**THE TWINS:** After completing their nine-game, 10-day roadtrip with a record 3-6 (2-1 in Houston, 0-3 at New York-AL and 1-2 at Pittsburgh), the Twins began their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a win over the Rockies last night...tonight, Minnesota will play the second of three against Colorado, then wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after this series, they will welcome the A's for four games from Thursday-Sunday, enjoy an off-day on Monday, then play the Rays for three games next Tuesday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins are 17-13 at home this season...they have gone 15-7 in their last 22 at Target Field after starting the season 2-6 here.

**THE SHERIFF SHUTS 'EM DOWN:** The Twins shut out the Rockies last night at Target Field, winning by a score of 5-0, marking their third shutout of the season...Chris Paddack (5-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.1 shutout innings, with six hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...Griffin Jax made his 30th appearance and struck out three batters on 11 pitches in the eighth inning...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Carlos Correa, who doubled for the 12th time this season...Royce Lewis made his Target Field return with a two-run homer, his fourth of the season...the time of game tied a season-best at 2:09 (previously 5/6 vs. SEA).

**ROSTER MOVE:** Earlier today, the Twins recalled right-handed pitcher Louie Varland from Roster-A St. Paul...Varland made eight starts for the Saints from April 27-June 6, going 2-5, 5.31 ERA (40.2 IP, 24 ER), 14 walks and 44 strikeouts...he made the Twins Opening Day roster and made four starts for Minnesota from April 2-21, going 0-4, 9.18 ERA (16.2 IP, 17 ER), nine walks and 18 strikeouts and was optioned to St. Paul on April 22...to make room for Varland on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo to St. Paul...Castillo appeared in five games, posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks and three strikeouts.

**ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH:** The Twins and Rockies are playing each other for the 22nd, 23rd and 24th time in their history this week...the Twins have gone 13-9 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 5-4 at Coors Field (2008, '14 & '23) and 6-4 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22 & '24).

☞ Dating back to June of 2022, the Twins have gone 5-1 against Colorado in their last six.

☞ The Twins have hit just 18 home runs against the Rockies in their history, Minnesota's second-fewest among any opponent (Atlanta -17).

☞ The Twins' 22 games against the Rockies are tied for third-fewest against any opponent (Miami - 19, San Francisco - 21 and Atlanta - 22).

**UNREAL ROYCE:** Through seven games this season, Royce Lewis is hitting .333 (7-for-21) with one double, four home runs, six RBI, two walks, a .375 on-base percentage, a .952 slugging percentage and a 1.327 OPS.

☞ Lewis has played in 77 career games...his 162-game averages are: .309 (181-for-585) with 25 doubles, 44 home runs, 133 RBI, 97 runs scored, 13 stolen bases and a .944 OPS.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** The Twins are 6-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-1 at Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh and 1-0 vs. Colorado...after this series, their next IL opponent will be the Diamondbacks at Chase Field from June 25-27.

☞ Trevor Larnach has four doubles, one triple, five home runs, 20 RBI, a .574 slugging percentage and an .875 OPS in 21 games against the NL since the start of last season.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with one double, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, eight walks and a 1.036 OPS in 12 games against NL opponents this season.

☞ Ryan Jeffers has nine home runs, a .403 on-base percentage, a .593 slugging percentage and a .996 OPS in 37 Interleague games since the start of last season...Jeffers' IL OPS ranks 13th in baseball since the start of last season.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** Over the last 19 games, the Twins relievers have gone 5-0, 2.13 ERA (63.1 IP, 15 ER) with 22 walks, 55 strikeouts, a .182 opponent batting average, 14 holds and seven saves in seven opportunities...below are the reliever ranks among other AL bullpens on the season:

**C4 IGNITING:** Carlos Correa is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with one double, one home run, five RBI, two walks, a .478 on-base percentage, a .650 slugging percentage and a 1.128 OPS in his last five games.

☞ Correa is hitting .317 (20-for-63) against breaking pitches this season, fifth-best average in the AL and ninth-best in baseball (minimum of 750 pitches seen).

☞ On the season, he ranks in MLB's 90th percentile in expected batting average (.288) and bat speed (75.0) and in the 87th percentile in expected wOBA (.364).

**WE HAVE CONTACT:** The Twins struck out a season-low two times yesterday, passing their previous low of three, done on April 24 vs. Chicago-AL...it was the fewest since June 24, 2022 vs. Colorado (also 2)...they have struck out just 15 times over their last three games...through nine games this month, Twins hitters have posted a strikeout rate of 21.0%...by comparison, they posted a 24.9% strikeout rate in April and 21.4% in May.

