<u>Salutations!</u> Sal Frelick belted his first home run of the season on Wednesday, ending a streak of 397 regular-season at-bats without a homer.....Frelick had not hit a regular-season home run since last 5/15 vs. Pittsburgh.....it had been the second-longest active homerless streak in baseball behind the Angels' Tim Anderson (438 at-bats)....Frelick now has 6 career homers, all at home

Don't Mess With Bill William Contreras enters the day on a 10-game hitting streak in which he is batting .351 (13-for-37, 3hr, 11rbi) with a .419 OBP/.649 SLG/1.067 OPS.

Nick Mears has retired all 14 batters he has faced over his first 5 outings of the season....he began the year on the injured list while recovering from an illness from Spring Training.

# We Went to Jared

Jared Koenig is unscored upon in his last 9 outings (8.2ip 1h, 3bb, 11k) with opponents batting .037 (1-for-27).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 4 (2-1) of a 6-game, 7-day homestand against Detroit [2-1] and the Athletics (3g)....following this homestand, the team takes a season-long 10-game, 11-day road trip to San Francisco (4g), St. Louis (3g) and Chicago-AL (3g).

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (31 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 10\*, SECOND: 8, THIRD: 7, FOURTH: 3, FIFTH: 3.....the team is in second place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 1.0 game (\* 9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing their first game).

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Brewers are 4-2-0 in series play. Game 1: 3-3, Game 2: 4-2, Game 3: 2-4, Game 4: 1-0 Sweep Wins [-]: None.....Sweep Losses [1]: at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)

AT HOME: The Brewers are 7-3 at home, going 3-0-0 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 3-6 on the road, going 1-2-0 in series play.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager... 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

CDACHES: Returning from 2024 is associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season) and third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role)....first base coach Julio Borbón, lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf and hitting coach Eric Theisen are all in their first seasons on the staff.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has not made any replay challenges in 2025.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times over the last seven seasons (missed in 2022) and have won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four, and two straight.....the Brewers are one of just five teams to qualify for the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons... igined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6),

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 676 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight consecutive seasons, missing out by iust a game in both 2017 and 2022.

### TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA [4gs, 1-1, 2.31]

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, will be making his fifth start of the season.....Peralta last started last Sunday at Arizona and received no decision in the Brewers' 5-2 loss (5.1ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 4bb, 6k, 1hbp, 1wp, 104 pitches).....the team is 2-2 in his starts.....he has 1 quality start.....opponents are batting .159 (13-for-82, 3hr).....he was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Peralta has 977 career strikeouts, trailing only Yovani Gallardo (1,226), Ben Sheets (1,206) and Teddy Higuera (1,081) on the all-time franchise list.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 11-9 with a 3.68 ERA in a career-high 32 starts last season.....the team went 19-13 in his starts.....he made 11 quality starts.....his 173.2 innings pitched marked a career high.....he was among National League leaders in K/9IP (5th, 10.36), H/9IP (5th, 7.41), strikeouts (6th, 200) and AVG (6th, .224).....he produced 200+ strikeouts (200) for the second time in his career and for the second straight season (210 in 2023), joining Teddy Higuera (2x), Corbin Burnes (3x) and Yovani Gallardo (4x) as the only pitchers in franchise history with multiple 200+ strikeout seasons.

CAREER: Is 54-37 with a 3.75 ERA and 1 save in 182 games/133 starts [777.2ip, 324er].....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers [2018-25].....has gone 46-35 with a 3.74 ERA as a starter [693.2ip, 288er] and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief [84ip, 36er].....was an All-Star in 2021......was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 31-19 with a 3.47 ERA in 96 games/68 starts (415ip, 160er).....is 0-0 with a 1.13 ERA in 1 start this season (8ip, 1er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 23-18 with a 4.07 ERA in 86 games/65 starts (362.2ip, 164er)....is 1-1 with a 2.93 ERA in 3 starts this season (15.1ip, 5er).
