YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Marlins, 6-3, clinching a series win for Miami...Colton Cowser had two of Baltimore's four hits, including a two-out, game-tying, three-run double in the sixth inning...Chayce McDermott made his MLB debut and surrendered three runs in 4.0 innings.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have lost three games in a row and eight of their last 11 since July 9...At 60-41 (.594), the Birds have the third-best record in MLB behind the Guardians (.604, 61-40) and Phillies (.627, 64-38)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 161-102 (.612), the best winning percentage and tied for the most wins in the majors with the Dodgers during that time...The O's are 244-181 (.574) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.585, 249-177), Braves (.611, 259-165), and Dodgers (.637, 272-155).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 157 home runs, eight more than the second-place Yankees (149) and 18 more than the Dodgers (139), who rank third...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

- Baltimore has an MLB-best eight players with at least 10 home runs, the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (28), Anthony Santander (27), Adley Rutschman (17), Jordan Westburg (16), Colton Cowser (13), Ryan Mountcastle and Ryan O'Hearn (12), and Cedric Mullins (10); the Birds had eight players hit 10+ homers before the 100-game mark for the third time in team history, joining the 2000 and 1987 seasons.
- Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 25 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (35) and Juan Soto (25); this marks the third time an 0's team has had multiple players with 25+ homers through the first 100 games of a season, joining Brady Anderson (31) and Rafael Palmeiro (25) in 1996, and Boog Powell (27) and Frank Robinson (25) in 1969.
- The Orioles lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).
- The O's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August; Baltimore has hit 18 in July, tied for 23rd in MLB this month, with five coming from Anthony Santander

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks third in MLB with 81 runs scored behind Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. and New York-AL's Juan Soto (83)...It's tied for the most runs scored through the first 100 team games to begin a season in Orioles history with **Frank Robinson** (1969)...He scored three runs on Friday at Texas for the eighth time this year, two more than the next closest player (Witt Jr.)...Henderson's 15 such games since the start of 2023 are five more than any other player in that time...He's on pace to become the second player in 0's history to score 130 times in a season, along with **Roberto Alomar**, who set the team record with 132 runs in 1996.

Three players in team history have led the AL in runs scored - Frank Robinson in 1966 (122), Cal Ripken, Jr. in 1983 (121), and Don Buford in 1971 (99).

MASHED TATERS: Anthony Santander is slashing .277/.323/.621 (49-for-177) with five doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 27 runs scored, 37 RBI, 12 walks, one hit-by-pitch, and one stolen base in

45 games since the beginning of June...His 18 homers lead the majors during that span.

• He's hit safely in 10 straight games since July 10 while batting .325/.372/.700 (13-for-40) during that time; this marks his fifth career hitting streak of at least 10 games and his

- longest since a career-long 16-gamer from July 16 to August 6, 2022. Santander is the ninth player in 0's history to hit 25+ homers in at least three straight seasons, matching **Frank Robinson** (1969-71), **Lee May** (1976-78), and **Manny Machado** (2015-17), and trailing **Eddie Murray** (1982-85) and **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995-98), who did so in four consecutive years, **Chris Davis** (2012-17) and **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1982-87), who had
- six, and **Adam Jones** (2011-17), who hit 25 or more homers in seven straight years. He has 15 multi-homer games, eighth-most in franchise history behind **Frank Robinson** (16), **Brady Anderson** (17), **Chris Davis** and **Manny Machado** (19), **Eddie Murray** and **Boog** Powell (20), and Cal Ripken, Jr. (21).

WRAPPING UP THE ROAD TRIP: Baltimore completes a six-game road trip today with the series finale in Miami...The Orioles lost the first two games against Marlins after going 2-1 in Texas to open the trip...Despite losing three straight games on this trip, the 0's are a league-best 30-19 (.612) on the road this year and 82-48 (.631) away from Oriole Park since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .585 during that time.

AGAINST THE MARLINS: The Orioles and Marlins finish their first series in Miami since 2021 today...Baltimore swept a three-game series at Camden Yards last year, the first sweep of any length against the Marlins in series history...The 0's are 13-30 (.302) against the Fish since the teams first met in 1997, the lowest winning percentage against an opponent in team history.

The Birds are 3-16 (.158) all time in Miami, the worst winning percentage on the road

against a franchise in team history.
Baltimore is 12-16 (.429) against the NL this season; of the nine series losses in 2024 five have come against NL opponents; the Orioles are an MLB-best 48-25 (.658) against

MONTHLY DUES: The O's have nine consecutive winning months (min. 10 games played) since the start of 2023, the longest streak by the O's since May 1982 through September 1983 (11), per the *Elias Sports Bureau...* At 7–10 this month, the Birds will need to go 6–2 in their final eight games in July to extend the streak...The current stretch is the longest active streak in the majors

<u>ROSTER MOVES:</u> The Orioles recalled infielder/outfielder **Connor Norby** and right-handed pitcher **Bryan Baker** from Triple-A Norfolk today...Infielder/outfielder **Jorge Mateo** was placed on the 10-day Injured List (left elbow subluxation), retroactive to July 24, and right-handed pitcher Chayce McDermott was optioned to the Tides after yesterday's game.

