**THE TWINS:** After finishing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 5-1 (3-0 at Texas and 2-1 at Arizona), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a loss to the Dodgers last night...tonight, they will play the second of three against Los Angeles and complete the series tomorrow night...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday then host the Rockies for three games over the weekend.  
 ☞ Twins have won six of their last eight and eight of their last 12.

**LOSS ANGELES:** The Twins lost to the Dodgers last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, making them 7-12 in one-run games this season...Zebby Matthews (3-5) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...he allowed a leadoff homer to Shohei Ohtani and another solo shot to Freddie Freeman in the sixth inning...the offense recorded just three hits, highlighted by a Byron Buxton solo home run in the first inning, his AL-leading 25th of the season (tied w/ Yordan Alvarez).

**TWINS-DODGERS, ON THE RECORD:** The Twins are playing the Dodgers in the regular season for the 29th, 30th and 31st times in their history this week...the Twins are 9-20 all-time vs. Los Angeles...in the regular season, Minnesota is 3-11 all-time at Dodger Stadium (3-14 counting the 0-3 record during the 1965 World Series), 3-9 at Target Field and 3-0 at the Metrodome.  
 ☞ The Twins' .310 winning percentage against LA is their second-lowest vs. any opponent in their history (since 1961), trailing Atlanta (.286 — 8-20).  
 ☞ Byron Buxton has reached base safely in 11-straight games vs. the Dodgers, dating back to August of 2022...in that span, he is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with four home runs, seven RBI, a .367 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS.  
 ☞ Victor Caratini has posted an .828 OPS over his last 14 games against the Dodgers, dating back to September of 2021.  
 ☞ Josh Bell has reached safely in 16 of his last 17 games against the Dodgers (dating back to August of 2023), hitting .317 (19-for-60) with a .795 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Royce Lewis has hit safely in all four career games against the Dodgers...in those game, he has gone 7-for-14 with two doubles, one home run, two walks and four RBI.

**ADDITIONALLY...** Buck's 25th home run last night made him the second Twin to reach the 25-homer mark before the All-Star break...the other was Harmon Killebrew (4x).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Austin Voth from Triple-A St. Paul...Voth has split the season between Triple-A Buffalo (Toronto) and St. Paul, going 1-3, 3.65 ERA (44.1 IP, 18 ER), 15 walks, 40 strikeouts, a 1.35 WHIP and a .254 opponent batting average...the 33-year-old was signed to a minor league contract by Minnesota on June 4 and has appeared in three games (3 starts) for the Saints, striking out 17 batters in 13.1 innings pitched (June 4-18)...the Redmond, WA native has pitched in parts of eight major league seasons with Washington (2018-22), Baltimore ('22-'23), Seattle ('24) and Toronto ('26).  
 ☞ To make room for Voth on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Cody Laweryson to St. Paul.

**BUCK BOMBS:** All 25 of Byron Buxton's home runs have come in his last 54 games, since April 13...over his last full calendar year, Buck has hit 43 home runs in 134 games (490 plate appearances)...over his last 162 games, he has hit 53 home runs in 712 plate appearances (since May 6, 2025).  
 ☞ In 32 home games this season, Buxton is hitting .325 (41-for-126) with 14 home runs, a .722 slugging percentage and a 1.119 OPS...he has homered four times in his last six home games.

**CONTACT LIST:** Twins have struck out just 131 times this month, the second-fewest in baseball, trailing Arizona (130)...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279).  
 ☞ Notable individuals this month (minimum of 70 plate appearances): Brooks Lee (8.3%) ranks first in the AL, Luke Keaschall (13.5%) ranks sixth and Kody Clemens (16.5%) ranks 15th.

**SUMMER LOVIN':** Through 20 games this month, the Twins are slugging .481, which ranks fourth-best in baseball, trailing Detroit (.496), the Athletics (.496) and Colorado (.492).  
 ☞ Twins have homered 33 times over their last 17 games, since June 4...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (40).

**GIMME A BELL YEAH:** Josh Bell has reached safely in eight-straight games...over his last 21 games, he is hitting .347 (25-for-72) with five doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI, a .405 on-base percentage, a .583 slugging percentage and a .988 OPS.  
 ☞ Since June 14, he has reached base safely in 17 of 33 plate appearances (.515 OBP).  
 ☞ He leads the club with 48 RBI...16 of those RBI have come in his last 16 games.

- ⚡ Kendry Rojas is slated to make his second career MLB start (sixth appearance) tonight against the Los Angeles Dodgers.
- ⚡ The start will mark his first major league outing since being placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 29 (retroactive to May 26) with left elbow inflammation.
- ⚡ Made one rehab appearance on June 18 vs. Omaha while with Triple-A St. Paul, giving up five runs on five hits, with one walk and one strikeout in 1.1 innings of work.
- ⚡ In his last major league outing on May 23 at Boston, Rojas pitched 3.0 scoreless innings of relief and allowed one hit, with one walk and three strikeouts.

