**ROSTER MOVE:** Prior to tonight's game, the Mets are expected to recall RHP Robert Stock from Triple-A Syracuse...Stock will make his second start for the Mets this year...He is 0-2 with a 7.88 ERA (seven earned runs/8.0 innings) with eight walks and eight strikeouts in two games this year between Chicago and New York...Stock has appeared in four games for Syracuse and went 1-0 with a 2.87 ERA (five earned runs/15.2 innings) with eight walks and 14 strikeouts...He was claimed by the Mets on June 22 from the Chicago Cubs.

**STEAL THIS BASE:** In the top of the 11th inning, Jeff McNeil advanced to second on what was originally scored defensive indifference...Major League Baseball has changed this to a stolen base.

**METS IN THE MORNING:** The New York Mets announced the launch of their new podcast, "Mets in the Morning" hosted by Josh Lewin...The podcast, which will air every weekday for the remainder of the regular season, can be found on Spotify, Apple and Google podcasts and [Mets.com/Podcasts](http://Mets.com/Podcasts)...Episodes will include highlights from the previous night's game, previews of each day's game, interviews and insight that will fully satisfy the appetite of fans everywhere...Lewin was a member of the Mets radio booth from 2012-2018.

**METSELLANEOUS:** The Mets defeated the Reds, 15-11, in extra-innings last night...The Mets have won two-in-a-row after dropping three straight...The Mets continue a six-game road trip (2-2) featuring three games against the Pirates (1-2) and the Reds (1-0)...The Mets are off on Thursday and then return to New York for a 10-day, 11-game homestand against the Blue Jays (three games), Braves (five games) and Reds (three games).

**DOUBLEVISION:** The Mets are the second team in MLB history to hit back-to-back home runs in the first inning and back-to-back blasts in extra innings in the same game...The other instance was the Pirates on September 3, 1950 (Danny O'Connell and Ralph Kiner in the first and then Pete Castiglione and Bob Dillinger in the 10th inning)...Courtesy of Stats, Inc.

**THREE'S COMPANY:** Last night was the second time the Mets had two players with three RBI off the bench...On September 27, 2001 at Montreal, Desi Relaford had a two-run homer and an RBI double after entering as a substitute and Mike Piazza had a pinch-hit, bases-clearing double in the ninth inning as New York came back from being down 6-2 to win, 12-6...Since RBI became official in 1920, only 28 other games have featured a team getting three or more RBI off the bench from multiple players...The Dodgers were the last to do it, getting a game-tying pinch-hit three-run homer from Chris Taylor and a walk-off three-run PH blast from Will Smith on June 23, 2019 vs. Colorado.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** The Mets hit seven home runs in last night's win...It was the fourth time in franchise history the Mets have socked seven or more home runs in a game...The team record is eight home runs in a game, done so on August 24, 2015 at Philadelphia...The other three games in which the Mets hit seven or more home runs came against Philadelphia.

**WHAT A RELIEF:** Anthony Banda earned the win last night in his first appearance with the team...He became the first Mets reliever to earn the win in his first game in extra-innings since Gabriel Ynoa did so in an 11-inning win on August 13, 2016 vs. San Diego.

**NINE IS FINE:** Jeff McNeil is on a nine-game hitting streak, batting .345 (10-29) with six runs, a double, a home run, five RBI, three walks and a .907 OPS in that span...His nine game hitting streak is the second longest streak of his career...His career-high is 11 straight games with a hit, doing so from August 16-26, 2018...He has safely reached base in each of his last 10 games, putting up a .447 OBP in that span...He is batting .333 (16-48) with nine runs, a double, a home run, seven RBI and six walks with an .835 OPS in 15 games this month.

