs. the Royals, compared to 5-11 at Kauffman Stadium.

☑ Twins are 36-26 in their last 62 overall against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022...that includes a home record of 24-9.

☑ Josh Bell is hitting .311 (32-for-103) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI and a .976 OPS in 29 career games vs. Kansas City...two of his five home runs this season have been against the Royals (April 1 off Bailey Falter and April 2 off Steven Cruz).

☑ Kody Clemens has four home runs in his last five games against Kansas City, dating back to September 7...he has 12 career hits against the Royals, seven of which are home runs...he has a .250 career average vs. KC, compared to a .729 slugging percentage and a 1.175 OPS in 17 games...he also has seven walks and a .345 on-base percentage.

GRAND LEFT: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 22nd time...they have gone 9-12 against left-handed starters...their last game vs. a lefty starter was a 3-1 loss on May 25 at Chicago-AL...their last win vs. a lefty starter was a 4-2 win over Jovani Moran on May 23 at Boston.

☑ The 21 lefty starters are tied with Baltimore for fourth-most in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (22), Cleveland (22) and Atlanta (27).

☑ Austin Martin is hitting .302 (19-for-63) with 16 walks, a .451 on-base percentage and an .880 OPS vs. left-handed pitching this season.

☑ Since April 7, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (17-for-51) with an .844 OPS vs. lefties.

☑ Since April 18, Luke Keaschall is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with four walks and a .361 on-base percentage vs. lefties.

BUCK SHOTS: On Thursday night, Byron Buxton hit his 18th home run of the season...he has hit all 18 home runs over his last 41 games, since April 13...since that date, he ranks second in baseball in home runs, trailing only Kyle Schwarber (19)...below are Buck's season AL rankings in a few offensive categories:

THE MISSILE: Over his last 24 games, Kody Clemens has posted a .913 OPS (.323 OBP/.589 SLG), while hitting .295 (28-for-95) with nine doubles, two triples, five home runs and 11 RBI...over that 24-game span, he has started at five different positions defensively: first base 14 times, centerfield five times, rightfield three times, leftfield once and second base once.

☑ Clemens has reached base safely in 19 of his last 20 home games, posting a .366 on-base percentage in that span with a .939 OPS.

☑ He is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with a .667 slugging percentage and 1.042 OPS over his last 12 home games.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: Twins need a win today to split the series with Kansas City at two games apiece...they have gone 8-11-1 in series play, 5-3-1 at home and 3-8-0 on the road...season results in the right margin.

☑ Twins are 1-0-1 in four-game series this season, sweeping the Tigers from April 6-9 and tying a series vs. the Blue Jays from April 30-May 3.

☑ Minnesota's next four-game series will be July 20-23 at Progressive Field against Cleveland.

PRIE AS A BIRD: Today's starter, Connor Prielipp ranks tied for fourth among AL rookies in starts (8), sixth in strikeouts (42) and eighth in innings pitched (40.2).

☑ In four home starts, he has gone 2-1, 3.68 ERA (22.0 IP, 9 ER) with nine walks, 24 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .169 opponent batting average...in four road starts, he has gone 0-2, 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER) with eight walks, 18 strikeouts, a 1.79 WHIP and a .324 opponent batting average.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids right-handed pitcher Riley Quick and Triple-A St. Paul outfielder Matt Wallner as their minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

☑ Quick, 22, made the start on Friday vs. Wisconsin, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the Trussville, AL native was selected by the Twins in the first round (36th overall) of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Alabama.

☑ Wallner played in six games for the Saints, hitting .423 (11-for-26) with two doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, a .464 on-base percentage, a 1.077 slugging percentage and a 1.541 OPS...he hit three home runs on Thursday vs. Indianapolis.

BIRTHDAY SHOUT: Twins third base coach Ramon Borrego is celebrating his 48th birthday today.

