FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals and Cincinnati Reds play the finale of a season-ending three-game series this afternoon as the club honors and celebrates **Adam Wainwright's** career this weekend at Busch Stadium ... The Cardinals will finish in last place in the National League Central for the first time in the Wild Card Era and first time since finishing 6th in the National League East in 1990 ... St. Louis will have spent 145-of-179 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present).

COMEBACK CARDS: St. Louis has recorded its first 90-loss season since going 70-92 in 1990 ... Since 1913, the Cardinals have lost 90 or more games only five times (1913, 1916, 1976, 1978, 1990), but finished above .500 the year after each of those seasons: 81-72 in 1914; 82-70 in 1917; 83-79 in 1977; 86-76 in 1979; and 84-78 in 1991.

THAT'S A WRAP: Since 1892, the Cardinals are 70-60-1 all-time on the final day of the regular season (44-32-1 at home) ... The last time the Redbirds played Game 162 against the Reds in St. Louis was October 3, 2012, a 1-0 combined shutout win by **Shelby Miller** (6.0), **Sam Freeman** (1.0), **Victor Marte** (1.0), **Marc Rzepczynski** (0.1) and **Jason Motte** (0.2) ... The lone run was an RBI single by **Matt Carpenter** in the bottom of the 8th inning.

SOUTHPAW SLUGGERS: Unless **Paul Goldschmidt** (25 HR) hits two home runs today, **Nolan Gorman** (27 HR) will become the first left-handed hitter to lead the Cardinals in home runs since **Matt Carpenter** (2015 and 2018) ... Prior to 2023, a left-handed hitter has led St. Louis in home runs in just 16 seasons, achieved by six different Cardinals (*chart left*).

FRESHMAN FINISHES: Rookie **Jordan Walker** has hit safely in 21-of-25 games played in September (.286/.349/.469, 28-98) ... With two more hits today, Walker would become just the 4th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 30+ hits in Sept./Oct., joining **Tommy Edman** (36 in 2019), **Albert Pujols** (32 in 2001), and **José Martínez** (30 in 2017).

BOOKEND BOMBERS: Only three players in Major League history have homered in their first and final career regular season game: **Eric Soderholm** (Sept. 3, 1971 with Twins and Oct. 5, 1980 with Yankees), **Dave McKay** (Aug. 22, 1975 with Twins and Oct. 3, 1982 with A's), and **Will "The Thrill" Clark** (April 8, 1986 with Giants and Oct. 1, 2000 with Cardinals) ... 2017 Silver Slugger Award winner **Adam Wainwright**, (and **Willson Contreras**) are members of the exclusive club of players who have homered on the first pitch of their MLB careers (May 24, 2006 at San Francisco off **Noah Lowry**, a game started by **Brad Thompson**). - *Elias*

PITCHERS ARE HITTERS TOO!: After pinch hitting for designated hitter **Luken Baker** on Friday night, **Adam Wainwright** became only the 4th pitcher in the DH Era (1973-present) to pinch hit for the designated hitter, joining Milwaukee's **Jamie Easterly** for **Ted Simmons/Mookie Haas** (May 23, 1983), Oakland's **Rick Honeycutt** for **Dave Henderson** (July 6, 1990-G2), and Washington's **Joe Ross** for **Yunel Escobar** (June 16, 2015).

PINCH-HITTING PITCHERS: The last time a primary pitcher pinch hit in their final career game was LHP **Mike Chris** for the 1983 Giants ... On May 1, 1983 at Busch Stadium II against the Cardinals, Chris pinch hit for the starting pitcher **Fred Breining** (flew out to CF) in the top of the 4th inning, threw 2.0+ innings in relief, and then never made it back to The Show. - *Elias*

LAST ONE FOR MILES: Opening Day starter **Miles Mikolas** makes his MLB-leading 35th start this season, becoming the first Cardinal to start 35 games in a season since **Chris Carpenter** (2010) ... Since Carpenter, only **David Price** (2016 Red Sox) and **Jhoulys Chacin** (2018 Brewers) have made 35 starts across MLB, while **Justin Verlander** (35 in 2009 with Tigers) is the only active pitcher to have done so.

HELLO, GOODBYE: **Miles Mikolas** today becomes the 12th Cardinals pitcher to start both the season opener and finale in the same season, joining **Bob Harmon** (1912), **Slim Sallee** (1915), **Dizzy Dean** (1936, 1934), **Murray Dickerson** (1948), **Harvey Haddix** (1954), **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (1956), **Bob Gibson** (1965, 1969, 1972, 1974), **Joaquín Andújar** (1985), **Darryl Kile** (2001), **Chris Carpenter** (2011), **Adam Wainwright** (2016).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY, MY FRIEND: Happy 60th birthday to Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** and 49th birthday to Cardinals Home Clubhouse Assistant **Patrick Cramer** ... Others born on this date include shortstop **Xander Bogaerts** (31), outfielder **Cedric Mullins** (29), Hall of Famer **Rod Carew** (78), actresses **Brie Larson** (34) **Julie Andrews** (88), and former pitcher **Matt Cain** (39) #RIPCommish

