RECENT REDBIRDS: The defending NL Central Division Champion St. Louis Cardinals and division rival Pittsburgh Pirates play the second game of a four-game series tonight at Busch Stadium ... The Arizona Diamondbacks make their annual visit to St. Louis on Monday for three games ... After last night's game, the Cardinals fell to 0-5 in series openers (0-3 at home)

AHOY, MATEY: St. Louis has won the season series over Pittsburgh for nine consecutive seasons (2014-22) and 20 times in the last 23 years since 2000 (excluding 2008, 2012, 2013).

BURIED TREASURE: Although dropping four of its last five to the Buccos, St. Louis owns MLB's best overall win pct. against the Pirates (.588, 107-75) dating back to 2013 when the two teams squared off in the Division Series.

ARRRRRRRRRRGH: For the first time in a series since April 1, 2019, the Cardinals have a worse overall record than Pittsburgh in head-to-head matchups ... The last time St. Louis played Pittsburgh where the Pirates had a better record through at least 13 games played was Aug. 4, 2018 (Cardinals 56-54; Pirates 57-53).

NADO CYCLE: The Cardinals are giving away 25,000 Nolan Arenado Cycle Bobbleheads to fans tonight in celebration of his cycle last season on July 1 at Philadelphia, the 2nd of his career and 17th by a Cardinal in franchise history ... Arenado tripled in the first inning, belted a two-run homer in the third, doubled in the 6th, and hit an infield single to third base in the 8th.

MORE CYCLE NOTES: Prior to Arenado, Mark Grudzielanek (April 27, 2005 vs. Milwaukee at Busch Stadium II) was the last Cardinal to cycle and still is the last player (home or visiting) to hit for the cycle in the city of St. Louis ... Pittsburgh's Daryle Ward (May 26, 2004 at Busch II) is the last opposing player to cycle in St. Louis ... Busch Stadium III (2006-present) has yet to witness a cycle.

STREAKING WITH GOLDY: Paul Goldschmidt has reached base safely in all 13 games this season, tied with four others for MLB's 2nd-longest active on-base streak **Xander Bogaerts** (14) this season ... Goldschmidt, who ranks among MLB leaders in on-base percentage (.475, T-6th) and times

on base (28, T-3rd), has compiled 52 double-digit on-base streaks in his career, highlighted by his career-best 46-gamer last season ... Goldy's longest on-base streak to begin a season is 15 games in 2013.

NOOT NEWS: OF Lars Nootbaar began an injury rehab assignment with Springfield (AA) last night at Arkansas (AA-Mariners), going 0-for-5 with one RBI and two strikeouts while seeing 15 pitches ... Nootbaar has missed the previous 12 games since jamming his left thumb while sliding into third base on Opening Day.

ZEROS TO HEROES: St. Louis was 12-4 in games following goose eggs last season and won the following day after its first shutout this season in Milwaukee.

MAYBE IT'S A SIGN: The last time the Cardinals sported a 2-5 record in their first seven home games was 2011.

WALKER'S HISTORIC HITTING STREAK ENDS: Rookie Jordan Walker snapped his historic 12-game hitting streak to begin his career last night, a Cardinals rookie record and tied for the 6th-longest all-time by any player to begin a MLB career ... At age 20, Walker also matched Philadelphia Athletics outfielder Eddie Murphy's 111-year-old record, of hitting safely in each of his first 12 games in 1912 at age 20.

OFF THE BAT: According to Baseball Savant, St. Louis leads MLB in hard hit balls of 95+mph (160) and ranks 3rd in average exit velocity (90.5 mph) ... Paul Goldschmidt is 5th in MLB in hard hit balls (23) and 8th in average exit velo (95.6), while Alec Burleson ranks 3rd among MLB rooks in average exit velo (93.2).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (April 14, 1998): Mark McGwire hits three home runs against the Arizona Diamondbacks, becoming the only Cardinal to do so at Busch Stadium II (1966-2005) ... Montreal's Lance Parrish (May 29, 1977) and Colorado's Larry Walker (April 28, 1999) were the only opponents to go yard three times in a game at Busch II.

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Field), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), and Matthew Liberatore (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Turner Ward played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (A-SS).

Miles Mikolas spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for Chris McGuiness (Dec. 30, 2013).