LAST TIME OUT: On June 2, Prielipp started against the Chicago White Sox for the second consecutive game, marking the first time in his MLB career he has faced a team twice...earned his second win of the season after throwing 6.0 innings and allowing four runs on six hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts...gave up three runs in the third inning on four hits, two Luisangel Acuña stolen bases and an Alex Jackson throwing error to third base...did not give up his fourth run until the seventh inning (Luisangel Acuña - came around to score via a Chase Meidroth single off Andrew Morris).

- Threw into the seventh inning for the first time in his professional career, but did not record an out as Luisangel Acuña and Jacob Gonzalez recorded back-to-back singles off him before he was relieved by Andrew Morris.
- Prielipp threw a new professional career high 94 pitches, 62 of them for strikes (65.6%)...the 65.6% strike percentage tied his MLB career high (5/8 at Cleveland).
- In his last three starts Prielipp has given up four-or-more runs in each outing after beginning his MLB career with five straight starts in which he allowed two runs or fewer (see First Five/Last Three Table below).

TWO STARTS AGO: On May 27, Prielipp made his seventh start of the season at Rate Field in Chicago against the White Sox opposite right-hander David Sandlin...suffered his third loss in the month of May after giving up a career-high six earned runs across 4.1 innings while allowing a career-high eight hits, with three walks and five strikeouts.

FIRST FIVE/LAST THREE: After not allowing more than two earned runs in each of his first five starts, Prielipp has not allowed less than four runs in each of his last three starts...here are his numbers from his first five outings compared to his last three:

WELCOME TO ROYALTY: Prielipp will get his first taste of the Kansas City Royals this afternoon...today marks his third straight start against a member of the American League Central, after facing Chicago in back-to-back starts on May 27 and June 2...faced only one AL Central team through his first six MLB starts (Cleveland - May 8).

CAREER AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: In three starts against the Central, is 1-2 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP, 11 ER), seven walks, 18 strikeouts, a .290 (18-for-62) BAA and a 1.63 WHIP...after facing Kansas City today, Detroit will be the only team in the division that he has not faced.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through eight games, Prielipp has started four times at home and four times on the road...on the road he is 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (17.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 18 strikeouts and a 1.79 WHIP, compared to 2-1 with a 3.68 ERA (22.0 IP, 9 ER), nine walks, 24 strikeouts and a 1.00 WHIP in four starts at Target Field.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through eight MLB starts, lefties are slashing .238/.292/.381 (10-for-42) with three doubles, one home run, four walks and 12 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .245/.336/.377 (26-for-106) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 walks and 30 strikeouts against Prielipp.

SPLITS IN THE MINORS: In his minor league career, lefties slashed .313/.392/.413 (47-for-150) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 15 walks and 44 strikeouts while righties slashed .241/.317/.340 (80-for-332) with 11 doubles, two triples, six home runs, 35 walks and 124 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: In his eight starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

THE SLIDER: Prielipp's slider remains his best weapon as he throws it 31.8% of the time which is the most among Twins starters...his .157 (8-for-51) BAA his slider ranks sixth in MLB (min. 50 PA and 500 total pitches this season).

BY YOU: After allowing White Sox hitters to go 4-for-4 off his 4-seam Fastball in his May 27 start, Prielipp returned on June 2 and struck out three Sox hitters (single-game career high) with his fastball and held them to a .250 (2-for-8) BAA.

TUESDAY'S STARTER - RHP TAJ BRADLEY (2026: 5-2, 3.56 ERA // CAREER: 24-29, 4.68 ERA)

Taj Bradley is due to make his 12th start of the season in Tuesday's three-game series opener in Detroit against the Tigers...in his last start on June 3 against the Chicago White Sox at Target Field, Bradley suffered his second loss of the season after giving up four runs on seven hits, with a career-high-tying five walks (also 9/3/23 at Cleveland) and five strikeouts in 4.2 innings pitched...over his last two starts this season, Bradley has an 8.31 ERA (8.2 IP, 8 ER) with seven walks, 11 strikeouts and a 2.19 WHIP...Tuesday will mark his second career start against the Tigers; in his first career start against Detroit on April 7 at Target Field, Bradley earned the win, pitching 6.1 innings of one-run ball with six hits allowed, zero walks and 10 strikeouts.
