THE TWINS: After completing their three-game roadtrip with a 1-2 series loss against the Yankees in New York, the Twins began their seven-game, eight-day homestand with a loss to the Tigers last night at Target Field...tonight, Minnesota will continue the homestand with the second of four against the Tigers through the weekend...they will enjoy an off-day on Monday, then host the Athletics for three games from Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ Twins are 32-26 at home this season and have gone 12-9 in their last 21 at Target Field.

TWINS DROP ONE TO DETROIT: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 4-3 in 11 innings, dropping to 4-8 in extras this season and 14-20 in one-run games... Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts...two of his three runs allowed came on a Riley Greene two-run homer in the fourth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Edouard Julien, who homered off Tarik Skubal in the third inning — Skubal's first allowed to the Twins this season.

RIDE THE TIGER: The Twins and Tigers are playing the 11th of 13 games this season...Twins are 4-6 against Detroit in 2025, going 1-3 at Target Field and 3-3 at Comerica Park...this series marks the final meeting between these two in 2025.

☞ Twins need to win the final three to secure the season-series vs. Detroit...one loss in these final three and the Twins will lose the head-to-head for the first time since 2023 (5-8).

☞ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 147, 36 ahead of Cleveland (111).

☞ Royce Lewis has posted an .831 OPS in 17 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 17 career games vs. the Tigers (.385 OBP).

☞ Former Tiger Kody Clemens is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with three doubles and two RBI in six career games against his former team.

☞ Byron Buxton has a 1.043 OPS and a .686 slugging percentage in his last 13 games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and five home runs in 56 plate appearances...Buck has homered four times against the Tigers this season: April 11 off Beau Brieske, April 13 off Casey Mize, June 27 off Sawyer Gipson-Long and June 28 off Casey Mize.

☞ Over their last three games against the Tigers, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.13 ERA (16.0 IP, 2 ER) with just three walks, 10 strikeouts and a .185 opponent batting average.

UNCLE BUCK: Byron Buxton enters tonight's game with 24 home runs on the season, four short of his single-season career-high of 28, hit in 2022...he is on pace to finish with 32 home runs...his last homer was on Monday at Yankee Stadium, off Will Warren...his last home run at Target Field was on July 12 vs. Pittsburgh, off Andrew Heaney — the cycle game.

☞ Over his last 40 games, Buxton is hitting .311 (47-for-151) with nine doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 22 RBI, 34 runs scored, 14 walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .662 slugging percentage and a 1.037 OPS.

THE MOOSE IS LOOSE: Over his last 20 games, Matt Wallner has reached base safely in 16 game...in those 20, he has posted a .377 on-base percentage (15 hits, 13 walks), a .597 slugging percentage and a .973 OPS.

☞ He has played in 76 games this season, tying his 2023 total...one more game played and he will set a single-season career-high in games played.

☞ Since July 27, Wallner has posted a 1.238 OPS against right-handed pitching, posting a .425 on-base percentage and an .813 slugging percentage.

☞ Since 2023, Wallner has posted an .857 OPS, 10th-best in the AL (minimum of 775 plate appearances).

SWR REHAB: Simeon Woods Richardson (illness) is scheduled to start on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul tonight in Omaha...SWR has missed the club's last nine games.

HELL OF A NIGHT: Multi-platinum, chart-topping country artist Dustin Lynch will perform a postgame concert tonight, presented by TickPick...admission to the concert is free with a ticket to tonight's game; a special ticket package that also includes a Twins-branded denim shirt is available for purchase at twins.com/DustinLynch.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Jim Thome hit two home runs in a 9-6 win at Detroit to become the eighth player to reach 600 home runs; Thome hit a two-run homer off Rick Porcello in the sixth for number 599, then a three-run shot against Daniel Schlereth in the seventh...in 2020, in front the big head cutouts debut at Target Field, Nelson Cruz homered in each game of a doubleheader against the Royals...for Cruz, it marked the first of three times in 2020 to homer in both games of a doubleheader (also 8/29 at DET & 9/8 at STL).

