TONIGHT'S GAME: Is game 4 (3-0) of a 6-game road trip to Washington (3-0) and Atlanta (3g).....following this trip and an off day on Thursday, the Brewers return home for 6 games against New York-NL (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g).
IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without Bob Uecker on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (139 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: FIRST: 25*, SECOND: 57, THIRD: 43, FOURTH: 11, FIFTH: 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 2.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).
SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The team is 22-12-2 in series play. Game 1: 22-14, Game 2: 22-14, Game 3: 20-15, Game 4: 3-1 Sweeps (7): vs. BOS (3g, 5/26-5/28), at PHI (3g, 5/30-6/1), at MIN (3g, 6/20-6/22), vs. LAD (3g, 7/7-7/9), vs. WSH (3g, 7/11-7/13), at LAD (3g, 7/18-7/20), at WSH (3g, 8/1-8/3)..... Were Swept (1): at NYY (3g, 3/27-3/30)
AT HOME: The team is 36-20 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play.....are 24-11 in the last 35 home games and 13-4 in the last 17.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.
ON THE ROAD: The team is 31-24 on the road, going 9-7-2 in series play.....are 21-6 in the last 27 road games and 9-1 in the last 10 contests with a current 4-game winning streak.....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.
MANAGER: Pat Murphy is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.
COACHES: Associate manager Rickie Weeks (2nd season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach Jim Henderson (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (2nd season), lead hitting coach Al LeBoeuf (1st season), hitting coach Connor Dawson (4th season), hitting coach Eric Theisen (1st season), assistant coach Daniel de Mondesert (2nd season), infield coach Matt Erickson (2nd season), first base coach Julio Borbón (1st season), third base coach Jason Lane (10th season/5th in current role).
LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 19 replay challenges this season, going 12-7.....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/30 vs. Chicago-NL as an out call at first base involving William Contreras stood.
BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.
BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 733 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

PRIESTER AT A GLANCE: Quinn Priester, 24, will make his 21st appearance and 16th start of the season.....Priester last pitched last Tuesday in a start vs. Chicago-NL and earned a 9-3 win (5.2ip, 8h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 3k, 1hr, 86 pitches).....the team is 9-6 in his starts.....he has 6 quality starts.....opponents are batting .236 (96-for-406, 12hr).....he has gone 7-2 with a 2.68 ERA as a starter (80.2ip, 24er) and 3-0 with a 5.06 ERA in relief (26.2ip, 15er).....he is on a 9-game winning streak over his last 11 games/8 starts while posting a 2.59 ERA (62.2ip, 55h, 19r, 18er, 13bb, 57k, 7hr).....Priester was acquired from Boston on April 7 for OF Yophery Rodriguez, a Competitive Balance Round A selection and a player to be named (RHP John Holobetz on May 5).....he began the season at Triple-A Worcester (1 start).

LAST SEASON: Priestler went 3-6 with a 4.71 ERA in 11 games/7 starts with Pittsburgh (10g/6gs) and Boston (1gs).....his teams went 1-6 in his starts.....he had 2 quality starts..... opponents batted .277 (56-for-202, 7hr).....he went 1-5 with a 4.42 ERA as a starter (36.2ip, 18er) and 2-1 with a 5.54 ERA as a reliever (13ip, 8er).....Priester was traded by Pittsburgh to Boston on 7/29/24 in exchange for INF/OF Nick Yorke.

CAREER: Is 16-11 with a 4.70 ERA in 41 games/30 starts (207ip, 108er) while pitching for Pittsburgh (2023-24), Boston (2024) and Milwaukee (2025).....has gone 10-10 with a 4.40 ERA as a starter (157.1ip, 77er) and 6-1 with a 5.62 ERA as a reliever (49.2ip, 31er).....Priester was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-2 with a 3.53 ERA in 12 games/8 starts (66.1ip, 26er).....is 6-1 with a 3.04 ERA in 9 games/6 starts this season (50.1ip, 17er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 7-6 with a 4.50 ERA in 23 games/17 starts (118ip, 59er).....is 4-1 with a 3.47 ERA in 11 games/9 starts this season (57ip, 22er).

CAREER vs. BRAVES: Is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA in 2 starts (10ip, 16h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 11k, 0hr), including a 4-1 win this season on 6/10 in Milwaukee (6ip, 7h, 1r, 1er, 0bb, 7k).....his other start came with the Pirates on 8/9/23 at PNC Park (4ip, 9h, 4r, 4er, 1bb, 4k, 2wp).....Pittsburgh lost, 6-5.
