TODAY'S GAME: The Braves continue their exhibition schedule today against the Tampa Bay Rays with their 25th of 32 games this spring.. Following today, the club will have four games remaining at CoolToday Park in North Port, Fla. and three games on the road...This afternoon's contest is the fourth of five scheduled exhibition meetings between the clubs...Atlanta won each of the first two exhibitions, before Tampa Bay won the last meeting, 3-1, on March 14...The teams will play again on March 23...During the regular season, the Braves will host the Rays at Truist Park for a three-game weekend set, June 14-16.
A The Braves host nine different major league teams at CoolToday Park, including three games each against the Baltimore Orioles and Minnesota Twins and two games each against the Boston Red Sox, Pittsburgh Pirates and Tampa Bay Rays...The Detroit Tigers, New York Yankees, Philadelphia Phillies and Toronto Blue Jays will make one visit each to North Port.

CAMP BREAKDOWN: The Braves currently have 34 players in camp, 15 of whom are pitchers (seven left-handers and eight right-handers)... Atlanta also has four catchers, eight infielders and seven outfielders in camp...There are six non-roster invitees (two catchers, three infielders and one outfielder)...The club opened camp with 60 players.

A The Braves today optioned RHP Bryce Elder and RHP HuascarYnoa to Triple-A Gwinnett.
A On March 14, the Braves signed OF Adam Duvall to a one-year major league contract worth $\$ 3$ million for the 2024 season...The club also released OF Jordan Luplow.
A On March 5, MLB Pipeline unveiled its prospect rankings for the 2024 season...Atlanta opened camp with seven players that currently rank among the team's top 30 prospects, including top overall prospect, RHP AJ Smith-Shawver...Also included are fellow top 10 prospects RHP Hurston Waldrep (No. 2) and INF Nacho Alvarez Jr. (No. 6).

23 IN '23: The Braves clinched the 23rd division title in franchise history last season, beating Philadelphia, 4-1 on September 13 at Citizens Bank Park to win the National League East...The 23 division titles are the most in major league history, two more than Los Angeles (NL) and three more than New York (AL)...Last season also marked the franchise's 29th postseason berth in the Modern Era (since 1900) and its sixth straight.
A The Braves won a major league-record 14 consecutive division titles from 1991-2005, with the first three coming as NL West champs before moving into the NL East in the strike-shortened 1994 season...They also won the West in 1969 and 1982, and the East in 2013 and every year since 2018.

A The six straight division titles marks the longest streak in baseball...The Astros have won three straight AL West titles dating to 2021, while the Dodgers have won each of the last two NL West crowns.

## Probable Starter

Max Fried • LHP • 6-4 • $190 \cdot 30$ yrs • \#54

- Makes his third start of the spring, last: March 8 vs. Pittsburgh...Owns a 7.20 ERA (4 ER/5.0 IP) with four strikeouts and three walks.
- Went 8-1 with a 2.55 ERA (22 ER/77.2 IP) in 14 starts last season.. Navigated three separate stints on the Injured List: April 4-17 (strained left hamstring), May 9-August 4 (strained left forearm) and September 22 through the end of the regular season (blister on left index finger).
Served as Atlanta's Opening Day starter in each of the last two seasons...Since the start of 2019, his 60 wins rank second in all of baseball, trailing New York's (AL) Gerrit Cole (71).
Entering his final season of club control...Acquired by Atlanta, along with OF Dustin Peterson and INF Jace Peterson from the San Diego Padres on December 19, 2014, in exchange for RHP Aaron Northcraft and OF Justin Upton...He's the second-longest-tenured player on the Braves roster, having made his MLB debut with the club, August 8, 2017...INF Ozzie Albies made his debut one week earlier on August 1...LHP A.J. Minter followed, debuting on August 17.