**LAST START:** Last pitched on June 6 vs. Syracuse Mets for Triple-A St. Paul...took his third consecutive loss of the minor league season dating back to May 26...allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR), four walks and one strikeout -- his six runs allowed and four walks are all season highs in the minors (8 starts)...allowed three-run home run to Pablo Reyes in the second inning.

**MILB RECAP:** Optioned to the Saints on April 22...since being sent down has made eight starts going 2-5, 5.31 ERA (40.2 IP, 24 ER), 14 walks, 44 strikeouts a 1.45 WHIP and a .274 (45-for-164) opponent batting average...made four home starts and four road starts.

- ☞ Had back-to-back games with eight strikeouts May 3-9.
- ☞ Fourth and fifth hitters hit .125 (5-for-40) with one double, one home run, three walks and 16 strikeouts.

**VARLAND VS. ROCKIES:** Facing the Colorado Rockies for the first time in his career...has made two career starts against the National League West division (LAD & SD), going 0-1, 5.73 ERA (11.0 IP, 7 ER), five walks and 12 strikeouts...making his third Interleague start of the season, after facing Milwaukee on April 2 and Los Angeles-NL on April 9; went 0-2, 9.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 9 ER), five walks and 10 strikeouts in those starts...career 1-2, 6.04 ERA (22.1 IP, 15 ER), eight walks and 25 strikeouts in five Interleague appearances (4 starts).

**DUB SEEKING:** Louie is looking to snap a four-game losing streak (MLB) and seeking his first win since September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay, which was a relief outing...in his last seven starts, he has gone 0-6, 9.66 ERA (31.2 IP, 34 ER) with 11 home runs and 48 hits allowed, dating back to June 6, 2023...his last win in a start came in Houston on May 31, 2023, pitching 7.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, one walk and five strikeouts...his last win as a starter at home came against the Cubs on May 14, 2023 in a Twins 16-3 victory.

**BACK AT HOME:** Set to make his third start of the season at home after facing the Detroit Tigers on April 21...he took his fourth loss of the season allowing four runs on three hits (1 HR), four walks and two strikeouts in 2.2 innings -- shortest start of the year.

- ☞ Last home win came in a regular season game on September 12, 2023 vs. Tampa Bay Rays...entered in relief for Joe Ryan in the fifth inning and pitched 2.1 scoreless innings, allowing one hit, no walks and three strikeouts...picked up his fourth win on the season.
- ☞ Is 2-5, 5.63 ERA (48.0 IP, 26 ER), 49 hits (13 HR), 15 walks, 45 strikeouts, 1.33 WHIP and a .266 (49-for-184) opponent batting average in 13 home appearances (8 starts).
- ☞ In four home games at Triple-A St. Paul he went 1-2, 5.40 ERA (20.0 IP, 12 ER), six walks and 24 strikeouts.

**LEFTIES VS. RIGHTIES:** Through four starts in the 2024 season, left-handed hitters have hit .349 (15-for-43), with four home runs, three walks and 12 strikeouts...righties have hit .387 (12-for-31) with two home runs, six strikeouts and six walks...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .256/.305/.483 with 10 home runs and 49 strikeouts against Varland, while righties are slashing .286/.342/.529 with 16 home runs and 61 strikeouts.

- ☞ In four starts at St. Paul, left-handed hitters hit .291 (23-for-79), seven extra-base hits, one triple, two home runs, four doubles and a .788 OPS against Varland...right-handed hitters hit .259 (22-for-85), six extra-base hits, one triple, two home runs, three doubles and a .700 OPS against Varland.

**PITCH BREAKDOWN:** Varland used a five-pitch mix in his first four starts of the 2024 season, including a 4-seam fastball, cutter, slider, changeup and sinker, according to Baseball Savant...used his four-seam fastball and curveball a combined 62.2 percent of the time in his first four starts of the 2024 season...below is a look at his 2024 repertoire through three starts:

**STRIKEOUT NUMBER 100:** Picked up his 100th career strikeout on April 9 vs. Los Angeles Dodgers, fanning Max Muncy in the top of the fourth inning.

- ☞ Became the 42nd player ever born in Minnesota to record 100 strikeouts.
- ☞ Ranks 10th all time in strikeouts among Minnesota-born Twins players with 108.

**DAY MAN, FIGHTER OF THE NIGHT MAN:** In his career in night games he is 3-5, 4.82 ERA (61.2 IP, 33 ER), 68 hits, 15 walks, 60 strikeouts, a 1.35 WHIP and a .276 (68-for-246) opponent batting average...has made a total of 10 starts in night games throughout his career (13 total appearances)...last one came April 15 in Baltimore.
