**MLB COMBINE AT CHASE FIELD THIS WEEK:** For the second straight year, the D-backs' Chase Field will host the 2024 MLB Draft Combine, from June 18-23...the top 300 Draft-eligible players have been invited along with up to 50 supplemental invites for the opportunity for players to participate in a series of medical and performance assessments as well as educational programming designed to prepare them for careers in professional baseball.

## SNAKEBITES

**THE NL CHAMPS:** The 2023 National League Champion D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23) last season.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs last last night, 1-3, @ Nationals.  
♦ **Brandon Pfaadt** made his second straight quality start (L; 3 ER in 6.1 IP).  
♦ **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** collected 2 hits while **Corbin Carroll** collected a double to extend his career-long on-base streak to 19 games.

**MAKE OUR SNAKES ALL-STARS:** **Ketel Marte**, in second place among NL second basemen (608,807 votes), leads D-backs vote getters in first balloting update for 2024 MLB All-Star Game.

♦ **Christian Walker** currently sits at sixth among first basemen (112,385 votes) while **Joc Pederson** sits at sixth among designated hitters (81,340 votes).  
♦ Phase 1 balloting ends on Thursday, June 27 at 9:00 a.m. AZ with finalists announced later that day at 3:00 p.m. AZ on MLB Network.

**SERIES-LY:** The D-backs can secure their third straight series victory today...they have won or split their last 5 series dating back to May 30.

♦ The D-backs have won their last 5 series-opening games (June 3-18) after going 3-15 in their previous 18 to start the season (March 28-May 30).

**CORBIN'S CAREER BEST STREAK:** **Corbin Carroll** is currently riding a career-high 19-game on-base streak (since May 29), the longest active on-base streak in the NL.

♦ Is batting .311 (23-for-74)/.860 OPS with 6 doubles, 2 triples, 6 RBI, 12 walks (10 strikeouts), 1 HBP and 4 stolen bases...previous high was 15 straight (April 3-19).

**NL'S BEST:** **Ketel Marte's** 4.1 bWAR leads the NL and is fourth in the Majors, behind Aaron Judge/NYY (5.2), Gunnar Henderson/BAL (5.1) and Juan Soto/NYY (4.2).

♦ **Marte** leads all second basemen with a 4.2 bWAR, an .852 OPS, 32 extra-base hits, 144 total bases, 42 RBI, 12 defensive runs saved and 1.5 dWAR, is second with 15 homers, tied for second with 15 doubles and 111 times on base and third with 80 hits.

**WALKER, TEXAS RANGER ALL-STAR:** **Christian Walker's** 2.0 bWAR is third among all first basemen, behind Freddie Freeman/LAD (3.0) and Bryce Harper/PHI (2.9)...his 16 home runs are third, behind Josh Naylor/CLE (19) and Bryce Harper/PHI (17), while his .808 OPS is fifth.

• Defensively, his 6 DRS and 0.3 dWAR are tied for the best marks among first basemen with Joey Gallo/WSH.

**JUNE BOOM:** The D-backs are 11-6 (.647) in June, tied for the fourth-best winning pct. in the Majors (also: Yankees and Red Sox), behind the Mariners (12-5, .706), Mets (11-5, .688) and Orioles (12-6, .667).

♦ The D-backs' 97 runs scored in June are the tied for the fourth most in baseball (also: Mets), behind the Red Sox (99), Yankees (99) and Orioles (98).

**DEFENDERS OF THE DIAMOND:** Since May 27, the D-backs' .989 fielding pct. and 8 errors committed are tied for the best in the NL (also: Padres).

• This season, the D-backs' .988 fielding pct. is the second best overall mark in the Majors, behind the Braves, while their 32 errors are second fewest, behind the Braves (30).

**LEADERS FROM THE 'PEN:** Among relievers since Sept. 1, 2023 (min. 20 GR), 3 D-backs' arms rank in ERA with **Ryan Thompson** (1st, 0.88), **Justin Martinez** (3rd, 0.93), and **Paul Sewald** (8th, 1.37)...the D-backs are the only organization to feature 3+ relievers in the top 10 ERA.

**10 STRAIGHT 5+-RUN GAME DECISIONS:** The D-backs' ended their streak at 10 games decided by 5+ runs (June 7-18), the longest such streak since 1900 [source: Sarah Langs (@SlangsOnSports) via @EliasSports]:

**ON DECK - PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES:** The D-backs last faced the Phillies in the 2023 National League Championship Series, winning games 6 and 7 (Oct. 23 & 24, 2023) @ Citizens Bank Park to clinch the NL pennant.