**PROUD TO BE GREAT AMERICAN:** The Mets own a 35-20 record with a 4.20 ERA (226 earned runs/484.2 innings) at Great American Ball Park...The team has hit .268/.335/.463 with 86 home runs at the yard...The Mets have outscored the Reds, 298-246 since the ballpark was opened in 2003...The team's .268 batting average is the fourth-highest opposing batting average in the ballpark...It's the second-highest in the NL...Only the Dodgers (.272) have a higher batting average at GABP.

**JULY! JULY! JULY!:** As a team, New York is batting .265/.352/.466 with an .818 OPS in 15 games this month...This is their highest batting average, OBP and SLG in any month this season...The Mets hit .222/.297/.379 in 30 games in June...The team has hit 26 home runs this month...Their second-highest total of any month this year...The team hit a season-high 33 blasts in June.

**WE LIKE MIKE:** Michael Conforto has hit three home runs in his last two games...It was his seventh career multi-home run game and first of the season...He is 6-17 (.353) with four runs, two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, two walks and a 1.421 OPS in four games since after the All-Star Break.

**MOVING ON UP:** Michael Conforto has hit 124 home runs and is now tied with Todd Hundley for eighth on the team's all-time home run list...Lucas Duda is seventh with 125...Pete Alonso is now 21st on the Mets all-time home run list with 87 blasts...Gary Carter is 20th with 89 home runs.

**METS-REDS NOTES:** The Mets return to the Queen City for the first time since September 20-22, 2019...The team took two of three from the Reds.

**THIS ONE GOES TO 11:** The Mets recorded a season-high 18 hits yesterday...The Mets collected their third consecutive game with at least 11 hits yesterday...The Mets have recorded 23 games this year with at least 10 hits and are 18-5 in those games.

**ROAD SHOW:** Pete Alonso is batting .282/.346/.588 with 31 runs, seven doubles, 15 home runs, 39 RBI and 14 walks on the road this year...His 15 road home runs is tied for the major league lead with Shohei Ohtani, Rafael Devers and Jesus Aguilar who each have 15...This compares to a .218/.321/.336 slash line with three home runs at home...Dominic Smith is slashing .277/.339/.464 with 21 runs, 10 doubles, seven homers, 18 RBI and 14 walks away from Citi Field...This compares to a .223/.295/.315 slash line with six extra-base hits at home.

**I'M WALKING HERE:** Brandon Nimmo has drawn nine walks in his last four games...He is 15-50 (.300) with 12 runs, four doubles, one home run, 12 walks and six RBI in 14 games since returning from the 10-Day IL...He is batting .310 (36-116) with 19 runs, nine doubles, two home runs, 14 RBI, 24 walks and an .872 OPS in 36 games this year.

**IN A PINCH:** The Mets pinch-hitters are batting .256/.336/.457 with eight doubles, six home runs, 29 RBI and 13 walks...Their .256 batting average is the fourth-best in the majors and is the best in the NL...Their .793 pinch-hit OPS is also the best in the NL...The team's six pinch-hit home runs is the third most in the NL.

**TOTAL DOMINATION:** Dominic Smith is batting .291/.333/.582 with 13 runs, four doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, three walks and a .915 OPS in 15 games this month...He is batting .342/.390/.507 with eight extra-base hits against left-handed pitchers this year.

**FIRST THINGS FIRST:** The Mets have been in first place since Saturday, May 8, a streak of 73 days...This is their longest run atop the East in the last 14 seasons...The 2007 Mets (135 days in a row) were the last iteration of the club to be in first longer than 73 days in a row, per Elias...The team has been in first place for 89 days overall this season, the most of any team in 2021.

**C IS FOR COOKIE:** Carlos Carrasco is currently on a rehab assignment with the Syracuse Mets...He is slated to start in their game against the Buffalo Bisons, which is being played in Trenton, NJ...He tossed 2.0 scoreless innings and allowed only a hit, while striking out two last Thursday...Carrasco is on the 60-Day IL with a right hamstring injury.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Mets are 21-28 with a 4.49 ERA (203 earned runs/407.1 innings) with 141 walks and 434 strikeouts on the road this year...This compares to a 28-14 record with a 2.43 ERA (97 earned runs/359.0 innings) with 128 walks and 399 strikeouts at home...The team's 2.43 ERA at home is the best in the majors and their .667 winning percentage is tied for the third-best.