WAINO TEAMMATES: Since making his Major League debut on September 11, 2005 at Busch Stadium II, **Adam Wainwright** has been a teammate to 363 total players (184 pitchers, 36 catchers, and 143 position players) and had four managers: **Tony La Russa**, **Mike Matheny**, **Mike Shildt**, and **Oli Marmol**.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (October 1, 2009): Pitcher **Chris Carpenter** hits a grand slam and drives in six while pitching 5.0 shutout innings during a 13-0 thrashing of the Reds at Great American Ball Park ... The grand slam off **Kip Wells** in the 2nd inning was the 10th by a Cardinals pitcher in franchise history and Carpenter's first career home run ... His six RBI set a Cardinals record for a pitcher.

CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiserman** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Turner Ward served as hitting coach for Cincinnati during the 2019 season.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ. (1995-97).

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Nick Martini was selected by St. Louis in the 7th round of the 2011 MLB Draft...played seven minor league seasons in the Cards organization (2011-17).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over the last two seasons (2022-23).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals... his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 2015 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in St. Louis (2017-22) where he won the 2021 NL Gold Glove in center field.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2023 is making his MLB-leading 35th start of 2023, his 178th career appearance & 150th career start.
- Needs one win for 50 as a Cardinal and to join **Adam Wainwright, Chris Carpenter, Matt Morris, Lance Lynn, Jaime Garcia, Carlos Martinez, Michael Wacha & Kyle Lohse** among 50+ win Cardinals pitchers since 2000.
- Will become the 1st Cardinals pitcher to start 35 games in a season since 2010 when **Chris Carpenter** also did so. **Justin Verlander** (35 in 2009 with DET) is the only active pitcher to have done so.
- He is the first Cardinals pitcher to draw a start on both Opening Day and in the team's regular season finale since **Adam Wainwright** did so in 2016.
- Needs 5.2 IP to reach 200 IP for the 3rd time (2018 & 2022) in his career and for the 2nd consecutive season. He'd be the 1st Cardinals pitcher to reach 200 IP in consecutive seasons since **Adam Wainwright & Lance Lynn** both did so in 2013-2014.
- His 219 hits allowed lead the majors and are the most allowed by a Cardinals pitcher in a single season since **Adam Wainwright** (220) in 2016.
- This year marks his fourth 32+ start season among his five active seasons as a Cardinal (missed 2020 COVID-shortened season due to injury).
- Is currently at 53-53 for his career, following win last Tue. (9/26) at MIL. His W-L record had dipped below .500 (52-53) following his loss to the Brewers on 9/21 for the 1st time since July 27, 2014 (3-4, .429 pct).
- He's 49-47 career as a Cardinal despite losing 13 games in back-to-back seasons (2022-23). Miles lost a career-high and NL-leading 14 games in 2019 after winning 18 in 2018.
- Has received 3 runs of support or fewer in 26 of 34 starts this season, including just one run or fewer in 15 of his 34 starts (44%).
- Leads the Cardinals in wins (8), the first time since 1906 that the Cardinals winningest pitcher will have fewer than 10 wins in a full schedule season (**Fred Beebe** was 9-9 that year). The Cardinals fewest wins by a pitcher to lead team was 9 in both 1906 & 1903.
- Has allowed 23 of his 107 runs in the 1st inning (6.09 ERA, .338 BA).
- Since joining the Cardinals in 2018, Mikolas has issued the fewest walks in MLB (min. 750 IP) with 1508; **Justin Verlander** (151) is 2nd. His 1.63 walks/9 IP is 2nd behind **Zack Greinke** (1.61) for the fewest in MLB in that span.
- Hasn't committed an error since 8/2/18 vs. COL. One of two pitchers (**Erick Fedde**) with 100+ total chances and zero errors since 8/3/18. Ranks 8th among MLB pitchers in fielding pct. (.988) since 2018 (min. 100 TC). Miles is one of 11 qualifying MLB pitchers with a perfect 1.000 fielding pct. (30 total chances) this season.

- Tossed 7.0 scoreless IP vs. Reds on 5/25/23 at Great American Ball Park in 2-1 win.
- His win on 5/25 at CIN was just his 2nd over a 13-start span vs. the Reds dating to 7/15/18. It was his 1st win at GABP since 4/14/18, snapping a string of six-straight winless starts in the Queen City.
- Provided a gutsy effort in 11-3 win in record (103 degree) heat on July 16, 2022 at Busch Stadium win over the Reds. Allowed a leadoff HR to Jonathan India, then blanked Cincy for 7.0 IP in his final outing before the All-Star break.
- The Cardinals have won six of his last 10 games started against Cincinnati.