♦ The D-backs became the sixth team in MLB history to win a 7-game Postseason series after losing the first 2 road games (lost on Oct. 16-17 @ Phillies).

♦ Since 2022, the D-backs are 3-3 @ Citizens Bank Park... last season, Arizona took the 3-game set 2-to-1.

♦ **Christian Walker**, a Philly-area native, is a career .315 batter (29-for-92, 8 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 13 RBI) vs. Phillies while Scranton, Pa. native **Jake McCarthy** is a career .341 hitter (14-for-41, 3 2B, 3 3B, 3 HR, 9 RBI)...**Ketel Marte** is a career .336 hitter (36-for-107, 4 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR, 12 RBI).

**VS. NATIONALS:** Second career start vs. Nationals.

• Posted a no-decision in his lone start on May 7, 2023 vs. Washington (3 R-2 ER in 5.0 IP, 7 H, 1 BB, 3 K).

**FIRST INNING:** Has not allowed a run in the first inning this season... owns a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 11.1 IP), .158 opponent average (6-for-38), 0.71 WHIP, 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.

• In the first inning in his last 8 games (7 starts), owns a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 7.1 IP), .125 opponent average (3-for-24), 0.41 WHIP, 0 walks and 8 strikeouts.  
 • Is 1 of 2 pitchers to not allow a first inning run since July 31, 2023 (min. 10 starts) (also: Reynaldo López/ATL).

**NASTY NELLY:** Is 6-1 with a 2.44 ERA (23 ER in 84.2 IP), 0.90 WHIP, .193 average (58-for-301) and 51 strikeouts when he pitches 6.0+ innings (13 GS).

**IT'S UNDER CONTROL:** In 3 of his 5 road starts, has allowed 0 walks.

• In 6 starts from April 7-May 17, only issued 3 walks in 26.2 IP...among all starters (min. 6 GS), his 3 walks tied second fewest with George Kirby/SEA (3 BB, 40.0 IP, 7 GS), behind Zach Eflin/TB (2 BB, 41.0 IP, 7 GS).

**VS LEFT:** Is holding lefties in his last 3 road outings (2 starts), is holding lefties to a .229 average (8-for-35) and 7 strikeouts.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** In his last 5 games (4 starts) with runners in scoring position, has held opponents to a .111 average (3-for-27).

**0-2 COUNT:** Limiting hitters to a .231 average (6-for-26) with 0 walks and 12 strikeouts on an 0-2 count.

**RYNE IN RELIEF:** Earned the win on May 22 @ Dodgers, after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings on 5 hits and 3 walks with 5 strikeouts out of the bullpen.

**IL REPORT:** Was placed on the 15-day injured list (right elbow contusion) on April 19...reinstated on May 5.

**2023 RECAP:** In 27 starts with the D-backs, went 7-8 with a 5.53 ERA (85 ER in 138.1 IP).

- Made his first Opening Day roster.
- Tossed 5.1 scoreless innings with a career-low 1 hit allowed on May 17 @ Athletics.
- On June 25 @ Giants, tossed a career-high-tying 7.0 innings (also: Major League debut on Sept. 5, 2022 @ Padres)...retired 15 consecutive batters after a first-inning walk to J.D. Davis and was 1 strikeout short of tying his career high of 7 set in his Major League debut.
- Appeared in 2 games in relief and went 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA, .056 opponent average, 0.53 WHIP and 5 strikeouts.

**2023 POSTSEASON HIGHLIGHTS:** Made 3 appearances out of the bullpen, going 0-0 with a 5.68 ERA (4 ER in 6.1 IP, 7 K).

**2021 MILB PITCHER OF THE YEAR:** Named D-backs' 2021 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after going 7-4 with a 3.17 ERA (41 ER in 116.1IP) with 163 strikeouts and a .206 opponent average over 22 starts between High-A Hillsboro and Double-A Amarillo...tied for fourth among all Minor Leaguers in strikeouts.

**HOW HE STARTED:** Selected by the D-backs in the second round (56th overall) of the 2019 draft.

- Attended the University of Oregon, where he was a 2019 First-Team All-Pac-12 selection...finished his junior year with a conference-high 104 strikeouts and finished fourth in the nation with a 14.40 K/9 IP.
- A Nevada native, attended Basic High School in Henderson where he was a shortstop and pitcher.