**LAST TIME OUT (REHAB):** Rojas made one rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul on June 18 vs. Omaha, after spending May 29-June 17 on the Injured List with left elbow inflammation...in his sole appearance he tossed 1.1 innings in relief, giving up a season-high five runs on five hits (four singles and one double), with one walk and one strikeout...threw 33 pitches in the outing, 22 of them for strikes.

**LAST TIME OUT (MLB):** Kendry last pitched in MLB on May 23 at Boston, firing 3.0 scoreless innings with just one hit allowed in relief of Taj Bradley, with one walk and three strikeouts in a 4-2 Twins victory at Fenway Park.

- ⚡ After surrendering a single to Jarren Duran to begin his outing, Kendry retired nine of his final 11 batters faced, with the only two base runners coming on a Nick Sogard walk and a throwing error that allowed Ceddanne Rafaela to reach.
- ⚡ Has pitched 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings for the Twins dating back to the ninth inning on May 14 vs. Miami, allowing just three combined hits with two walks and eight strikeouts in that span.

**VIVA CUBA!:** Rojas, a native of Ciego de Avila, Cuba, is just the sixth Cuban-born pitcher in Twins club history (1961-) to make a start, and first since Liván Hernández made 23 starts for Minnesota during the 2008 season...below is a list of all six Cuban-born starting pitchers in Twins club history, and their numbers as a starter:

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS (MAJORS):** In five major league outings, Kendry has made two appearances at home (one start), going 0-0 with a 1.50 ERA (6.0 IP, 1 ER), three walks and six strikeouts, compared to 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP, 1 ER), seven walks and eight strikeouts in three appearances on the road.

- ⚡ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Rojas has made three home appearances with St. Paul and three road appearances (one start) this season; at home is 0-0 with a 7.88 ERA (8.0 IP, 7 ER), four walks and six strikeouts and on the road is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (8.1 IP, 2 ER), two walks and 10 strikeouts.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS (MAJORS):** Rojas has faced 61 total batters through his first five outings, with lefties slashing .188/.435/.188 (3-for-16) with zero extra-base hits, seven walks and seven strikeouts, while righties are slashing .242/.324/.303 (8-for-33) with two doubles, three walks and seven strikeouts.

- ⚡ **SPLITS IN THE MINORS:** Through six appearances with St. Paul this season, lefties are slashing .154/.267/.154 (2-for-13) off Rojas with one walk and four strikeouts, while righties are slashing .327/.386/.423 (17-for-52) with two doubles, one homer, five walks and 12 strikeouts...in his minor league career, lefties are slashing .220/.287/.316 (62-for-282) with 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 18 walks and 82 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .248/.323/.375 (211-for-850) with 51 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs, 93 walks and 262 strikeouts; if you combine both sides of the plate, Rojas has a career minor league BAA of .241 (273-for-1132).

**THE ARSENAL:** Rojas displayed a four-pitch arsenal through his first five big-league appearances prior to injury...here are his numbers, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ **A NOTE ON THE HEATER:** Kendry's .118 (2-for-17) BAA on his 4-Seam Fastball currently ranks first among active Twins' pitchers and also ranks second with a 25.6 whiff percentage (min. 10 PA) - also excludes pitchers currently on the Injured List.

- ⚡ **EXCITED TO SEE THE SLIDER AGAIN:** Prior to his stint on the Injured List, Rojas generated a .100 (1-for-10) BAA his slider in his three outings from May 14-May 23...in those 10 at-bats opposing hitters managed only a single and struck out three times...in comparison, through his first two big league outings, opposing hitters hit .500 (3-for-6) with two singles, one double and only one strikeout.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - JOE RYAN (2026: 5-3, 2.99 ERA // CAREER: 51-39, 3.69 ERA)

Joe Ryan is slated to make his 17th start of the season tomorrow night in the finale of a three-game series against the Los Angeles Dodgers...in his most recent start on June 18 at Texas, Joe earned his fifth win of the season after firing 5.0 scoreless innings and allowing three hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in a 9-3 Twins victory...over his last eight starts dating back to May 9 at Cleveland, he is 3-0 with a 2.40 ERA (48.2 IP, 13 ER), eight walks, 59 strikeouts and a 0.95 WHIP...Ryan has made one career start against the Dodgers, on August 9, 2022; in that start took the loss after giving up six runs (five earned) on nine hits (1 HR - Max Muncy), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched.
