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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore and Detroit conclude a three-game set this afternoon...The Birds are coming off a brief three-game homestand, having dropped two of three to the Braves...The O's will enjoy an off-day tomorrow before opening a six-game homestand against the Phillies and Angels on Friday...The Orioles have won 13 of 21 games since July 1 and are 11.0 games behind Tampa Bay in the AL East and 2.5 games back in the Wild Card.

- 🐦 The Birds were shut out yesterday for the second time this season, joining a 3-0 loss on June 18 at Seattle...Entering play today, the two shutouts are tied for the fewest in MLB along with the Dodgers and Nationals.
- 🐦 It marked the eighth time in franchise history (since 1954) the Orioles suffered a loss of 14+ runs while being shut out, including the first since a 14-0 defeat on June 14, 2004 at Cleveland...The franchise record was a 16-0 loss on April 30, 1960 vs. New York-AL.
- 🐦 **Dean Kremer** permitted a career-high eight earned runs across 4.0 innings...The eight earned runs are tied for the most allowed by an Oriole starter this season along with **Trey Gibson** (6/30 vs. CWS).
- 🐦 **Jackson Holliday** was responsible for two of Baltimore's three hits...The three knocks tied a season low (8x, last: 7/9 vs. CHC).

MR. ROGERS' NEIGHBORHOOD: Over his last nine starts since June 4, **Trevor Rogers** is 4-1 with a 1.80 ERA (11 ER/55.0 IP)...During that period, he is 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) across four road starts.

- 🐦 During the nine-start period, Rogers has limited the opposition to a .540 OPS after having a .906 opponent OPS over nine starts in April and May.

INSIDE THE MATCHUP: Opponents are hitting .267 (16-for-60) off Tarik Skubal's sinker, the highest average off any of his five offerings, which he throws 19.4 percent of the time.

- 🐦 Among Orioles with the most success against sinkers this season include **Taylor Ward** (.360, 36-for-100, 1 HR), **Tyler O'Neill** (.325, 13-for-40, 2 HR), **Leody Taveras** (.324, 11-for-34, 1 HR), **Colton Cowser** (.318, 7-for-22, 3 HR), **Jeremiah Jackson** (.308, 12-for-39), and **Pete Alonso** (.304, 28-for-92, 5 HR).

SOUTHPAW SPEAK: Since June 30, the Orioles are slashing .271/.342/.524 with 15 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, and an .866 OPS off left-handed pitching...The .866 OPS off southpaws is the fourth-highest mark in MLB during that period behind the Cubs (.935), Nationals (.912), and Rangers (.882).

- 🐦 **Coby Mayo** is slashing .280/.352/.720 (23-for-82) with six doubles, 10 home runs, and a 1.071 OPS off left-handed pitching...Among all major league batters with at least 90 plate appearances against lefties, Mayo ranks in OPS (1st), slugging percentage (1st), and home runs (T-2nd).

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 99 straight games since April 6, the longest active streak in the majors ahead of the Mets (39 G).

- 🐦 Today, Baltimore looks to secure a walk in 100 straight games for the sixth time in franchise history (since 1954)...The O's drew 1+ walk in a franchise-record 172 games from July 2, 2024-July 12, 2025.
- 🐦 The current 99-game stretch is the third-longest single-season streak in team history (since 1954), trailing streaks of 112 games (1995) and 104 games (1975).
- 🐦 **Taylor Ward** has 83 walks this season, 21 more than an Oriole had in 2025 and five more than the team leader had in 2024...The last O's player with more than 80 walks in a season was **Adley Rutschman** (92 BB) in 2023...An Oriole has not reached 100 free passes in a season since Albert Belle (101) in 1999.
- 🐦 The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season (4/5 at PIT).
- 🐦 Overall, the O's lead the AL and are tied for third in MLB with 418 walks.

HOLLIDAY SEASON: In 21 July games, **Jackson Holliday** is slashing .353/.493/.412 (18-for-51) with three doubles, seven runs, three RBI, and 15 walks against 10 strikeouts...The 15 walks are second most in the AL during July, trailing only teammate **Taylor Ward** (17), and rank seventh in the majors.

- 🐦 Holliday owns a 14.9 percent walk rate (27 BB/181 PA) across 56 games this season after recording an 8.6 percent clip (56 BB/649 PA) in 2025.

EYE OF THE TIGER: **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in 20 of 25 career games against Detroit, slashing .295/.356/.484 (28-for-95) with seven doubles, one triple, three home runs, 11 runs, 11 RBI, nine walks, and three steals.

- 🐦 In his last four games at Comercia Park since September 2, 2025, **Pete Alonso** is 7-for-16 with two doubles, two home runs, three RBI, and one walk.

KITT AND KABOODLE: **Andrew Kittredge** has gone a career-high 14 straight appearances without allowing an earned run, the third-longest active streak in MLB behind COL's Brennan Bernardino (20 G) and MIL's Abner Uribe (15 G).

- 🐦 It is the longest such streak by an Oriole since Seranthyony Domínguez's 15-game stretch from May 26-June 30, 2025.

MAKING THEIR PITCH: The O's have posted a 3.57 ERA in 57 games since May 24, the fifth-lowest mark in MLB behind the Tigers (3.26), Red Sox (3.41), Yankees (3.49), and Brewers (3.54)...Entering that day, the Orioles had a 4.95 ERA in the first 51 games of the year, second worst in MLB ahead of the Astros (5.16).