ALL-STARS: Five Orioles were selected to the All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington. TX: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, Anthony Santander, and Jordan Westburg...Head Athletic Trainer Brian Ebel also represented the 0's on the AL staff...Burnes (4x) and Rutschman (2x) were repeat All-Stars while Henderson, Santander, and Westburg were first-timers...Burnes (P), Henderson (SS), and Rutschman (C) all started for the first time in their careers

- Baltimore became the first AL team with at least five All-Stars, all of whom were under 30 years old at the time of the game, since New York-AL in 2017 (also 5); the Braves did
- so with eight such players last year.

 Burnes and Rutschman became the first pair of teammates to form the starting battery at the All-Star game since 2016, when San Francisco's Johnny Cueto (P) and Buster Posey (C) did so in San Diego, and the first for the AL since 2006, when Detroit's Kenny Rogers (P) and Iván Rodríguez (C) did so in Pittsburgh.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 21st start of the season this afternoon against the Marlins...Made the start in the 2024 Midsummer Classic...Reinstated from the Paternity List on July 1; placed on the PL June 28...His 2.38 ERA is the lowest mark for an Orioles starting pitcher through his first 20 starts in a season since Jim Palmer in 1978 (2.23) and it is the lowest mark for a pitcher through his first 20 starts to begin an Orioles career all-time...The Orioles are 13-7 in his starts this year...Has allowed 24 stolen bases this season, the most by any pitcher in MLB...A four-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024... Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

HEY NOW. YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: Selected to his fourth consecutive All-Star Game and made his first All-Star Game start...Became the fifth Orioles pitcher to start the Midsummer Classic, joining Steve Stone (1980), Jim Palmer (1978, 1977, 1972, 1970), Milt Pappas (1965), and Jerry Walker (1959)...Burnes pitched a scoreless first inning, allowing a walk to Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani and a double to Philadelphia's Bryce Harper; left both runners stranded in scoring position...Caught by Adley Rutschman, the first all-Oriole battery to appear together in an All-Star Game.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on July 19 at Texas after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, surrendering two hits (1 HR), a season-high four walks, and one wild pitch with six strikeouts...Earned his 16th quality start of the season, tied with Kansas City's Seth Lugo and Seattle's Logan Gilbert for the MLB lead... Has notched 5+ strikeouts in each of his last 11 starts; is the only Orioles pitcher with 11 consecutive outings with 5+ punchouts this year...Threw 101 pitches, 60 strikes; topped 100 pitches for the third time this season and first since May 29 vs. Boston.

AGAINST THE MARLINS: Scheduled to make his seventh career appearance (5GS) against Miami...Is 2-1 with a 1.95 ERA (6 ER/27.2 IP) across his six prior outings against the Fish...Secured the win in his last start against the Marlins on September 22, 2023 at loanDepot park; tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and two walks with six strikeouts...Made his MLB debut in Miami (w/MIL) on July 10, 2018, earning the save with a strikeout in 2.0 perfect innings.

AGAINST THE NL EAST: Will be making his 30^{th} career appearance (19^{th} start) against the NL East...Owns a lifetime 7-5 record with a 3.88 ERA (52 ER/120.2 IP) against the division...Has gone 1-1 with a 3.65 ERA (5 ER/12.1 IP) iwith 13 strikeouts to five walks n two starts against the division this season.

HIGH OUALITY: Burnes tossed a career-high 10 consecutive quality starts from April 26 to June 16, the longest streak in the majors this year and the longest stretch by an Oriole since Jeremy Guthrie (10, 5/8-6/26/07)...Burnes' 16 quality starts on the season are tied for the most in MLB and his 73 quality outings since the start of 2021 lead the majors.

NO MORE THAN FOUR: In each of his last 15 appearances, Burnes has gone at least 6.0 innings while allowing no more than four earned runs...The next longest active such streak in MLB is an eight-gamer by Seattle's George Kirby... San Diego's Yu Darvish is the last pitcher with a 15-game such streak in a single season (7/9-9/30, 2022)...The last Oriole with such a single-season streak was Dennis Martinez in 1978 (15G, 7/29-10/1).

RING 'EMUP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with 200+ strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 84 strikeouts away from 200 on the year and 14 away from 1,000 in his career; the last Orioles pitcher to record a 200+-strikeout season was Erik Bedard in 2007 (221).

INNINGS FATER: The 687.1 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank second in MLB behind Philadelphia's Aaron Nola (704.0 IP)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA(30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.