PIZZA PARTY AT TARGET FIELD: Luke Keaschall is celebrating his 23rd birthday today...he shares a birthday with former Twins manager Tom Kelly (75), former Twins player Chad Allen (57) and former Vikings quarterback Bubby Brister (60) — Dan Gladden's starting quarterback on his fantasy football team in 2000 (0 TD, 1 INT, 82 Yards).

HAVE A NICE FALL: Yesterday, Major League Baseball announced the schedule for the 2025 Arizona Fall League...the league will open on October 6 with the AFL Championship on November 15...all AFL games will be streamed on the Arizona Fall League website and MLB Network.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his first career hold on August 10 vs. Kansas City, a 5-3, 11-inning Twins win...worked the fifth-seventh innings (2.2 IP), allowing no runs with one hit and a walk...walked Maikel Garcia to start the fifth; Garcia stole second, then was picked off, OHL's first pickoff in the majors and his first since 2023, when he picked off three runners between High-A Cedar Rapids and Double-A Wichita...lone hit allowed was a single by Adam Frazier in the sixth inning...in the seventh, induced a groundout and a flyout before being replaced by Cole Sands.

LAST START: Last started on August 6 at Detroit opposite Jack Flaherty but did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-4 win...allowed four runs on four hits (3 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts over 2.2 innings of work...three home runs tied his professional career high, done on June 15, 2023 at Double-A Wichita...recorded a 1-2-3 first inning before allowing a home run to Spencer Torkelson to start the second...in the third, allowed a home run to Zack McKinstry and a two-run shot to Kerry Carpenter before exiting the game.

FOUR OHL TIMES SAKE: Among American League pitchers who have worked 11.1-or-fewer innings in their first four outings of the season, OHL's nine strikeouts are tied for the seventh most...also, his four home runs and nine extra-base hits allowed are the most, and his nine earned runs allowed are the third most.

FACING DETROIT: Is facing the Tigers for the second time in his career...Detroit will become his first repeat opponent at the major league level...also, his fourth-straight appearance against a fellow American League Central team.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In two road appearances this season, is 0-1 with a 7.94 ERA (5.2 IP, 5 ER), one walk and five strikeouts, compared to 0-1 with a 6.35 ERA (5.2 IP, 4 ER), two walks and four strikeouts in two home appearances...in four home games (3 starts) at Triple-A this season, OHL went 0-0 with a 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER), one home run, two walks and 15 strikeouts, compared to 0-1 with a 6.14 ERA (7.1 IP, 5 ER), one home run, three walks and eight strikeouts in three road appearances (no starts).
In 46 home games (34 starts) in his minor league career, OHL is 12-12 with a 3.70 ERA (201.2 IP, 83 ER), 20 home runs allowed, a 5.15 strikeout-to-walk ratio (175/34), a .253 opponent batting average and a 1.15 WHIP.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In four major league appearances (2 starts), lefties are hitting .323 (10-for-31) with three doubles, two home runs, five RBI, one walk and six strikeouts, while righties are 4-for-16 (.250) with one double, one triple, two home runs, three RBI, two walks and three strikeouts.
In seven appearances with the Saints this season, lefties went 9-for-31 (.290) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, four walks and seven strikeouts, while righties hit .190 (11-for-58) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI, one walk and 16 strikeouts.

Began 2025 season on Double-A Wichita's 7-day Injured List with a right shoulder impingement; during rehab assignment, made two appearances with Low-A Fort Myers, going 1-0 while allowing no runs with one walk and 10 strikeouts over 5.0 innings of work...reinstated on April 25.
Named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 1...in two appearances, went 1-0-1 with no runs allowed on three hits over 7.0 innings, with one walk and eight strikeouts.
In 13 appearances (2 starts) with the Wind Surge, went 4-1-1 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1 IP, 9 ER), two home runs, four walks and 23 strikeouts...did not allow a run in eight of his 13 outings.