Andrew Knizner's uncle. Matt Knizner. was a quarterback at Penn State Univ. and was on the 1986 National Championship Nittany Lion squad.

Tyler Heineman played in 21 games for Memphis (AAA) last season.

Chris Stratton pitched parts of four seasons with the Pirates (2019-22)...traded to St. Louis with José Quintana for Malcom Nunez and Johan $\textbf{Oviedo} \; (\text{Aug. 2, 2022}).$

Génesis Cabrera, Luis Ortiz, and Roansy Contreras were teammates for the Dominican Republic in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

 $\textbf{David Bednar} \ \text{pitched for Team USA in the 2023}$ World Baseball Classic with Adam Wainwright. Miles Mikolas, Paul Goldschmidt, and Nolan Arenado.

Derek Shelton was born in Carbondale. III... caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

Rich Hill pitched in 23 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization in 2010.

Rob Zastryzny pitched three seasons at the University of Missouri (2011-13).

Johan Oviedo signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Julián Javier signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956.. played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

- Earned his first Major League win vs. PIT (9/19/20) coming in relief of Kwang Hyun Kim. Was the pitcher of record as the Cardinals rallied from a 4-0 deficit with a 5-run 7th inning after Mitch Keller was removed following six no-hit innings.
- Was the finishing pitcher in his last three games vs. PIT, all coming in the final month of the 2022 season.
- Has not allowed more than three runs in any of his seven career starts (3-3, 3.25 ERA) vs. N.L. Central opponents; has pitched 5.0 or more innings in 6-of-7 starts.

- Today's start marks his 3rd of the season (13th career) and 68th career appearance.
- Makes his first career start vs. PIT after eight relief appearances. The Pirates are his 9th different opponent to make a start against with the Cubs as his most with four.
- Earned his first Major League win against the Pirates on Sept. 19, 2020, coming on in relief of Kwang Hyun Kim. Threw two-thirds of an inning and inherited the win
- Seven of his 12 career starts have come against N.L. Central opponents, posting a 3-3 record with a 3.25 ERA. Has not allowed more than three runs in any of those seven
- Career 3-5 with 4.64 ERA (54.1 IP/28 ER) in 12 career starts with the Cardinals going 7-5 in those games
- Ranks 6th among MLB pitchers in Avg Vertical Movement on the curveball (7.7 in.).
- Had a strong Grapefruit League season, going 1-0 with a 2.04 ERA in 5 games (2 starts). He led the pitching staff with 18 strikeouts in his 17.2 IP.

- Former first round selection out of high school made his Major League debut in 2020 in the second game of a doubleheader after the Cardinals returned from a 17-day absence from playing due to a COVID breakout. Has pitched as both a starter and out of the bullpen.
- Switched uniform number from No. 40 to No. 44 prior to the 2023 season to allow Willson Contreras to wear the same number he had since the start of his career with the Chicago Cubs in 2016.
- Finished the 2022 season on an 11.1-inning scoreless streak, winning each of his last four decisions.
- Since his MLB debut in 2020, ranks 4th in MLB in GIDP/9 IP (1.34), trailing teammates Dakota Hudson (1.44) and Andre Pallante (1.37) - min. 100 IP.
- Has career marks of 3-4 with a 4.53 ERA in 11 career Major League starts (49.2 IP) and 5-1 with a 3.53 ERA in 55 relief appearances (91.2 IP).
- Ranked in the Top 15 among MLB pitchers in average of vertical movement on his curveball each of the last three seasons at 14th in 2020 (6.3 inches), 11th in 2021 (7.2 inches) and 10th in 2022 (8.0 inches). Baseball Savant.

- Allowed career-highs with six runs and three home runs, while matching his career-high with seven hits in his first start of the season, an 8-4 loss to ATL (4/3) at Busch Stadium. Surrendered a 473-foot home run to Austin Riley, the 2nd-longest by an opposing play at Busch Stadium in the 1st inning.
- Was hit for three runs over 4.2 innings in his second start of the season at MIL (4/9). All three runs were knocked in by Willy Adames on a two-RBI double and a solo home run.

- Pitched between St. Louis and Memphis (AAA) making a combined 38 appearances with 11 starts covering 91.1 innings pitched.
