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BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore opens a six-game homestand against Philadelphia (3 to play) and Los Angeles-AL (3 to play)...The Birds are coming off a brief three-game road trip in Detroit, taking two of three from the Tigers...The Orioles have won 14 of 22 games since July 1 and are 11.5 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.5 games back in the Wild Card.

👉 The Birds' 10-9 victory on Wednesday marked the first time in which they have won a game after being down by at least seven runs since June 30, 2009 vs. Boston when they overcame a nine-run deficit to win 11-10...It marked the ninth such victory in team history (since 1954).

👉 **Jackson Holliday** recorded two more hits after entering the game as a pinch hitter in the seventh inning...He is the fourth Oriole (fifth occurrence) this season to record at least two hits as a reserve (last: **Tyler O'Neill**, 7/8 vs. CHC, also 2 H)...The Birds have at least five such player games for the first time since 2023 when it happened six different times.

👉 **Coby Mayo** tallied his first career triple on a game-tying, two-run knock in the eighth inning...He also notched his first career game with at least two RBI and two walks.

ROSTER MOVES: Yesterday, the Orioles acquired **C Jake Rogers** from the Detroit Tigers in exchange for minor league **RHP Zane Barnhart**...Rogers was activated earlier today while **C Chadwick Tromp** was designated for assignment.

BY ALL MEANS: **Brandon Young** has allowed no more than one earned run in consecutive outings for the first time in his career.

👉 Among starters with at least 17 starts, Young's .800 winning percentage ranks third in the AL behind BOS' Sonny Gray (.867) and TB's Nick Martinez (.833) and is tied for eighth in MLB.

👉 The Birds' .824 winning percentage in Young's starts is the best mark in MLB (min. 15 GS) ahead of WSH's Foster Griffin (.810), TB's Nick Martinez (.800), AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez (.773), and PHI's Zack Wheeler (.765).

INSIDE THE MATCHUP: Opponents are hitting .194 (27-for-139) off **Brandon Young's** four-seam fastball, the lowest average off any of his five offerings, which he throws 40.0 percent of the time.

👉 The Phillies are collectively hitting .266 against four-seamers this season, which is the third-best mark in MLB behind Pittsburgh (.271) and Washington (.270)...Among Phillies with the most success against four-seamers this season include Derek Hill (.409, 9-for-22, 2 HR), Edmundo Sosa (.409, 18-for-44, 3 HR), Brandon Marsh (.342, 39-for-114, 5 HR), Trea Turner (.305, 32-for-105, 5 HR), Justin Crawford (.294, 25-for-85), and Bryce Harper (.292, 26-for-89, 11 HR).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 100 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (42 G).

👉 Baltimore has secured a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025.

👉 The current 100-game stretch is the third-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), trailing streaks of 112 games (1995) and 104 games (1975).

👉 **Taylor Ward** has 84 walks this season, 22 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and six more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 80 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.

👉 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).

👉 Overall, the O's lead the AL and rank third in MLB with 423 walks.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: In 22 July games, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .370/.500/.426 (20-for-54) with three doubles, eight runs, six RBI, and 15 walks against just 11 strikeouts...The 15 walks are tied for second most in the AL during July, trailing only teammate **Taylor Ward** (18), and rank tied for eighth in the majors.

👉 Holliday owns a 14.7 percent walk rate (27 BB/184 PA) across 57 games this season after recording an 8.6 percent clip (56 BB/649 PA) in 2025.

NOT A PHAIR PHIGHT: **Taylor Ward** has gone 11-for-28 (.393) with four doubles and two homers in seven career games against Philadelphia.

👉 **Pete Alonso** has played in a team-high 104 career games against the Phillies, owning an .812 OPS with 25 doubles and 18 homers.

👉 **Tyler O'Neill** owns a .953 OPS against Philadelphia after having homered five times in 15 career games against them.

KITT AND KABOODLE: **Andrew Kittredge** has gone a career-high 15 straight appearances without allowing an earned run, tied for the second-longest active streak in MLB behind COL's Brennan Bernardino (21 G).

👉 It is the longest such streak by an Oriole since Seranthony Domínguez's 15-game stretch from May 26-June 30, 2025...The last Oriole to not allow an earned run in at least 16 straight games was Cionel Pérez in 2023 when he did not allow an earned run in 23 consecutive games.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.57 ERA in 58 games since May 24, the fourth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Tigers and Yankees (both 3.32) and Red Sox (3.39)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

👉 The rotation has posted a 3.79 ERA since May 24, the sixth-best starter ERA in the majors during that time...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).