**CONNECT FORTY:** The Mets are 40-8 when scoring four or more runs this season...The team is 9-34 when scoring three or fewer runs...The Mets are 37-12 when scoring first this season...The team's .755 winning percentage is the third-best record in the major leagues when scoring first this season.

**REPLACE-METS:** Entering today, the Mets have used 52 players through 91 games this season...The franchise record for most players used in a season is 56 by the 2018 Mets...The Mets have had 15 different pitchers start a game this season...That is the most in the majors...The Mets used 10 starters in 2020...The last time the Mets used 15 or more starters in a season was in 1979 when they also used 15...The franchise record is 20 starters used in 1967.

**THREW ME FOR A LOUP:** Aaron Loup has allowed one run in his last 18 appearances...He is 2-0 with a 0.47 ERA (one earned run/19.0 innings) in that span with four walks and 24 strikeouts...Overall, he is 3-0 with a 1.48 ERA (five earned runs/30.1 innings) with 25 hits, six walks and 37 strikeouts...He has held left-handed hitters to a .186 (8-43) batting average this season.

**QUALITY EATS:** The Mets have made 34 quality starts this season...The Mets rotation owns a 3.07 ERA (151 earned runs/443.1 innings) this season, the second-best mark in the major leagues...deGrom leads the major leagues with a 1.08 ERA, while Marcus Stroman is 13th in the majors with a 2.78 mark.

**THIS DAY IN METS HISTORY:** On this day in 2008, José Reyes recorded his 11th triple of the year and the 63rd of his career to surpass Mookie Wilson for the team's all-time leader in triples...The Mets defeated the Reds, 7-5, in Cincinnati...Mike Pelfry made the start, but did not receive a decision, Duaner Sanchez earned the win in relief and Billy Wagner converted the save...The Mets scored twice in the 10th to earn the win...Reyes finished 4-6 with three runs and the triple in the game...The shortstop would go on to hit 113 triples with the Mets...For cool photos and interactive history information on the Mets, please visit the Mets Virtual Vault at [metsheritage.com](http://metsheritage.com).

### MEGILL NEWS & NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Stock started on Sunday for Syracuse (AAA)...He pitched 1.0 inning and retired all three batters he faced on seven pitches...He struck out one.

**LAST TIME IN THE BIGS:** Stock's last major league start was his Mets debut, July 7 vs. Milwaukee in game two of a doubleheader...He tossed a career-high-tying 4.0 innings and allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts.

**2021:** Stock has made the first two starts of his major league career this season...His first start came against the Mets on June 16 with the Cubs...He was designated for assignment by Chicago on June 20 and claimed off waivers by the Mets on June 22...He has made 13 appearances (six starts) with Iowa (AAA) and Syracuse (AAA) this season, going 1-3 with a 3.57 ERA (14 earned runs/35.1 innings).

**MAJOR LEAGUE REVIEW:** Stock was exclusively a reliever before this season, making 52 appearances out of the bullpen for San Diego (2018-2019) and Boston (2020) over the last three years...He was 2-2 with a 4.24 ERA (30 earned runs/63.2 innings) in those 52 games with 31 walks and 67 strikeouts.

**NEW YORK, FRIEND & FOE:** According to Elias, the last pitcher to make his first two career starts for and against the same team was Jalen Beeks, who made his major league debut in a start for Boston on June 7, 2018, then made his second career start vs. the Red Sox over a year later for the Rays on July 22, 2019...Elias also notes that the last pitcher to make consecutive appearances, both starts, for and against the same team was Joe Kelly, who started for St. Louis on July 30, 2014, then against the Cardinals for Boston a week later on August 6.