- 🐦 The rotation has posted a 3.75 ERA since May 24, the sixth-best starter ERA in the majors during that time...Entering that day, O's starters had a 5.13 ERA, second worst in MLB ahead of the Rockies (5.55).
- 🐦 Orioles relievers have a 2.76 ERA since June 16, second lowest in the majors behind the Yankees (2.63)...Entering that day, the team's bullpen ERA was 4.53, ranked ninth in the AL and 21st in MLB.

NIP AND TUCK: Baltimore is 9-17 (.346) in one-run games, the second-lowest winning percentage in such affairs in MLB ahead of New York-NL (.321, 9-19)...This includes a 3-9 mark in such games on the road.

QUICK HITS: Rogers is scheduled to make his 20th start of the season and 122nd of his career...Was reinstated from the 15-day Injured List (illness) on May 12...Voted as the winner of the 2025 Most Valuable Oriole Award by members of the local media, joining Randy Myers (1997), Mike Cuellar (1974), and Dave McNally (1968) as the only left-handed pitchers in franchise history to be named Most Valuable Oriole...He was the first pitcher to earn the honor since Rodrigo Lopez (2002)...Acquired from the Miami Marlins in exchange for INF/OF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers on July 30, 2024.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on July 24 vs. Atlanta after tossing a season-high-tying 7.0 innings (3x, last: 6/20 at LAD), allowing two runs on six hits with zero walks and six strikeouts... Threw 88 pitches, 72 strikes.

- ⚡ His 81.8 percent strike rate in the start is the highest by any pitcher in MLB this season (min. 50 pitches thrown), ahead of PIT's Braxton Ashcraft on June 24 vs. Seattle (79.1%, 68-of-86)...Under the same parameter, it was the highest strike rate by an Oriole pitcher in the pitch tracking era (since 2008), ahead of Kevin Gausman's 80.4 percent clip (86-of-107) on May 11, 2018 vs. Tampa Bay.
- ⚡ Did not issue a walk for the third time in 2026, joining April 7 at Chicago-AL and June 26 vs. Washington.

MO-TOWN: Rogers is set to make his third career start against the Tigers, having gone 1-1 with a 3.72 ERA (4 ER/9.2 IP).

- ⚡ Made his lone career start in Detroit on May 15, 2024 and earned the win after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing three hits, two walks, and one hit batter with six strikeouts.
 - ⚡ Took the loss earlier this season in Game 2 of the May 24 doubleheader, permitting four runs on four hits (1 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts over 4.2 innings.
- THAT'S MORE LIKE IT:** Over his last seven starts since June 14, Rogers is 3-1 with a 1.44 ERA (7 ER/43.2 IP), .199 (31-for-156) opponent average, and 0.98 WHIP.
- ⚡ Among all MLB pitchers who have thrown at least 40.0 innings since June 14, his 1.44 ERA is tied with PHI's Jesús Luzardo for third lowest in the majors behind SF's Robbie Ray (1.04) and DET's Troy Melton (1.09).
 - ⚡ He went 0-3 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP) and .996 opponent OPS across four May starts...Among all MLB starters who made at least four starts in May, his 10.31 ERA was second highest ahead of COL's Kyle Freeland (12.46).

SWING AND MISS STUFF: In six starts since June 20, Rogers owns a 24.1 percent strikeout rate and 25.9 percent whiff rate...He posted a 16.6 percent strikeout rate and 22.0 percent whiff rate over his first 13 outings.

- ⚡ During his most recent six-start stretch, he owns a 26.6 percent strikeout rate on his four-seam fastball, while producing a 28.7 percent whiff rate on the offering...Over his first 13 starts, he owned a 13.8 percent strikeout rate on the heater with a 21.2 percent whiff rate.

ROAD WARRIOR: Over his last four road starts since June 4, Rogers is 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) after going 0-2 with an 8.59 ERA (14 ER/14.2 IP) over his first three to open the season.

SUPPORT WELCOMED: Rogers has received three runs of support or fewer in each of his last eight outings (15 runs total), including one run in four of the outings.

- ⚡ He received 32 runs of support over his first 11 starts of 2026, including a season-high-tying eight runs on April 1 vs. Texas and June 4 at Boston.

LEFT SIDE STORY: Over his past six starts, Rogers has limited left-handed hitters to a .143 (6-for-42) clip with two doubles and 15 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Over his previous seven starts from May 12-June 14, lefties went 11-for-39 (.282) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, four walks, and seven strikeouts.
- ⚡ Rogers opened the season limiting left-handed hitters to a .091 (2-for-22) mark with two doubles, three walks, and eight strikeouts over six starts.

TWO-OUT TROUBLES: Opponents are slashing .306/.367/.418 (41-for-134) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 29 RBI off Rogers with two outs.

- ⚡ Over his last nine starts since June 4, however, he has limited the opposition to a .219/.286/.297 (14-for-64) line with two outs after they slashed .386/.442/.529 (27-for-70) over his first 10 outings.
- ⚡ Overall, opponents are slashing .426/.500/.638 (20-for-47) with four doubles and two home runs off Rogers with runners in scoring position and two outs.

Has not thrown more than 10 pitches in at least seven straight games for the second time this season (also 3/28-4/11)...He is the only player in MLB to hold at least one such 7+-game streak since T.J. McFarland did so in 10 straight games from 8/9-9/1/24 with OAK and the first to do so twice in the same season since Óliver Pérez with CLE in 2019