👉 Orioles relievers have a 2.70 ERA since June 16, third lowest in the majors behind the Yankees (2.36) and Rays (2.68)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

HALL OF FAME: This weekend, the Orioles will be honoring the newest members of the Orioles Hall of Fame including former first baseman **Chris Davis**, former right-handed pitcher **Storm Davis**, and the late former scout **Jim Russo**...The inductees will be honored during an on-field ceremony prior to tomorrow's game against the Phillies at 7:05 p.m. ET.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 18th start of the season and the 30th of his career tonight in the series opener vs. Philadelphia...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Didn't factor into the decision of a 3-2 Orioles win on July 25 vs. Atlanta despite throwing 6.1 innings of one-run ball on four hits and two walks with six strikeouts...Allowed his lone run in the sixth inning off Mauricio Dubón's RBI groundout...Threw 94 pitches, 58 strikes.
🌀 Has recorded eight quality starts over his last 11 outings, including three in a row since July 10.

NEW TEAM, WHO DIS?: Young is scheduled to make his first career start opposite Philadelphia, marking the 19th MLB team he's faced since debuting in 2025...Over four starts vs. the NL East this year, he is 1-0 with a 3.43 ERA (8 ER/21.0 IP) after going 0-1 with an 8.38 ERA (9 ER/9.2 IP) over two starts against the division in 2025.
🌀 Young is 3-1 with a 4.56 ERA (25 ER/49.1 IP) in 10 career Interleague starts and has won his past three decisions (6 GS) dating to May 6, during which the O's are 5-1 (.833).

CATCHING FIRE: In 11 starts since May 24 (G1) vs. Detroit, Young is 5-1 with a 2.65 ERA (20 ER/68.0 IP)...Among all major league pitchers who have thrown at least 65.0 innings during that period, his 2.65 ERA is eighth lowest in MLB and fourth in the AL behind DET's Troy Melton (1.75), CWS' Sean Burke (2.27), and NYY's Cam Schlitler (2.55).

WHIFFIN': Young has struck out at least five batters in six consecutive starts for the first time in his career, over which he holds a 9.17 K/9.0 IP...That included a start vs. Washington on June 27, when he recorded a career-high 23 swings and misses...The 23 whiffs were the most by an Oriole pitcher since Kyle Gibson (also 23) on July 9, 2023 at Minnesota.
🌀 He has tallied 31 of his 80 strikeouts (38.8%) this season on his slider, which opponents are whiffing at 43.3 percent of the time... The 43.3 percent whiff rate is tied for the third-highest mark among MLB starters (min. 200 sliders thrown) behind CIN's Chase Burns (51.2%) and PHI's Cristopher Sánchez (45.3%).

SWEET VICTORY: Baltimore is 14-3 (.824) in games started by Young this season after going 3-9 (.250) in 2025...That included a seven-game winning streak from May 6-June 10, over which he went 3-0 with a 2.59 ERA (12 ER/41.2 IP) and five quality starts.
🌀 Young is 8-2 (.800) in 17 starts this season...The .800 winning percentage is the third-highest mark among AL starters (min. 15 GS) behind BOS' Sonny Gray (13-2, .867) and TB's Nick Martinez (10-2, .833).
🌀 He's on a career-high-tying three-decision winning streak (also 5/6-6/10/26) since June 21, over which he holds a 3.06 ERA (12 ER/35.1 IP) with 36 strikeouts to 11 walks.

FASTBALL FOCUS: Young's average fastball has climbed to 94.2 mph in 2026, up 1.7 miles per hour from 2025 (92.5 mph)...The 1.7 mph increase is tied for the fourth-highest year-over-year increase by any pitcher in MLB this year, trailing LAA's Ryan Zeferjahn (+2.2 mph), SD's Adrian Morejon (+1.9 mph), and CWS' Sean Newcomb (+1.8 mph).
🌀 Owns a run value of 11 on his fastballs (four seamer, sinker), which ranks in the 93rd percentile of MLB...Has prevented 11 runs with his four seamer, holding opponents to a .194/.296/.338 (27-for-139) slash line with five doubles, five home runs, 19 walks, and 22 strikeouts.
🌀 However, holds a run value of zero on his sinker, which opponents are slashing .322/.385/.424 (19-for-59) against with three doubles, one home run, six walks, and 10 strikeouts.

THEM CHANGES: Young is averaging 83.3 mph and 1,378 revolutions per minute (RPM) on his split finger over his last 11 starts since May 24 (G1), during which opponents are hitting .237 (14-for-59) with two doubles, one triple, and one home run...Over his first six starts of the season his splitter averaged 87.7 mph and 1,501 RPM, with opponents hitting .476 (10-for-21) off it with three doubles.
🌀 Last season opponents hit .281 (18-for-64) off his split finger with six doubles and five home runs...Threw the pitch 17.8 percent of the time in 2025 compared to 20.4 percent this season, marking a 2.6 percent increase in usage.

TRENDING UP: Young's 34.5 percent chase rate is a 6.7 percent increase from 2025 (27.8%) and ranks in the 87th percentile of MLB... Additionally, his 66.0 percent first-pitch strike rate is a 3.9 percent increase from last season (62.1%).
